In regional balance, Virendra Kumar prevailed over VD Sharma, Kulaste eliminated

The picture of MP's faces in the central government has become clear. Despite the compulsions and constraints of coalition dharma, MP has got full attention from the central leadership, five ministers from MP have been included in the cabinet at once, after a long time a woman from MP has also got a chance, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had already said during the election campaign that he would take Chouhan with him to Delhi. Here, the newly elected MP from Guna Scindia also had no confusion about becoming a minister in the center, both of them were natural contenders.

Virendra Kumar's experience came in handy once again. This is also because Virendra Kumar comes from the Scheduled Caste. There is a large population of this class in Bundelkhand, secondly this area is adjacent to Uttar Pradesh, where there is a large

population of SC class. The Lok Sabha results in Uttar Pradesh were not as per the expectations of BJP. A big reason behind this was the shift of Dalit votes. A large section of Dalits had come to the BJP's side in 2019, but this time it shifted towards Samajwadi Party and Congress.

In such a situation, once again BJP is facing the challenge of wooing Dalits. 8-time MP Virendra Kumar got the benefit of this and he got preference over VD Sharma. When speculations were made about the MPs joining the Union Cabinet from the state, there was no mention of low profile MP Durgadas Uike from Betul parliamentary constituency, but to woo the caste, Uike got more preference over former Union Minister Fag-gan Singh Kulaste. Whereas from the women's quota, after Sushma Swaraj and Uma Bharti, Dhar MP Savitri Thakur has been made a minister.

Gwalior lost due to delay in candidate selection and distance of big leaders

Congress leaders and workers surprised by defeat in Gwalior

Gwalior seat was special among the seats from which Congress had the highest hopes of victory in the Lok Sabha elections in the state, but the defeat by 70 thousand votes in Gwalior has surprised the local senior leaders of Congress, from workers to policy makers handling important responsibilities in the election campaign.

Now the brainstorming has started in the party on the reasons for the defeat. Efforts are also on to prove one's role in the election campaign cleanly by putting the responsibility of defeat on each other. However, this question is still unanswered that, despite putting all the strength in the campaign and strong claims of taking all sections along, what was lacking was that the party lost the winning game. Although a defeat by 70 thousand votes is not considered a big defeat in a Lok Sabha election fought on a broad canvas, the party is regretting the defeat on this seat for the fifth time in a row. In the assembly elections held seven months ago, Congress and BJP had won four seats each out of the eight assembly seats in this Lok Sabha constituency, but the contest was tied.

As soon as the assembly elections were over, Congress started preparing for the Lok Sabha elections and no matter who the candidate was, the responsibilities of the local leaders and workers were fixed, but as the Lok Sabha elections came closer, all the coordination fell apart.

With the announcement of Praveen Pathak being made the candidate, a big rift was seen in the party. Ramevak Babuji, who was an MP, had asked for a ticket from Gwalior Rural in the assembly elections, at that time he was promised a Lok Sabha ticket but his assembly ticket was cut, Ramevak had started preparing to contest the Lok Sabha since then but citing a young and highly educated father, the ticket was given to Praveen Pathak in the Lok Sabha battle. Angry Ramevak Babuji not only stayed at home but also talked about quitting active politics.

Congress candidate Praveen Pathak tried to convince him but his anger did not go away. On the other hand, Udayveer Singh, son of the angry former MP and a person who has held many posts in the Congress organization joined the BJP.

Congress, which was fighting the BJP in the Lok Sabha election campaign, got another big shock when the acting district president of the rural Congress Kalyan Singh Kansana bid goodbye to the party and took a ticket from the BSP and directly made a dent in the traditional vote bank of his old party. He kept making dents in the traditional vote bank of the Congress with a big plan and the Congress candidates, instead of taking him seriously or making a counter strategy, kept ignoring him by calling BSP the B team of the BJP.

This is why Congress lost here:

Praveen Pathak and Bharat Kushwaha

Praveen Pathak as its candidate only after the first week of April passed while BJP started its campaign with full vigor as its candidate was declared, thus Congress lagged behind by more than a month in the campaign. Many big leaders including Chief Minister Mohan Yadav, State President VD Sharma, Narendra Singh Tomar, Shivraj Singh Chauhan, Jyotiraditya Scindia were involved in BJP's campaign but no big leader came here to campaign for Congress. Rahul and Priyanka Gandhi held meetings in Bhand and Morena seats but they did not bother to come to Gwalior and hold a meeting. There was a lack of coordination between the District Congress Committee and Congress candidate Praveen Pathak. With the announcement of Pathak's name, the displeasure of Congress District President Dr. Devendra Sharma came to the fore. Party sources said that an important decision like the selection of Lok Sabha candidate was not taken by taking the District Congress Committee into confidence. However, in the background of the displeasure of District President Dr. Sharma, it was said that he himself was a serious contender for the ticket. Although the city district Congress president was seen campaigning for the party, the distance did not end. Since the Congress candidate was from the Brahmin class, some Brahmin organizations linked his candidature to the pride and identity of the Brahmin community, as a result some other social classes became angry with the Congress, due to which the Congress had to bear the brunt.

Praveen could not dominate his own assembly constituency

Political experts had estimated that Congress would improve its position in the urban area, but despite having four MLAs, the performance of the Congress was neither good in the urban area nor in the rural area. The performance of the Congress candidate in his own assembly constituency Gwalior South was disappointing, here Praveen got only 69797 votes while Bharat Singh Kushwaha got 88250 votes. Praveen's performance was definitely excellent in both these assembly constituencies, with a lead of 83672 votes against Bharat Singh's 70524 in Dabra and 75898 votes against 70000 in Bhitwar. Even though there is a Congress MLA in Gwalior Rural, Praveen lagged behind by 444 votes. Congress candidates did not appear very strong in Pohri and Karera either.

MR-12 road will be built in Indore for Simhastha

Indore Development Authority is constructing MR-12 road. At present, two kilometers of road has been built in pieces. The construction of the remaining more than ten kilometers will be completed in two years. On Thursday, IDA Chief Executive Officer RP Ahirwar visited and saw the obstructing constructions on the road.

This road will be built in front of Aurobindo Hospital. Its other end will be connected near Prakash Petrol Pump on AB Road. Traffic coming

from Dewas-Bhopal will be able to reach Sanwer Road directly through this road. Four years ago also, the process of its construction was started, but due to hundreds of obstructing constructions, the matter was put on hold. Now, in view of the Simhastha fair, a decision has been taken to build this road. The construction of this road can also boost the real estate market of Niranjapur, Lasudia area.

Right now, heavy vehicles go towards Ujjain via MR-10 road from MR-11 link road. Currently, a part

of the road has been built in the Kurmedi area.

Ahirwar said that the width of this road will be 60 meters. A railway bridge and a bridge on the Kanha river will also be constructed on this route.

With the construction of this road, the traffic pressure in the urban part of Indore will be reduced during the Simhastha fair. This road is proposed in the master plan of the year 2021.
