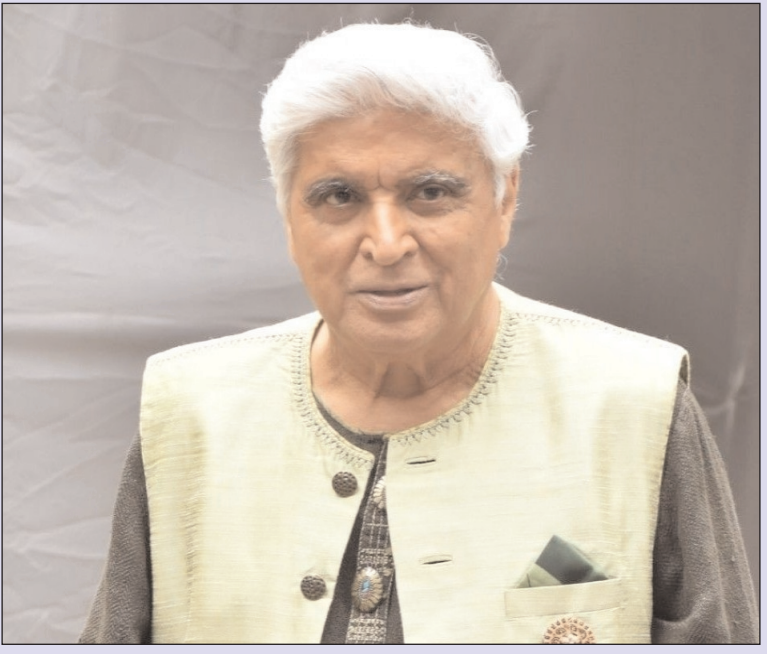

Javed Akhtar's Twitter Thread, For the unversed, Javed Akhtar's father Jan Nisar Akhtar, also a lyricist and poet was an active force of the Progressive Writers' Movement in pre-Partition British India. His mother Safiya Siraj-ul Haq was also a writer. Akhtar's great-great-grandfather Fazl-e-Haq Khairabadi was a freedom fighter and was a part of the 1857 rebellion against the rule of the British East India Company.

Khairabadi was sentenced to life imprisonment on the Andaman Islands where passed away in 1864.
