

In such a situation, it is believed that if even 3 or 4 people from MP get a chance to become ministers at the center, it will be a big thing. If we look at MP, Shivraj Singh Chauhan is a natural contender to become a minister at the center.

Similarly, activities will be undertaken for the cleanliness and conservation of 54 wells and 42 step wells of Bhopal with public cooperation. Water from these water sources will also be used appropriately. Mayor Bhopal Smt. Rai said that better maintenance of water sources will also increase the beautification of Bhopal.
