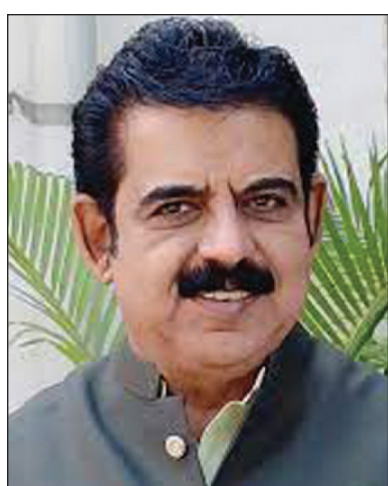


Will strengthen road, rail and metro network: Lalwani

Question: What are the priorities regarding Indore?

Answer: We will strengthen the road, rail and metro network for Indore and surrounding areas. Will further improve traffic. For this we have made short term, medium term and long term plans. For the first time after independence, a large number of over bridges are being built. Many of these are being made by the

Central Government. To supply water, they are bringing the fourth phase of Narmada. Its DPR has been prepared. Have sent it to the Center and will get it approved by the state also. Elevated corridor is being built by LIG. Approval of Rs 350 crore has been received for this. There are some issues, we will resolve them and get this started soon.

Question: Rail projects connected to Indore are still incomplete. Why was the adequate budget not received?

Answer: Indore has received the highest budget this time in its history after independence. Indore-Khandwa, Indore-Dahod and Indore-Budhani-Jabalpur will be completed in the coming one and a half years. Talking about Indore-Manmad, till now it was being built by Shipping Corporation but now it is being built by Railways. Its DPR has been prepared. Soon that plan will also be completed.

Question: Why did the new international flight not start?

Answer: Till now three international flights have started from Indore. International flights start according to commercial de-

mand. New flights will also start soon.

Question: How much development work was done in Adarsh Gram?

Answer: We have done good work in whatever Adarsh Gram (Model villages) we have adopted. The central team has also praised it and has also videographed it. Some work still remains in the village that was adopted last. That too will be completed soon.

Question: How do you see the organization giving you a second chance?

Answer: The organization has its own process for selecting candidates. He is selected accordingly. I have been selected considering my work. I will live up to the expectations of the organization.

Question: How much benefit will we get from the Ram Mandir issue?

Answer: We do not do politics of religion. There is enthusiasm among the people about the establishment of Ram temple. It was constructed due to the efforts of Prime Minister Modi and during his tenure, hence people have an emotional attachment to it. We will definitely benefit from it.

Anger of Cong workers comes to fore in Indore

Withdrawal of nomination by Akshay Bam

Before the voting of the third phase of Lok Sabha elections-2024, a big development took place in Indore on Monday which attracted the attention of not only Indore but the entire country. What happened is that Congress candidate from Indore Lok Sabha seat, Akshay Bam, has withdrawn his nomination form.

After this, there is no Congress candidate left before BJP candidate Shankar Lalwani. After this, the anger of Congress workers has started coming to the fore.

Acting President of Indore City Congress Committee, Devendra, said, "The grassroots workers, who had been struggling for the party for years, were not given a chance and tickets were given to rich and influential people. I had also asked for tickets, but the party gave tickets to powerful people instead of grassroots workers like us, the consequences of which are in front of the party today."

Congress Indore District President and other leaders said, "We already knew that Akshay Bam would withdraw his name. When there was a meeting at Gandhi Bhawan, I had told all the leaders that Akshay Bam would surely withdraw his name. But the high command did not listen to anyone and the entire Congress is facing the consequences."

According to Congress leaders, Akshay Bam was engaged in campaigning at 6-7 in the morning. Even then he was told by party

workers not to join BJP. Then Akshay said that he was not going anywhere.

Congress district president said, "I wanted to contest myself, but the party high command did not give permission. If I had been given permission, the Congress worker would have been contesting election today."

He further said, "Now Congress will have to think that they give tickets to people who have come from the Bharatiya Janata Party, party gives posts only to them. Congress put forward only those with money. If Congress gives a chance to the workers, then such a situation will not arise."

Congress candidate Akshay Kanti Bam has joined BJP. On the other hand, Congress suspects that Bam had made a deliberate mistake while filling the form. He had written independent candidate in the form.

Akshay was threatened: Patwari

Addressing the issue, Congress state president Jitu Patwari asserted, "Three days ago, section 307 was invoked in an old case against Akshay Kanti Bam. He was intimidated, threatened, and subjected to torment throughout the night. After this, today, he was escorted by the BJP and his nomination was withdrawn."

Meanwhile, a significant number of Congress leaders gathered at the office District Election Office in the Indore Collectorate on Monday, expressing fears that officials are being influenced by BJP pressures.

Notice sent to Collector-SP

High Court seeks reply in four weeks

In the case of fake liquor bank guarantee of the district, High Court Jabalpur has issued notice to Principal Secretary Commercial Tax and Excise Commissioner, along with Collector-SP and sought reply within four weeks.

The case of fake bank guarantee amounting to Rs 15 crore has become a pain in the neck for the officials. The petition was filed by Brijendra Kumar in Jabalpur High Court.

While hearing the matter on April 24, the court has given instructions to submit the reply within four weeks. The case was defended by Advocate Amit Singh. To get the liquor contract, District Cooperative Bank Morba Singrauli gave a fake performance guarantee.

The liquor contractor met the bank and prepared forged documents and obtained bank guarantee. While hearing the case, the double bench of Chief Justice Ravi Malimath and Justice Vishal Mishra has issued notices to Principal Secretary Commercial Tax, Excise Commissioner, Collector Rewa, SP and Economic Offenses SP Rewa and directed them to submit their reply within four weeks.

Congress suffers loss due to defection program of Sanjay Shukla and Vishal Patel

Bhopal: Two former Congress MLAs — Sanjay Shukla and Vishal Patel — are now BJP leaders. They have to prove their usefulness to the BJP. Sanjay Shukla and Vishal Patel, who are called brothers-in-law, organized a mega defection event in the presence of the Chief Minister. Sources say that many officials and leaders of Indore area number 1 and 4 took membership of BJP before the Chief Minister. Similarly, due to the efforts of Vishal Patel, many district representatives, Sarpanchs and councilors of Nagar Panchayats of Depalpur took membership of BJP. Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav had come to Indore to file the nomination papers of BJP candidate and MP Shankar Lalwani. Depalpur BJP MLA Manoj Patel is not digesting

Vishal Patel's entry into BJP at all. Vishal Patel has not even been invited to the BJP meetings held in Depalpur for the Lok Sabha elections. Here Sanjay Shukla is also not liked by a section of BJP in area number one. However, due to the defection before the Chief Minister, Congress has suffered losses in Depalpur and area number one.

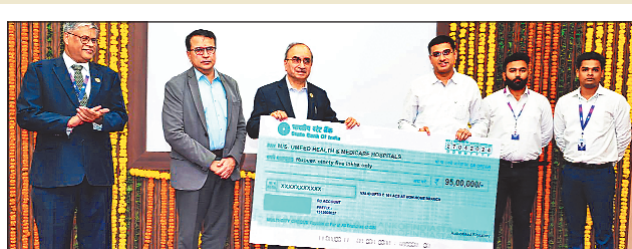

Close contest between Congress's Baraiya and BJP's Sandhya Rai

Cong made BJP's electoral path somewhat difficult by making leader Phool Singh Baraiya its candidate from Bhind Datia Lok Sabha constituency

Bhind-Datia Lok Sabha seat of Gwalior-Chambal division has been a stronghold of BJP for more than three decades. From here, BJP has been fighting for victory in every election to continuously increase its victory margin. The BJP, which has been winning continuously for three decades, may be trying its best to register its presence among the public on the basis of Modi's guarantee by claiming victory in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, but somewhere deep inside it is also doubtful.



Phool Singh Baraiya Sandhya Rai

Baraiya is his candidate from Bhind Datia Lok Sabha constituency.

In fact, despite all the efforts, BJP is not able to prove Congress candidate Phool Singh Baraiya as an outsider candidate. The reason is that Baraiya comes from Sukand village of Gormi tehsil of Mehgaon assembly constituency of Bhind district, where Baraiya's family members have been residents ancestrally for generations. Baraiya cannot be underestimated even in terms of his education level, he has done BE in Mechanical. Baraiya does not need any introduction in the Bhind-Datia region, ever since he started his political career as an ordinary worker in the initial phase of the establishment of BSP four decades ago and has been known for his organizational skills and

his ability to help the weakest of the society. Due to his association with BSP, he not only made BSP strong in the state but also got a dozen seats for this party during his state presidency in the 1993 assembly elections. To take advantage of this organizational ability of Baraiya, Congress has made him contest Assembly elections twice and Rajya Sabha elections once. Baraiya claims that the continuously increasing support base in his public relations confirms his chances of victory.

Now talking about BJP, BJP has the strong support of Modi's guarantee to stop Congress's victory campaign in Bhind-Datia. BJP has a large army of workers and senior leaders, with the help of which BJP is claiming victory. According to analysts who keep a close eye on the politics of Bhind, BJP candidate Sandhya Rai, originally a resident of neighboring Morena district, does not know much of anyone except a few leaders and limited workers of her party, this is the reason why BJP is not popular among the people. BJP leaders and workers are trying their best to suppress the voices of protest being raised

regarding the candidate. After all, people are people, they get a chance to express their views only at the time of elections every five years, this is the reason why local voters are openly expressing their views to the candidates of different parties who are coming to seek votes. There are many questions of the public to which the candidates and their election managers have no answers.

Congress fielded Imarti Devi and Devashish, both of them left the party - One aspect is that Congress is being said to have a big cadre in the name of organization but except a few people as an exception, who is doing what? No one knows this except the election managers. Congress has been using unique experiments in every election to capture Bhind seat. Ater's firebrand leader Satyadev Katara was contested twice and once senior journalist Udayan Sharma, a friend of late Rajiv Gandhi, was also fielded. Ever since this seat was reserved for the Scheduled Caste category, Congress placed its bets on Dalit leaders like Imarti Devi and Devashish Jararia, but both of them had to face defeat by a huge margin.
