Budget will be prepared with advice of public

Finance Minister Devda addresses dialogue programme

Deputy Chief Minister Jagdish Devda has said that the economy of Madhya Pradesh is fully dynamic. Strategies are being made to maintain the pace of infrastructural development along with capital expenditure. For the first time, we are going to prepare the budget of Madhya Pradesh 2024-25 with the suggestions of the public. Right now we are taking suggestions from experts.

After this, we will also try to take suggestions from the general pubthrough social media. He was addressing a dialogue program with subject experts for the preparation of the state's budget at the Academy of Administration on Wednesďay.

Devda said that for the first time in Madhya Pradesh, suggestions have been sought from all sections of the society for budget preparation to make the budget according to the expectations of the citizens and to fulfill their development plans.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has set a target of taking the coun-try's economy to 5 trillion dollars. This will also include the notable contribution of Madhya Pradesh



under the leadership of Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav. With the guidance received from dynamic Finance Minister Nirmala Šitharaman, the financial management of Madhya Pradesh has proved to be better. On this occasion, Principal Secretary Manish Singh, Secretary Ajit Kumar, Director Budget Bikki Karthikeyan, Deputy Secretary Rajiv Ranjan Meena, Deputy Secretary Frank Nobel and Finance Department officials were present.

These suggestions were given by budget experts

Focus on digital literacy: Reserve Bank of India Bhopal GM Hemant Soni said that there is a need to focus on climate risk, adequate storage space, financial and digital literacy for farmers and students. There should be more provision in the budget for this.

Focus on irrigation sector: NABARD Deputy General Manager Nandu J. Naik said that there is a need to focus on the irrigation sector. There is a need to increase horticulture and micro irrigation and the import market. Work should be done in the logistics and corporate sector.

Capital expenditure will have to be **increased:** Prof. C. Pratap Ranjan Jaina of National Institute of Public Finance and Policy, New Delhi suggested increasing capital expenditure in various sectors. He said that there is a need to take forward investment in all the sectors that increase the state's GDP.

Keep funds for women's safety: UN Women India Deputy Country Representative Kanta Singh said that Madhya Pradesh has done a great job for the gender budget. More

funds should be given for women's safety and care welding economics. Focus on climate change: Prof. Yogesh Dubey of Indian Forest Management Institute Bhopal stressed on making a separate budget for forests and water. Wildlife and environment and climate change should be kept in mind.

Additional budget for development: Senior Economic Advisor of Home Ministry, Government of India, V Pratap suggested that additional budget should be kept for investment in development work being done in various areas of infrastructure. Apart from this, attention should be paid to providing new employment opportunities.

Focus on children's development: Ms. Hyun Hee Ben, Chief Social Policy, UNICEF India Delhi praised the Madhya Pradesh government for doing good work for women's development. She suggested that more budget should be given for children's development.

Subsidy should be given on stamp duty: ČII's ex-Chairman Prof. Siddharth Chaturvedi said that there should be a provision for subsidv on stamp duty in this budget. Also, the government should consider connecting women with start-ups, health, research in education, skill and IT.

Remains of Bhojshala's pillar found

The team of Archaeological Survey of India conducted a continuous survey for the 90th day on Wednesday in the historic Bhojshala. 3 remains have been found in the excavation in the northern part. These are pieces of pillar and wall. The shape is not clear due to lack

of cleaning. So far 1800 small and big re-mains have been found. These include remains of 30 idols. A broken idol of Maa Vagdevi was found on June 9. The maximum 79 remains were found on this day. June 27 is

the last day of the survey. The survey was started in Bho-jshala from March 22. The important thing is that before July 4, ASI has to submit its report to the Indore Bench of the High Court, so the work of documentation has been expedited. Some experts have even prepared and submitted their reports. The report is being prepared by experts of other disci plines.

Videography and photography: Videography and photography are being done in the final phase of the survey as well. Especially at those places where the excavation has been done in the last phase On Wednesday, as part of the survey, excavation was done in the northern part, where 153 remains were kept years ago. These were shifted from here.

90 days of survey completed

Bhojshala Mukti Yagna coordinator Gopal Sharma and petitioner Ashish Goyal said that three remains have been found during excavation in the northern part. 90 days of survey work has been completed. Videography and photog raphy have been done in the inside part. Especially numbering and other works are being done. Now the report of the remains is also being prepared.

Liver transported 3.5 km away in 4 minutes CM, ministers, others to take

Liver, kidney transported 17 km away by creating 02 green corridors

Kidney transported 17 km away to Chirayu in 13 minutes

Patient was admitted in Siddhanta since 05 days

2 green corridors were created on Wednesday in the capital Bhopal to donate the liver and kidney of a brain dead patient. The first corridor was built from Siddhanta Red Cross Hospital in Shivaji Nagar to Bansal Hospital and the liver was transported covering a distance of 3.5 km in 4 minutes. The second corridor was built from Siddhanta to Chirayu Medical and the kidney was transported 17 km away in 13 minutes.

Mahesh Namdev (53), a resident of Sagar, was admitted to Siddhanta Red Cross Hospital 5 days ago for the treatment of brain hemorrhage. During the treatment, he went into a coma due to excessive bleeding in the brain. He became brain dead on Tuesday. After this, the family decided to donate his liver and kidney.

According to Siddhanta Hospital director Dr. Subodh Varshney, 53-year-old Mahesh Namdev, a resident of Sagar, had recovered from a heart attack. He had come to Bhopal for treatment of brain hemorrhage. He was admitted here 5 days ago. During the treat-



ment, he went into a coma due to excessive bleeding in the brain. After this, he became brain dead on Tuesday. After seeing the patient's medical report, the patient's family expressed their intention to donate liver and kidney. After this, as per the prescribed protocol, the committee of medical experts declared patient Mahesh Namdev brain dead.

Also, the patient's report was sent to the National Tissue and Transplant Organization. The liver was taken to Bansal Hospital and the kidney to Chirayu Hospital for transplant. Meanwhile, Additional DCP Traffic Bansat Kaul said that the first team of doctors from Bansal Hospital left Siddhanta Hospital with the liver at around 2.30 pm. The journey of 3.5 km was covered in four minutes. The second team left for Chirayu Medical College with the kidney at 2.35 pm. The distance of 17 km was covered in 13 minutes. The kidney transplant is to be done on a patient in Siddhanta Hospital itself.

About 10 minutes after the departure of both the teams, Mahesh Namdev's body was handed over to his family. The family left for Sagar with the body.

The attack came on the day he was to be discharged

Mahesh Namdev's son Sachendra Namdev said - We are residents of Maharaj of Sagar. Father used to do farming. His health deteriorated on Tuesday. He was admitted to Bhagyoday Hospital in Sagar. Doctors said that he had a heart attack. We brought him to Siddhanta Hospital in Bhopal. He underwent angioplasty here. He was fine for two-three days. On the day he was to be discharged, he suffered a brain hemorrhage. He also underwent surgery. Father died due to excessive bleeding.

Liver will be transplanted to a patient of Karond

Mahesh Namdev's liver will be transplanted to a 49-year-old patient of Karond admitted in Bansal Hospital. Doctors had advised the patient to undergo liver transplant surgery a year ago. But the surgery could not be performed due to the unavailability of an organ donor. Liver transplant surgeon Dr. Gursagar Singh Sahota will perform the surgery on the patient in the hospital.



Naveen Markam likely to be Cong candidate from Amarwara

Bhopal: The Amarwara assembly seat in Chhindwara is currently making headlines. The BJP and the Gondwana Gantantra Party (GGP) have already announced their candidates for the by-election. However, the Congress candidate remains undecided, leading to much speculation. According to sources, Naveen Markam is likely to be declared as the Congress candidate.

Several names have been circulating the p candidates, including Manuel Dburve, Champalal Kurche, Used DSP Ramculating as potential Congress Ganesh Das, retired DSP Ramnarayan Parteti, and Naveen Markam. Among them, Naveen Markam appears to be the frontrunner. Markam, a resident of Chhindi in Harrai, is currently serving as a district panchayat member. Sources suggest that his candidacy is almost confirmed. GGP, BJP announced their candi-

dates: The by-election for the Amarwara assembly seat in Chhindwara, Madhya Pradesh, is scheduled for July 10, igniting intense political activity. On Monday, the Gondwana Gantantra Party announced Dev Ravin Bhalavi as its candidate.

Meanwhile, the BJP has fielded Raja Kamlesh Shah. As for the Congress, they have yet to announce their candidate. To defeat the BJP and GGP, the Congress is carefully considering a strong candidate. While many names are being discussed, the final decision is eagerly awaited. Seat Vacated Due to Resignation

of Cong MLA: Kamlesh Shah, elected as the Congress MLA from Amarwara in 2023, recently switched allegiance to the BJP ahead of the Lok Sabha elections-2024, leading to his resignation and the subsequent vacancy of the seat.
