### Heatwave: Red alert issued in Delhi

New Delhi: The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a red alert warning for Delhi as severe heatwave conditions continue to prevail over northern parts of the country, including the national capital. This year, the city witnessed a prolonged heatwave, recording temperatures of 40°C and above for more than 30 consecutive days. "Heatwave to severe heatwave conditions are likely to continue over many parts of North India during the next 2 days and gradually abate thereafter under the influence of an approaching Western Disturbance towards Northwest India," the IMD said on Monday.

### Shah to review security situation in Manipur



New Delhi: A day after reviewing the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir, Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Monday was to chair a high-level meeting here to review the security situation in Manipur. The meeting, scheduled to take place at 4pm, was to be attended by senior officials from the Centre, Manipur government, Army and other security forces. The Centre has made it clear that there will be zero tolerance for any terror spewing entities in the country.

## Militant killed in J&K's Bandipora

Srinagar: Security forces shot dead a militant in Jammu and Kashmir's Bandipora district, Army said on Monday. They said an unidentified militant was killed in a joint operation which was launched last night at Gurihajin, Aragam in Bandipora, following a specific input. "Based on specific intelligence input regarding presence of terrorists, a Joint Operation was launched by #IndianArmy & @JmuKmrPolice on the intervening night of 16-17 June 24 in general area of Gurihajin 24 in general area of Gurihajin, Aragam Bandipora; one terrorist eliminated, operation in progress," Army's Srinagar based Chinar Corps said in a post on X.

## Re-densification plan of 1250 quarters cancelled


Bhopal: The Commissioner of Madhya Pradesh Housing and Infrastructure Development Board has issued an order on Monday and cancelled the proposed re-densification plan on the land of 1250 quarters located in Bhopal. After the cancellation of the proposal, the alternative site will be examined. As per the order issued on Monday, keeping in view the environmental protection and the existing trees in the area, the proposed project has been rejected after thorough consideration. Along with this, instructions have been given to test other alternative locations. While preparing the alternative proposal, instructions have been given to have extensive discussions with environmentalists, local public representatives and citizens at the initial stage itself. Keeping in view the shortage of employee housing, the plan prepared under the Re-densification Policy 2022 to prepare a preliminary project in place of dilapidated and unusable houses of 1250 quarters Bhopal and presented at the government level has been can-

# Kanchanjunga Exp in Darjeeling distt

Kolkata/New Delhi (UNI)
A goods train smashed into the back of a stationary passenger train in West Bengal's Darjeeling district on Monday, killing eight people and injuring over two dozen. Northeast injuring over two dozen, Northeast Frontier Railway bulletin said, in an accident that railway authorities blamed on a disregarded signal. The Sealdah-bound Kanchanjun-

ga Express left Agartala on Sunday and was scheduled to reach its destination by Monday evening, when around 8.55 am it met with the accident about 10 km away from the New Jalpaiguri (NJP) railway station, when many passengers aboard were yet to start their day.

The passenger train was hit by a goods train carrying containers between Raninagar and Chaterhat station under the Katihar division of the NFRailway.

Four coaches of the rear side of the express train and five wagons of the impact of the crash that Chairman & CEO Railway Board Jaya Var-ma Sinha, said: "Prima facie suggests human error as the cause. The first indications suggest that this is a case of signal disregard. Kavach needs to proliferate, as planned for West Bengal."
Both Up and Down lines were

The central government announced an enhanced ex-gratia of Rs 10 lakh to the next of kin of each deceased. The announcement was made by Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw in a social media post on X. The minister was expected to be at the accident site later in the day.

### **DEADLIEST COLLISIONS** IN THE PAST 10 YEARS

■ Chennai Train Collision (2014): On April 1, 2014, a collision occurred between a passenger train and a stationary train at the Chennai Beach station in Tamil Nadu. The accident caused the death of 9 people and injured several others.

Kanpur Train Derailment (2016): Ôn Nov 20, 2016, the Indore-Patna Express derailed near Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh. The train was traveling at high speed when it derailed, resulting in 150 fatalities and numerous injuries. It was one of the deadliest train accidents in India in recent times.

Pukhrayan Train Derailment (2016): On Nov 20, 2016, another train derailment occurred in Pukhrayan, Uttar Pradesh. Fourteen coaches of the Indore-Rajendranagar Express derailed, leading to the loss of 152 lives and injuring many passengers.

Jagdalpur-Bhubaneswar Hirak-

hand Express Derailment (2017): On Jan 21, 2017, the Jagdalpur-Bhubaneswar Hirakhand Express derailed in Andhra Pradesh. The train derailed near Kuneru station, claiming the lives of 41 people and injuring several others.

Khatauli Train Derailment

(2017): On Aug 19, 2017, the Kalinga Utkal Express derailed near Khatauli in Uttar Pradesh. The accident resulted in 23 deaths and numerous injuries. The derailment was attributed to a track fracture caused by maintenance negli-

Maharashtra Train Collision (2020): On Oct 16, 2020, two trains collided near Karmad, Maharashtra. The trains involved were the Hyderabad-Mumbai CSMT Express and the Hazur Sahib Nanded-Mumbai CSMT Rajdhani Special. The accident resulted in 16 fatalities and many injuries.

Bikaner-Guwahati Express derailment (2022): On Jan 13, 2022, 12 coaches of the Bikaner-Guwahati Express derailed in West Bengal's Alipurduar, killing 9 and leaving 36 others injured.
