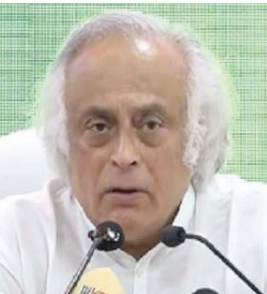

## Over 87 pc pass in Class 8 exam, 91 pc in Class 5

Bhopal: State Education Center Madhya Pradesh released the results of class 5th and 8th board exams on Tuesday.

With that, the wait of about 24 lakh students was finally over. The result of class 8 was 87.71% while the result of class V was 90.97%.

This year, around 24 lakh students appeared in the class 5th and 8th board exams across Madhya Pradesh.

The pass percentage in government schools in class five was 91.53%, while in private schools, 90.18% children passed. 73.26% children passed in madrasas.

The pass percentage of class eight government schools was 86.22%, while 90.60% children passed in private schools. The pass percentage of madrasas was 67.40%.



In class five, the pass percentage in rural schools was 92.60%, while in urban schools 86.19% children passed. Similarly, 88.35 percent children of rural schools passed in class eight. At the same time,

only 86.04 percent children in urban schools passed class 8th.

Along with the results, State Education Center will also share the merit list and other relevant details.

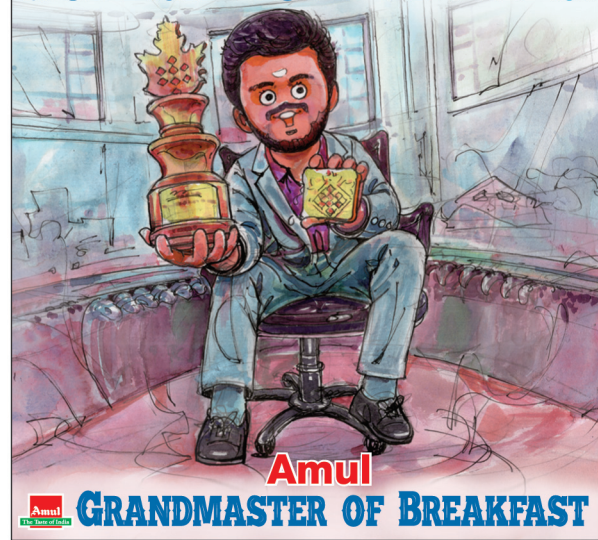
To pass the MP Board Class 5 and Class 8 board exams, students are required to score at least 33% marks out of the total marks. Apart from this, it is also necessary to score 33% in every subject.

### Class-10, 12 results to be declared today

The MP Board of Secondary Education (MPBSE) has announced that the results for classes 10 and 12, along with the Diploma in Pre-school Education (DPSE), will be declared on Wednesday, April 24. The results will be announced at 4 pm, as per the official announcement.

### Massive fire breaks out at multi-storey building

Howrah: A massive fire broke out at a multi-storied building in the North Howrah district on Tuesday. As per officials, "Five fire tenders reached the spot and dousing operations are currently underway." The reason for the fire is yet to be ascertained. No casualties or injuries have been reported in the fire incident so far.

### FIR registered against BJP MLAs

Mumbai: The Maharashtra government on Tuesday informed the Bombay High Court that criminal cases have been registered against BJP MLA Nitesh Rane for giving alleged hate speeches in different parts of Mumbai, such as Malwani, Mankhurd, Ghatkopar. FIR (first information report) has also been registered against MLA Gita Jain for alleged hate speech in Mira-Bhayander town from January to March this year.

Kangra: Hanuman Jayanti was celebrated here on Tuesday with religious fervor and enthusiasm. On this occasion, a Hanuman Temple was inaugurated inside the Kangra Police station with much fanfare and bhajan and kirtan. ## Half of INDI alliance leaders in jail, half on bail: JP Nadda

Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) President JP Nadda said on Tuesday that half of the leaders of the INDI alliance are in jail, half are on bail, and Prime Minister Narendra Modi's anti-corruption campaign will intensify after June 4.

Addressing an election meeting in Tikamgarh, Madhya Pradesh, in sup-

port of the party candidate, Nadda said that the culture and thinking of politics have changed under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Ten years ago, everyone said it would be like this; nothing would change. Today, even the common man is saying that the country has changed.

State Party President Bishnu Dutt Sharma was among several other party leaders present at the meeting.

Nadda said if Modi becomes Prime Minister again, India will become the third-largest economy in two years. Nadda said this time the people have to choose between two ideologies. On one side, there are people engaged in development of the country under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and on the other side, there are people who are engaged in protecting their families and corrupt people.

### New version of Medium-Range Ballistic Missile successfully launched

New Delhi: A new variant of a Medium-Range Ballistic Missile was successfully launched on Tuesday, a Defence Ministry statement said.

The launch was carried out under the aegis of the Strategic Forces Command. The user launch has proven the operational capability of the Command and validated new technologies, the statement added.

Earlier on April 18, the DRDO conducted a successful flight-test of Indigenous Technology Cruise Missile (ITCM). The flight of the missile was monitored from the Su-30-Mk-I aircraft of the Indian Air Force. The missile was equipped with advanced avionics and software to ensure better and reliable performance. The ITCM followed the desired path using way point navigation and demonstrated very low altitude sea-skimming flight.

## SC widens its ambit on misleading Patanjali ads; blames IMA, others for misguiding public

Supreme Court on Tuesday took note that Patanjali's Founder Baba Ramdev has issued a public apology in 67 newspapers after its last order.

A bench comprising Justice Hima Kohli and Justice Ahsanuddin Amanullah asked Ramdev to file a proper affidavit in this regard.

The apex court remarked on the tiny size advertisement of apology published by Ramdev and said, "your apology should also have been as your advertisements."

The bench said, "You are more concerned about the revenue than the content of the apology in your advertisement, and showed its displeasure on the tiny advertisements placed at non prominent places of advertisements."

I had put the truth before the country that Congress is hatching a deep conspiracy to snatch your property and distribute it to its special people. I exposed



their vote bank and appeasement politics. After all, why is Congress so afraid of the truth?" the Prime Minister said.

PM Modi also asked what would have happened if there was a Congress government at the centre after 2014.

### PM to hold road show in Bhopal today

Bhopal: Prime Minister Narendra Modi will hold a roadshow on Wednesday evening in Bhopal Lok Sabha constituency. It will be PM Modi's second roadshow in Madhya Pradesh and the fifth visit to the state in the last 18 days.

The road show will cover a distance of 1.5 km from the old Vidhan Sabha to New Market area. It will commence around 7 pm, Bhopal Commissioner of Police Harinarayanachari Mishra said.

Parmar expressed his determination to clean up the river and restore its purity.

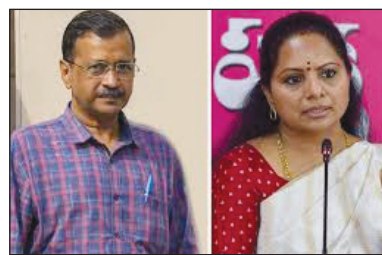

## Delhi Court extends judicial custody of Kejriwal, K Kavitha

New Delhi (UNI)

A Special Court in Delhi on Tuesday extended the judicial custody of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Bharat Rashtia Samithi (BRS) leader K Kavitha till May 7 in the Delhi Excise Policy case. They were arrested by the Enforcement Directorate under the provisions of Prevention of Money Laundering Act. Special Judge Kaweri Baweja extended their custody after they were produced through video conferencing on expiry of their judicial custody.

Kavitha, the daughter of former Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao was arrested by ED on March 15, while Arvind Kejriwal was arrested on March 21. The court has extended the judicial custody of Kavitha in both the cases registered by the ED and Central Bureau of In-



vestigation (CBI).

Special Judge Baweja Monday rejected Kejriwal's application seeking daily 15 minutes of medical consultation with his doctor. The judge directed that necessary medical treatment be provided and in case of requirement of any special consultation, Tihar jail authorities should consult a medical board consisting of the AIIMS doctors.



and Acharya Balkrishna were present before the court today. The Supreme Court also pulled up the Indian Medical Association Doctors for randomly endorsing Medicines/Health products in Allopathic field. The bench remarked at IMA, "When you are pointing one finger at

The Bench said that "it will widen its ambit and its order will now be applied to all FMCGs and Drug companies. We are not gunning a particular company, but all the issues affecting the general public, especially babies and school going kids."

The court questioned the authorities saying, why Rule 170 (prohibited advertisements without state licensing authority, approval) put on hold.

"It is an arbitrary colourable exercise, We want an explanation on this," the bench said.

The bench impleaded I & B, consumer Affairs Ministries, Drug Licensing Authorities of all the states and asked them to reply in this regard.
