PM Modi, French President Macron hold roadshow

Prime Minister Narendra Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron held a mega roadshow in Rajasthan's Jaipur on Thursday. The French leader is in India on a two-day state visit at the invitation of PM Modi. People in large numbers welcomed PM Modi and French President Emmanuel Macron during their roadshow in Jaipur. Macron waved at the people who gathered there, acknowledging the warm welcome accorded him. As PM Modi and French President Macron held the mega road show, a floral



show for the leaders also took place. Following the roadshow, PM Modi and French President visited Hawa Mahal.

Hawa Mahal, also known as "Palace of Breeze", was built in 1799 as an extension to the Royal City Palace of Jaipur. Earlier, Macron arrived at Amer Fort in Rajasthan's Jaipur. He also met school students who gathered there to welcome him. On his visit to the fort, the French President was accompanied by External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar and Rajasthan Deputy Chief Minister Diya Kumari. At the fort, Macron also posed for a picture with Jaishankar and Diya Kumari. As the French President walked around the royal fort, he was also given an overview of the history the fort carries.

Amit Shah launches e-bus service in J-K, distributes over 1,000 appointment letters

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday launched e-bus service in Jammu and distributed more than

1,000 appointment letters for Jammu and Kashmir Combined Examination-2024 and compassionate appointment through video conferencing from the national capital. In his address, Shah said 100 fully air-conditioned e-buses have been dedicated to the people of Jammu. He further said this project has started with the operation and maintenance of these buses for 12 years at a cost of Rs 561 crore. Shah said under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, India has spread environmental awareness throughout the world and the best steps in this direction have been taken. He said the Modi government has implemented schemes for e-buses in the entire country and under the same measure, Jammu is getting 100 e-buses on Thursday. Shah added that a reliable, comfortable, economical and durable public transport facility for the people of Jammu has started from Thursday.

Clash erupts between two groups in Ujjain

A clash erupted between two groups following the vandalisation of a statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel installed near a square in Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain district, a police official said on Thursday. The incident occurred under the jurisdiction of Makdhone police station on Thursday morning and the Makdhone police station in-charge has been suspended for negligence,

the officer added. "A statue of a great personality installed near Krishi Upaj Mandi square under Makdhone police station by people of one group was vandalised by people of another group on Thursday morning, after which a clash broke out between the two groups on the spot," said Guru Prasad Parashar, Additional Superintendent of Police (ASP). On getting information about the incident, the police immediately reached the spot and talked to both the parties. The officer further said, "A Sub Inspector (SI) of Makdhone police station, Lalchand Sharma, has sustained injuries in the incident; he is undergoing treatment. Prima facie, Makdhone station in-charge Bhim Singh Deora has been suspended for serious negligence in the incident."
