Bhopal: Dr. Mohan Yadav has said that self-reliance has been the main strength and specialty of Indian villages. Don't deprive children of govt employees of internship scheme: Bhargava

Bhopal: Isolating and not including the children of government employees and income tax payers from across the country and depriving them from the new internship scheme of the Union Budget is a blatant discrimination policy, and in the rising inflation, giving a stipend of only five thousand rupees per month is like a drop in the ocean, this amount should be increased to fifteen thousand and permanent employment should be ensured after training. This demand has been made by the provincial convener of the All Department Outsource Joint Struggle Front, Manoj Bhargava

and general secretary Dinesh Sisodia to the Union Finance Minister.

To prevent hundreds of electrical accidents increasing in the power sector across the country, Bhargava has appealed to the Union Finance Minister to expand the scope of the Centre's new Internship Employment Skill Training Scheme to include electricity outsourced contract workers across the country, so that electricity sub-station operators and line staff outsourced contract workers can receive long-term training under this internship scheme, because due to lack of training, contract

workers across the country are dying every day.

Bhargava requested to include all outsourced contract workers of the country in the Centre's much talked about 'Aatmanirbhar Yojana' and free them from contract dependence and pay monthly salary directly from government departments and gov-

ernment undertakings, so that outsourced workers can be freed from the clutches of contractors and become financially strong.
