

# Japan will become the country partner of GIS

Additional Commissioner Nidhi Singh removed

Administrative Correspondent, Bhopal: Bhopal Municipal Corporation's Additional Commissioner Ms. Nidhi Singh has been removed. She has now been posted as Joint Commissioner Land Records and Settlement in Gwalior.

Nidhi Singh is a 2019 batch IAS. Nidhi Singh came into the limelight when a censure motion was passed against her in the Bhopal Municipal Corporation meeting. This motion was passed in the Municipal Corporation Council meeting held on December 13. Nidhi Singh was the target of councillors of both Bhopal and Congress parties, the censure motion presented against her was supported by both the parties.

Councillors of both the parties had accused her of not picking up the phone, not giving importance to the councillors and removing the files. Since then it was believed that Nidhi Singh could be removed anytime. Now she has been removed a month after the censure motion was passed. She was second in command after the commissioner in Bhopal Municipal Corporation, and was discharging many important responsibilities.

## CM will visit Japan to attract investment



**Bhopal:** CM Dr. Mohan Yadav announced that the next Cabinet meeting, dedicated to Lokmata Devi Ahilya Bai Holkar's 300th birth anniversary, will be held on January 24 in Maheshwar. He also ordered exemptions in motor vehicle taxes for the Gwalior Fair and Vikramotsav Ujjain. While congratulating the Swami Vivekanand Yuva Shakti Mission, inspired by PM Modi's focus on knowledge and empowerment of the poor, youth, farm-

ers and women, he affirmed the upcoming implementation of the Garib Kalyan Mission in the state. CM was addressing the ministers before the meeting of the Cabinet on Wednesday.

CM informed that the next Regional Industry Conclave will be held in Shahdol to promote industrial activities and investment in the state. Japan will participate as a country partner in the GIS scheduled in Bhopal

on February 24-25. Additionally, the CM's visit to Japan from January 27 to February 1 is planned to attract investment to the state.

CM said that 11 departments have been told to finalize their investment policies in preparation for the Global Investor Summit, with 21 policies currently under development.

## Industry Conclave in Shahdol today

**Bhopal:** CM Dr. Mohan Yadav has said that Shahdol is a land of immense possibilities in the industrial sector. Regional Industry Conclave is going to be held at University Institute of Technology Shahdol on January 16 to promote regional industries with cooperation and collaboration. In this, policy dialogue and innovations will be shared with industrialists and investors. More than 4 thousand participants and more than 2 thousand industrialists will participate in the conclave.

CM will dedicate and perform Bhoomi Pujan of 28 industrial units in the conclave. An investment of Rs 570 crore will be made and 2600 jobs will be created in these units. In the conclave an investment of Rs 18 thousand crore is likely for 1600 megawatt thermal plant by Torrent Power.

During conclave, CM will hold one-to-one discussions with the leading industrialists of the country. There will also be 3 sectoral sessions with investors. In the opening session of the conclave, Chief Secretary Anurag Jain will shed light on the industry outlook of Madhya Pradesh and a film will be screened on the achievements of the Industry Department in one year.

## Now 50% tax exemption on vehicle purchase in Gwalior fair

### Transport department issues orders



**Administrative correspondent, Bhopal:** The state government has given 50% exemption in sales tax on vehicles sold in Gwalior Trade Fair. The Transport Department has issued orders in this regard on Tuesday.

According to the order, non-

transport vehicles such as motorcycles, motor cars, omni buses for personal use and light transport vehicles which are liable for lifetime motor vehicle tax and which are sold at the Gwalior Trade Fair during the period of 2024-25, will get a discount of 50 percent on the

rate of lifetime motor vehicle tax payable. Exemption in sales tax will be available only to such vehicles, which are sold during the Gwalior Trade Fair period. To avail this exemption, it will be necessary that the vehicles have been registered at the Regional Transport Office, Gwalior.

The department has also made it clear in the order that automobile businessmen coming from outside Gwalior will be allowed to sell vehicles only after obtaining a business certificate from the Regional Transport Office, Gwalior and ensuring their physical presence in the fair premises in Gwalior. Let us tell you here that the biggest reason for the huge sale of vehicles in the Gwalior Trade Fair is that there is a discount of up to 50 percent in the sales tax here, if this exemption is not available then the main attraction of the fair is lost. Due to lack of exemption, vehicle sales in the fair are greatly affected, hence pressure was exerted on the government.

## Stolen goods worth Rs 1.40 lakh recovered from 2 suspects

**Bhopal:** Bagsevania police arrested two smart criminals and recovered stolen goods worth Rs 1.40 lakh from them. During interrogation, two incidents in the area were revealed. The arrested accused are the monitored criminals of Habibganj. More than a dozen crimes have been registered against both of them. DCP Zone No. 2 Sanjay Agarwal said that the criminals jumped over the boundary wall of a house located near Saket Nagar drain and stole gold and silver jewellery.

Similarly, goods worth thousands including jewellery were stolen by cutting the grill of the window of an empty house located in BHEL Sangam Colony. After inspecting the spot, different teams were deployed to search for the criminals. After



watching the footage of about 90 CCTV cameras installed in the area and the road, one of the accused was taken into custody and questioned.

He confessed to committing both the crimes and selling the stolen goods to another youth.

### Exterted criminal arrested in Arera Hills

Arera Hills police station has arrested an exiled criminal. Action has been taken against him under NSA. According to the po-

lice, the accused Akash Chaudhary alias Akku (23) is a resident of Bhimnagar near Gopal Kirana Store. The Police Commissioner had issued an exile order against him on November 5 last year. The order said that the criminal should appear at the Arera Hills police station on the 15th of every month and mark his attendance.

In compliance with this order, when the criminal Akash did not appear at the police station in the month of December, a case of violation of the order was registered against him recently. When the police team reached for checking on Tuesday, the accused was found near the house, who was arrested.
