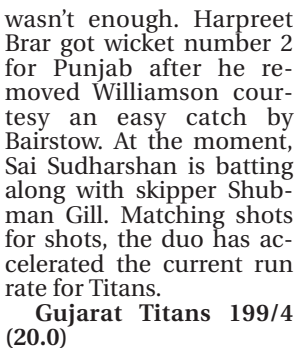
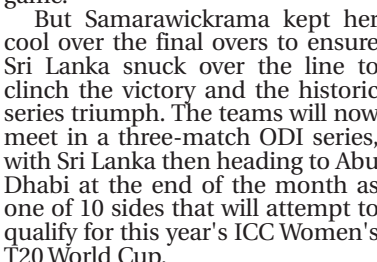


# Gujarat Titans post 199/4 in 20 overs vs Punjab Kings



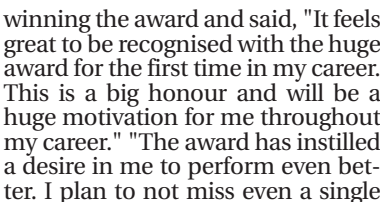

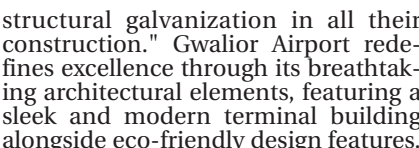

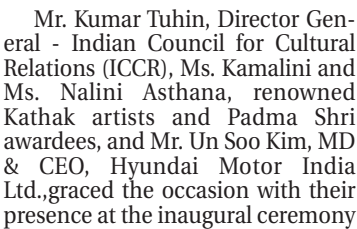
