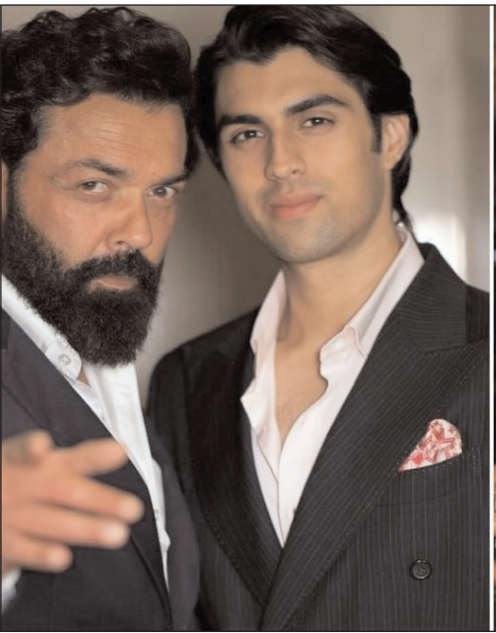


Bobby Deol reveals being 'more scared' of Sunny Deol as a kid than dad Dharmendra
