Survey being conducted using scientific method



In these, heart and lungs were transplanted to patients of Ahmedabad, both kidneys and liv-

er were transplanted to patients of Indore. For this, the 56th Green Corridor was created. One corridor was built for the hospital and the other for the airport. Brain death was certified by a four-member medical team.

The second green corridor from Jupiter Hospital for kidney special to Choithram Hospital was started at 8:58 pm and reached at 9:05 pm. In the case of organ donation, for the first time in the whole of India, the practice of providing the dead body along with post-mortem and Panchna ma to the family in a medico-legal case was started in Indore. On behalf of the administration, Medical Officer Dr. Amit Atre and on behalf of the police administration, ACP Traffic Police Kiran Kumar Sharma provided the post-mortem and Panchnama report to the family.

Outer border geo-fencing distance restriction removed

In view of the convenience of passengers, the restriction of outer limit geo-fencing distance for journey ticket and platform ticket in UTS on mobile app has been abolished

with immediate effect. Senior Divisional Commercial Manager Saurabh Kataria said that now railway users can book unreserved tickets and platform tickets for any station from any station of Indian Railways sitting at home, while the internal limit of geo fencing remains unchanged i.e. only within the station premises.

Ticket booking will be allowed from outside only. Currently, this outer limit geo-fencing distance restriction was 50 km that is, any passenger could book an unreserved ticket or platform ticket for travel from a station located within a radius of 50 km from the location of his mobile, but now this restriction has been removed For the convenience of passen gers traveling on unreserved tickets, Indian Railways is pro-viding the facility of booking unreserved tickets through smart phones with internet connection.
