

# YC activists dispersed using water cannons, several workers arrested

►Protest over rising unemployment and scams, senior leaders also took part

Bhopal: In response to a call by the Youth Congress, senior Congress leaders took to the streets in Madhya Pradesh to protest against rising unemployment, the nursing scam, and other issues. The demonstrators were met with barricades and water cannons, as the police sought to prevent them from reaching the CM residence. During the clash, State President Jitu Patwari fell from a barricade due to the water pressure. Additionally, several Congress workers were arrested by the police.

## Cong workers climbed barricades

The Youth Congress had announced plans to surround the CM residence and deliver post-cards as part of the "Ab Yuwak Karega Kranti" (Now, Youth Will Lead the Revolution) program in Bhopal on Friday. As part of this demonstration, Congress leaders and workers from across the state gathered at Roshanpura intersection. When the workers attempted to move from Roshan-

pura towards the CM residence, they were stopped by barricades set up by the police. In defiance, some Congress workers climbed the barricades to continue their march.

## Use of water cannons and tear gas

To halt the advancing crowd,

the police deployed water cannons, spraying Youth Congress workers who were attempting to breach the barricades. The sudden release of water created panic among the demonstrators, leading to a scuffle between some Youth Congress members and the police. To further control the situation, the police also

fired tear gas shells, adding to the chaos.

## Campaign Highlights Broken Promises

As part of the "Kya Hua Tera Wada" (What Happened to Your Promise) campaign, the Youth Congress had encouraged young people to write letters questioning the government's unmet promises. These letters were intended to be delivered to the CM during the protest. The youth raised questions about the government's promises of job creation, housing for Ladli bahnas, punishment for those involved in the nursing scam, and ensuring the Minimum Support Price (MSP) for farmers.

Several senior Congress leaders were present at the protest, including Youth Congress State President Mitendra Singh Yadav, Congress State President Jeetu Patwari, former Union Minister Arun Yadav, and former Minister Omkar Singh Markam.

# Now economy of villages of Madhya Pradesh will be strengthened

- Currently there are 116 home-stays, more will increase in future
- Rural Development Minister Patel says- Panchayats should send proposals to make tourist villages

With the increase in tourism in rural areas of Madhya Pradesh, the economy of the village is now getting strengthened. There are 116 home-stays in the state so far. Their number will be increased. Tourists from abroad and cities have started coming and staying to understand the rural culture and environment and their number is increasing. Such villages are being identified which have great potential for tourism.

Rural Development and Panchayat Minister Prahlad Patel has urged all the Panchayats to identify the villages with tourism potential in their area and send proposals to make them tourist villages. He said that promoting rural tourism will strengthen the economy of the village. Sawarwani village of 300 houses, 6 km inside Jhirpa in Tamia development block of Chhindwara, has become a tourist village since 2019. So far more than 300 foreign tourists have come here and understood the culture of the vil-



lage.

● The economy of the village has improved due to the arrival of tourists. This homestay - Vedika Hills is managed by the tourism development committee of the village. The chairman of this committee is Kamleshwar Yadav. The vice-chairman is Ram Prasad Salam and the secretary is Durgesh. The 15 other members of the committee include Ramesh Parteti, Naresh Nagvanshi, Manoj Bhovanshi. Each member has the responsibility of conducting different tourism activities. The fee for each activity is fixed. For example, 1000 rupees for tribal Shaila dance and 500 rupees for the performance of Bhajan Mandali, 500 rupees for the guide, 300 rupees for cooking local food. Committee vice-chairman Ramprasad says that Shahwan and Puratala villages are nearby at a distance of three to four kilometers. The interest of the people here is also increasing and now 6 such homestays have been built. Committee secretary Durgesh says that the economy of the village has improved due to the arrival of tourists.

The sanctum sanctorum of the world famous Mahakaleshwar Lord's temple has been closed for general visitors since last Sawan. Devotees are not able to offer even a pot of water to Baba Mahakal directly.

For the last 429 days, devotees are having darshan of Baba Mahakal from a distance. Right now only priests and VIPs are able to enter the sanctum sanctorum. In the last procession, six idols of Mahakal came out to give darshan to the devotees. This time again Baba Mahakal will come out of the temple on 2 September, despite this, devotees are not able to enter inside to offer even a pot of water to the Lord.

Navbharat's investigation revealed that on 4 July 2023, the sanctum sanctorum was closed till 11 September 2023 in view of the huge crowd that came in the last month of Shravan. Since then, the sanctum sanctorum of Mahakal temple has been closed. In view of the Shri Krishna festival, many organizations as well as common visitors made verbal demands to Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav, who came to Ujjain on the occasion of Janmashtami festival. The CM has given assurance on this. On September 2, the royal procession of Baba Mahakal will be taken out. Now the patience of the devotees is breaking. Devotees from Ujjain to all over the country want to be able to touch Baba and offer water, for this the sanctum sanctorum should be opened for everyone. When the sanctum sanctorum of Mahakal was closed for general visitors, the temple committee had said at that time that the sanctum sanctorum will be opened for common devotees as soon as Sawan ends.

There is also a discussion that MM's General Manager Vipul Agarwal does not want to go out as ED. The other three General Managers are fully in the race.
