Cong slams Modi govt over fall of Indian rupee against US dollar

The Congress on Friday hit out at the Narendra Modi government over the falling value of the Indian rupee against the US dollar, alleging that the Indian currency has witnessed 50 percent fall under the BJP government. The party also flagged its grave concern over the Indian currency almost touching the 87 mark against the dollar.

Addressing a press conference at the AICC headquarters here, Congress spokesperson Supriya Shrinate said, "Looks like Prime Minister Narendra Modi has resolved to make the rupee hit the century against the dollar

She asked the government whether it realised how much impact the falling rupee will have on the common people as imports will be expensive which will lead to inflation and price rise of essential commodifies



The Congress spokesperson said that despite the RBI pumping in 80 billion dollars since September 2024 to arrest the fall, nothing had happened to redeem the value of the ru pee, which is in a free fall.

Shrinate alleged that the foreign exchange reserves in the country right now were lowest in the last ten months at 625 billion dollars against the high of 704 billion dollars in Sep tember 2024.

Ayodhya (UP): In a scathing attack on Samajwadi Party (ŠP), Úttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday accused it of opposing leaders like Baba Saheb Bhim-rao Ambedkar while supporting mafia elements.

Addressing a rally in support of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) candidate Chandrabhanu Paswan for the Milkipur assembly by-election, the CM said, "they mourn the deaths of mafia members and even recite 'marsiya' for them. The devotees of Moid Khan must not succeed. It is time to ensure the victory of nationalists from Milkipur."

He said, "SP leaders act shocked when their true colours are exposed. Moid Khan, who disrespected a Dalit daughter, is celebrated as a hero by the SP. This behaviour reflects SP's real character.

Yogi said that SP MPs from Ayodhya openly support Moid Khan and even take pride in being associated with him. "Those who glorify someone like Moid Khan pose a threat to the safety of our daughters. They should not be allowed to succeed," he said.



Form filling for Madrasa Board exams

Bhopal: The facility of filling the application form for the class 10th-12th Urdu medium examinations of MP Madrasa Board to be held in the session 2025 will be available on the MP Online portal from 20 January 2025 to 31 March 2025 through authorized study centers. Error correction in the application forms can be done till 10 April. After online application, it is mandatory to send the original documents by 15 April 2025. These examinations are recognized and equivalenced by the Government of India and the State Government. Authorized study centers and students are directed to thoroughly go through the guidelines issued by the board before filling the application form, so that there is no error in the application forms. The guidelines are available on the Madrasa Board website mpmb.org.in.

Geo-Tagging Borewells, now mandatory in MP

In a decisive move to curb the recurring tragedies of children falling into open borewells, the Madhya Pradesh government has introduced stricter regulations. Despite numerous warnings, such incidents have continued to claim innocent lives, leav-ing families shattered and the administration scrambling to mount rescue operations. To address this alarming issue, the government has implemented the Madhya Pradesh Prevention and Safety Rules-2024, ensuring enhanced safety and accountability in borewell construction.

Under the new rules, geo-tagging of borewells has been made mandatory, and agencies involved in borewell digging are now required to obtain licenses from the Executive Engineer (EE) of the Public Health Engineering Department. This reform is aimed at bringing trans-parency and ensuring every borewell



is tracked from the moment it is drilled

Safety First: A Proactive Approach In addition to geo-tagging, the rules mandate that agencies must install proper safety measures during and after borewell construction. For example:

Signboards with complete infor-mation: The drilling site must have a visible signboard displaying the contact details of the drilling agency and the landowner.

Physical barriers: The area around the drilling site must be fenced with barbed wire or any suitable barrier to prevent unauthorized access, especially by children.

Encouraging Citizen Participation

To ensure compliance, the government has introduced an innovative approach: rewarding those who report violations. If any individual spots a borewell that does not follow the prescribed safety measures and reports it to the authorities, they will be eligible for a reward. This initiative not only empowers citizens but also creates a collective sense of responsibility in preventing accidents.

Elevated Corridor from Misrod to Ratnagiri Tiraha: A game-changer for Bhopal's Traffic

In a major development aimed at alleviating traffic congestion on Bhopal's Narmadapuram Road, an elevated corridor connecting Misrod BRTS Corridor to CRRI MPRI and Ratnagiri Tiraha is set to be constructed soon.

The long-awaited project has received renewed attention after Minister of State for Backward Classes and Minority Welfare (Independent Charge), Mrs. Krishna Gaur, met Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari, in New Delhi on January 22.

During the meeting, State Min-ister Krishna Gaur highlighted the delays in the project and emphasized the urgent need for its completion. "The construction work has not progressed as expected, and the delay is causing serious



transportation issues and road safety concerns in the area," she stated.

Minister Gaur requested Union Minister Gadkari to expedite the project, citing the growing number of road accidents and the inconvenience faced by commuters due to the lack of adequate infrastructure.
