CM Dr. Yadav, Union Minister Yadav plant saplings in BSF range of Indore

Bhopal: Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav and Union Forest and Environment Minister Bhupendra Yadav participated in the plantation program in BSF range area of Indore on Sunday under the campaign "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam" and planted saplings in the memory of their mothers. CM Dr. Yadav planted a banyan tree in the memory of his mother Late Smt. Leelabai Shri Poonamchand Ji Yadav. Union Minister Shri Yadav planted a mango tree in the memory of his mother Late Smt. Santra Yadav, State Urban Bodies and Housing Minister Shri Kailash Vijayvargiya planted a mango tree in the memory of his mother Late Smt. Ayodhya Devi Vijayvargiya. CM Dr. Yadav said that since ancient times, Indore and Ujjain have had a special relationship with the environment. Indore is the place of origin of 7 rivers including Maa Kshipra. Indore has a special identity in the country and the world. Along with being a clean city, In-



dore will definitely become number one green city as well. CM Dr. Yadav was addressing the program organized for plantation of trees in Indore.

CM said that Indian society has always been a nature worshipper. It is said in the Vedic traditions of India that one tree is equal to 10 sons. Chief Minister Dr. Yadav said that Indore will become a green city along with being a clean city, with this resolution the whole of Indore is associated with this campaign.

Development works

Mentioning the gifts of development works from the stage, CM

said that Chintaman Ganesh Temple Road will be made a four lane. Chief Minister Dr. Yadav said that Mahakal Temple will be connected to Aurobindo College in Indore by a 42-kilometer-long metro line.

For regional development, transportation facilities, and traffic management, Ujjain-Dewas-Indore-Fatehabad will be connected by high-speed Vande Metro, which will lead to the all-round development of Ujjain along with all the surrounding districts.

By connecting Chintaman Ganesh Railway Station to Nagda, the transportation facility from cities like Delhi, Mumbai, etc. is being expanded for the convenience of the devotees in Simhastha. He said that the entire development of Ujjain will be as per Vaastu, due to which the district will remain prosperous forever.

Rozgar Diwas celebrated annually, but no outsourced employee regularized: Bhargava

Bhopal: The MP government has been celebrating Rozgar Diwas with great enthusiasm for the last 5 years, but out of the 25 lakh 83 thousand registered unemployed of the state registered on the employment panel, not a single one got regular employment at grade-3 or below in the last 5 years and neither were the experienced contract and outsourced employees working for many years in various government departments, undertakings and power sector of MP regularized.

In this regard, Provincial Convener of All Department Outsource Joint Sangharsh Morcha Manoj Bhargava and General Secretary Dinesh Sisodia appealed to the Chief Minister to regularize the contract workers of

the state as per the Assembly Election BJP Manifesto 2013 and immediately issue orders regarding giving contract appointment to outsourced employees of the state by implementing the promise shown on page number-81 of Assembly Election BJP Sankalp Patra 2023.

Bhargava says that in the last 5 years from 2018 to 2023, 51 thousand government recruitments were made in MP through the Employee Selection Board (ESB), in which 82 lakh youth appeared in the examination, out of which even after the results of 30 thousand recruitments were released, not a single appointment has been given to the post of Grade-3 or below.

Vacancies were released for

posts like Sub Engineer, Kalyan Officer, Data Entry Operator, Steno Typist, Staff Nurse, Pharmacist, Patwari, Para Medical Staff, Police Constable, Excise Constable, Jail Guard, Forest Guard, Primary-Middle-High School Teacher, but not giving jobs to lakhs of candidates even after taking written examination, fitness, eligibility test is a matter of surprise.

Bhargava has appealed to the Chief Minister to fulfil the promise of the BJP government by running a special campaign in the state to fill the vacant regular posts of class III and IV through contract-outsourced workers working in the state, otherwise the workers will be forced to protest.

Speculation about first expansion of state cabinet

Bhopal: There is rising speculation about a cabinet expansion in Madhya Pradesh, with indications that Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav might undertake the first expansion of his cabinet soon.

Among the names circulating, Ramniwas Rawat is expected to take the oath as a minister. Additionally, discussions include leaders who have shifted from Congress to the BJP. Alongside Rawat, names like Nirmala Sapre and Kamlesh Shah, a by-election candidate from Amarwara, are being considered. The swearing-in ceremony is anticipated to be held at Raj Bhavan at 9 AM on Monday. Currently, Dr. Mohan Yadav's government comprises 31 ministers. It is speculated that three to four more MLAs might be

inducted as ministers, making this first expansion a significant challenge for the Chief Minister.

Dr. Yadav has consulted with senior party leaders

Dr. Yadav has recently consulted with senior party leaders, including Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, and BJP President JP Nadda, discussing the cabinet expansion during his visit to Delhi. Rebel leaders might benefit from this expansion, although official confirmation will come post the BJP Working Committee meeting. The political landscape is abuzz with these developments, awaiting the final decision on the cabinet's new composition.

Passengers' complaints will be resolved in war room

Railways set up a war room in Bhopal division

Passenger complaints will be resolved within time limit

Chronicle Reporter, Bhopal West Central Railway has set up a war room in the railway control offices in Bhopal division. In this war room, special emphasis is laid on quick resolution of passenger problems and providing them better services and rail help analysis under passenger facilities.



On the instructions of General Manager Shobhana Bandopadhyay of WCR, from time to time in

various meetings, emphasis is laid on quick resolution of passenger complaints within the time limit at

all stations of West Central Railway and all passenger trains passing through. Bhopal division PRO Naval Agarwal said that for quick redressal of passenger complaints in the railways, the department employees are engaged 24x7 on the computer terminal in the war room to resolve the problems of the passengers. In this, along with RPE, Commercial, Mechanical Electrical Department, employees are also deployed to keep an eye on the complaints coming on social media. Real time monitoring is also done from this war room.

By operating the war room, the problems of medical assistance, water in coaches, cleanliness, electricity and other complaints related to railway passengers and security etc. are being resolved very quickly.

Confusion in Indore Metro's 540 crore tender, contractor company will make claim

Demand rises for laying underground line instead of elevated line MP government will suffer loss of crores due to Metro



Virendra Verma, Indore Confusion has arisen in the tender for the metro line running from Robot Square to High Court. For the time being, Metro work has been stopped. Presently, there was a tender for running the metro on an elevated line, but due to opposition from some business organizations and residents of the area, demand for laying underground line was raised. This demand got so strong that the Metro officials had to hold a meeting with the Minister, MP and enlightened citizens.

It was decided in the meeting that first the laying of the said line should be reconsidered once again. Due to the opposition, Madhya Pradesh government will suffer loss of crores due to the metro and the contractor company will make claim as per the decided conditions. Work of making a 30 km

long ring of metro train had started in Indore. In the first phase, Dilip Buildcon was given the contract of Rs 385 crore to build the 6 km long section from MR 10 to Robot Square. After that, in the second phase, the work of the 12 km long section from Gandhi Nagar to MR 10 ISBT was given to Rail Vikas Nigam for Rs 1100 crore, which is almost complete.

Madhya Pradesh Metro Rail called for the tender for the third phase of 30 km, which will be built from Robot Square to High Court. It includes six stations Khajrana, Bengali Square, Patrakar Colony, Palasia, 56 Dukan and High Court. This tender has been jointly taken by Rail Vikas Nigam and URC (Chennai) for Rs 540 crore. The company had started

the work of laying a six kilometer long elevated line, which has been stopped for the time being due to opposition. If the work is stopped, the company will make a claim on the government, because all the resources including machines and manpower have been deployed. The metro train was supposed to go underground from the High Court to Bada Ganpati Square, but a controversy arose due to the demand to make it underground from Bengali Square itself.

Government will suffer a huge loss

If the metro train is made underground from Bengali Square, the government will suffer a huge loss. Firstly, the cost will increase four times i.e. to

2100 crores. Secondly, the project report will have to be prepared again for the underground line and approval will have to be taken from Delhi. Thirdly, the loan will have to be revised from ADB Bank. In this entire process, the project will start after one year. Rail Vikas Nigam and URC Company will not be able to participate in the tender. L&T or foreign companies will participate for the underground line. The current manufacturing company can claim about 30 to 50 crores from the government, keep in mind that during the work from Gandhinagar to MR 10 Square, the company has claimed loss from the government when the work was stopped for eight days due to the security reasons of the President and the Prime Minister.

It is not confirmed whether the government gave approval or not. Metro General Manager CB Chakraborty said that a committee has been formed for this. A report on all the benefits and losses will be prepared and given to the government. After that the government will take a decision. On the question of work being stopped, he said that there is a lot of other work in the metro, which is being done. Once a decision is taken, the work will resume.

Bio CNG plant for disposal of 400 tons of wet waste

Charcoal plant can be built for disposal of 400 tons of dry waste Councillors from 03 assembly constituencies attend meeting



Bhopal: Mayor Malti Rai has called upon the public representatives to actively participate in cleanliness activities and also tell the citizens the importance of separating dry and wet waste and cooperate in making their city the cleanest city of the country under Swachh Survekshan 2024.

Mayor Rai made this call in the meeting of councillors coming under Govindpura, Narela and Huzur assembly constituencies to give information about the prescribed parameters of Swachh Survey. In the meeting, detailed information was given through power point presentation regarding the prescribed parameters and guidelines of Swachh Survey. In a meeting held in the hall of

the Mayor's office at ISBT on Friday, the Mayor discussed making Bhopal the cleanest city of the country in Swachh Survekshan-2024 and also took suggestions.

During this, detailed information was given through a power point presentation regarding the parameters set for the Swachh Survey and the marks set for cleanliness as per the provisions of the Urban Solid Waste 2016 Act and the role of public representatives in the Swachh Survey.

The Mayor called upon all the public representatives to motivate the citizens to keep the city clean. She said that we have to pay special attention to the segregation of waste so that the garbage transfer stations operat-

ed for garbage disposal in the city, bio CNG plant for disposal of 400 tonnes of wet waste and charcoal plant for disposal of 400 tonnes of dry waste can be made meaningful.

In the meeting, the councillors assured that they themselves will play an active role in other cleanliness activities including garbage segregation, citizen feedback and will also motivate the citizens of their area for this and make their city number one in cleanliness.
