

Woman candidate again from Rewa after twenty-eight years

Till date no woman elected MP from Rewa
Congress makes Neelam its candidate from Rewa this time

The people of Rewa have always accepted male-dominated leadership in the Lok Sabha. Till date no woman MP has been elected from Rewa seat. In the Rewa Lok Sabha seat, national parties have fielded very few women by giving them the ticket.

After three decades, the Congress Party has fielded a woman candidate in the elections. Earlier in 1989, Congress had given a ticket to Maharani Praveen Kumari, how-

ever she could not win the election. After this, in the Lok Sabha elections held in 1996, BJP had fielded Maharani Praveen Kumari. Luck was not on her side here either and Maharani lost the election. If we look at the Lok Sabha elections from 1952 till now, no woman MP has been elected from Rewa, very little opportunity was given to her.

Half the population has not yet tasted victory. Congress, BJP and BSP fielded women in the elections, but could not taste victory. Women are active in politics in all parties, be it Congress or BJP, there is a long list of women leaders. BJP has been in power at the Center for a decade but no woman was given a chance from Rewa. While many women leaders were contenders for the Lok Sabha ticket and their names had also come up during the opinion

poll, the party trusted only the old faces. It is another matter that a woman MP was elected from the neighboring district Sidhi. No woman MP has been elected in Rewa since independence. After three

decades, Congress has fielded Mrs. Neelam Abhay Mishra in the election field. This election is not new for Neelam. Before this, she had been elected MLA by contesting elections from Semaria in 2013. For a long time, Congress did not give a chance to any woman. BJP also did not give tickets to any woman after 1996. Whereas from time to time there has been a demand to field a woman candidate.

There were two women candidates in 2019 elections

The last elections for Lok Sabha were held in the year 2019. 23 candidates were in the fray, including two women candidates. Rita Tripathi from Bhartiya Shakti Chetna Party was in the fray, who received 3032 votes. Shakuntala Mishra was in the election fray from SAPAKS,

who got 3719 votes. Apart from this, other candidates were men. In the previous elections, various parties have been fielding women candidates.

Vimla Sondhia and Sheela Kushwaha were in the fray in the 1984 elections. Apart from Congress-BJP, BSP also gave opportunity to women candidates and fielded Mrs. Vimala Devi in the 1989 elections. Who had received 1,37,431 votes at that time. In the Lok Sabha elections, women candidates from regional parties and independent women have been contesting the elections. Women are active in all the major parties of Rewa and also hold senior positions in the organization. At present the District Panchayat President is Mrs. Neeta Kaul. No woman candidate has yet filed nomination in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

Risk of accident increases after removal of BRTS

Vehicles overtaking and running at high speed, even traffic police not able to control them

The BRTS built five years ago was removed last month by the Municipal Corporation on the instructions of the government, but due to not making dividers in the middle of the road, the risk of accidents has increased.

However, traffic signals costing crores of rupees installed at the intersections of the roads of the capital have failed. Now after the removal of the BRTS corridor, drivers are overtaking and running at high speed. In such a situation, even the traffic police have become helpless in controlling the traffic. The approximately 25 km long BRTS from Bairagarh to 11th Mile of Narmadapuram Road in the capital was built five years ago at a cost of approximately Rs 269 crore. Now

after the Mohan government came, the decision was taken to demolish this BRTS. As soon as the order to demolish the BRTS was issued before the code of conduct for the Lok Sabha elections was imposed in March, the Municipal Corporation immediately started removing it.

Road divider construction work with very slow speed - Municipal Corporation removed the BRTS corridor from Bairagarh to Barkatullah University on Narmadapuram Road between 15th to 25th March. Till now, only about 15 km stretch could be broken. Now the work of making a road divider has started. But the work is going on at a snail's pace. A 2 feet high and 1 foot wide divider has been built in the middle of the road in the BRTS

portion from Bairagarh to Lal Ghati intersection, but beyond this, the construction work of the divider is going on at a very slow pace.

Vehicles drive haphazardly as soon as the road appears wide

The removal of the BRTS corridor may have brought relief to the general public, but the risk of accidents has also increased. In fact, as soon as the road appeared wide, the drivers started driving at high speed. Especially two-wheeler and four-wheeler drivers started overtaking other vehicles at high speed. Two days before overtaking on the route from Board Office to Rani Kamalapati station, the car driver narrowly avoided hitting the bike

rider. Actually, it was the fault of the young man riding the sports bike. He suddenly overtook and cut in front of Pragati petrol pump. This saved him from colliding with the car. Eyewitnesses said that if there was BRTS, such accidents would not have happened.

25 thousand vehicles run daily

In the 11-mile stretch from Sant Hirdaram Nagar that includes the BRTS corridor, there is a daily movement of about 25 thousand vehicles and there are more than 20 major intersections, out of which only a dozen intersections have signals. The remaining intersections are used as crossings without signals. At these major intersections, traffic police are present for traffic control.

Municipal Corporation has removed BRTS corridors. Now the part in front of BU till the 11 Mile intersection has to be removed. Will remove this also soon. Along with this, after the road has been widened, the work of making a divider in the middle has been started to prevent accidents. Currently the work of the divider has been done till Hamidia Collectorate. Road dividers for the entire 11 miles are expected to be built in the next two months.

EC gives green signal to increase property rates in MP

Property rates will increase only in 60 thousand locations in the state
Software updated on Wednesday evening
Increase has been made from 5 to 20 percent

Bhopal: The Election Commission of India has given permission to implement the new Collector Guidelines for property in Madhya Pradesh in the next 24 hours. Along with this, new rates have been implemented as soon as the registration software is updated from Wednesday.

In this, instructions have been received to increase the new rates only in 60 thousand locations out of approximately 1.12 lakh locations in the state. IG Registration and Stamp M Selvendran said that due to the implementation of the code of conduct, permission was sought from the Election Commission to implement it from April 1, which was granted. Since there were two days of holiday, the system is being updated as soon as the registry office opens on time from Wednesday.

The new rates will come into effect after 24 hours. It is noteworthy that in the new guideline, property prices have been increased in 60 thousand out of 1.12 lakh locations

across the state. This increase has been made from minimum 5 percent to 20 percent maximum.

7.19 percent rate increased in Bhopal

Average 7.19 percent guideline i.e. collector rate has been increased at 1443 locations in Bhopal city. With this, property has become the most expensive in Kolar, Salaiya, Ayodhya Bypass and Misrod. Here the rates have increased from 25 percent to 94 percent. Along with this, the lands of 22 colonies situated in the areas adjacent to the city will also be registered according to the new guidelines. The registrar has issued an order to increase the new rates on Wednesday evening.

Property of these areas become expensive

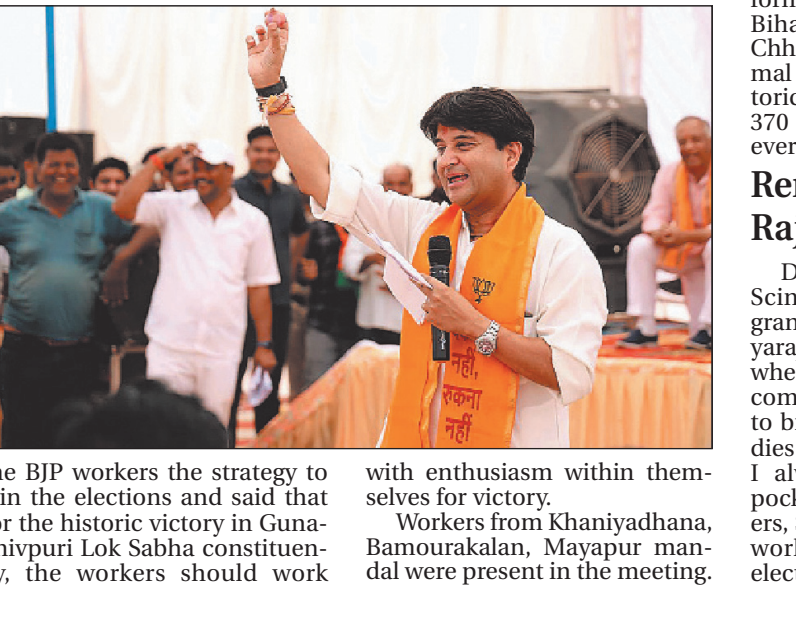

Deploy extra force in sensitive areas: CEO

Bhopal: CEO Anupam Rajan has directed that special attention should be given to all the sensitive areas of the state. Additional force should also be deployed here as per requirement to increase vigilance.

Rajan reviewed the activities of the inter-state and intra-state checkpoints established in the state and asked the police officers to activate all these checkpoints. He told to increase the number of staff here and monitor every activity.

Rajan said that the monitoring system of flying squad and surveillance team (SST) prepared in the context of elections should be made more effective. He instructed these teams to act promptly and review their work daily.

Rajan gave instructions to give proper training to all police officers and employees engaged in elections. He said that in the training, policemen should also be told about their official duties and the prescribed procedure to be followed to fulfill these duties. Rajan told the police officers that a border meeting should be organized between the police officers of the bordering districts of Madhya Pradesh and the district level police

officers of the bordering states. Police officers of both the states should ensure that all necessary restrictive actions are taken within the time limit.

My son was beaten up: Minister Narendra Patel

Bhopal: The issue of assault on the son of Minister of State for Health Narendra Shivaji Patel in Bhopal has started heating up. Now Minister Patel's statement has come to light. In which he has accused the police of brutally beating his son.

Patel said that at the time of the incident, his son Abhigyan was accompanied by four other associates but the police beat only his son. He further said that he had gone to the police station in his capacity as a father and not as a minister. He didn't even take his gun with him. The wife also went to the police station along



with him. Patel said that the policemen had threatened his son and said that you may be the son of a minister but we are the goons here.

There was a dispute in a restaurant

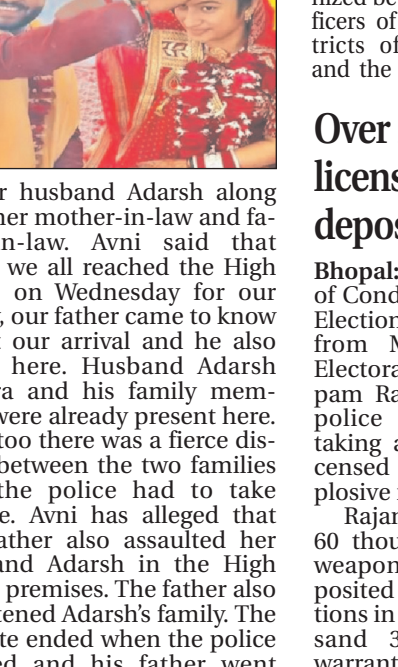

The girl's father is a secretary in MP Congress and the youth is a priest in the Mahakal temple.

Girl Avni Shukla says that her father Ravi Shukla does not like the marriage of me and my husband Adarsh Mishra. He is a big leader of Congress. A month has passed since our marriage but we are continuously receiving threats. Both of us are very upset. The girl released a video and also said that she is afraid for the safety



of her husband Adarsh along with her mother-in-law and father-in-law. Avni said that when we all reached the High Court on Wednesday for our safety, our father came to know about our arrival and he also came here. Husband Adarsh Mishra and his family members were already present here. Here too there was a fierce dispute between the two families and the police had to take charge. Avni has alleged that her father also assaulted her husband Adarsh in the High Court premises. The father also threatened Adarsh's family. The dispute ended when the police arrived and his father went back.

Over 2.60 lakh licensed weapons deposited

Bhopal: The Model Code of Conduct for Lok Sabha Elections-2024 is effective from March 16. Chief Electoral Officer Shri Anupam Rajan said that the police are continuously taking action to seize licensed weapons and explosive material.

Rajan said that 2 lakh 60 thousand 74 licensed weapons have been deposited in the police stations in the state. 22 thousand 306 non-bailable warrants have also been served in the state.
