Prepaid Meters Now Mandatory in Govt Offices – No Payment, No Power

State Government Implements Prepaid Electricity System for All Offices

Bhopal: In a major policy shift, the Madhya Pradesh government has mandated the installation of prepaid electricity meters in all government offices. Under this system, offices will receive electricity only as per the recharge amount, similar to prepaid mobile plans. Once the balance runs out, the power supply will be automatically cut off.

This move aims to ensure timely payments of electricity bills, bringing government offices in line with the strict payment policies already imposed on regular consumers.

Currently, electricity companies disconnect power for ordinary consumers if bills remain unpaid for a month. While postpaid meters offered some flexibility in payments, the transition to prepaid smart meters will eliminate any delays or exemptions.

End of Long-Pending Electricity Dues in Government Offices

Traditionally, government offices have accumulated large unpaid electricity bills, only settling dues when power companies enforced strict measures. With the prepaid system in place, delayed payments will no longer be an option. The Finance Department has issued directives to all government



departments, divisional commissioners, department heads, and district collectors to ensure that offices maintain sufficient balance for uninterrupted power supply.

How the Prepaid Meter System Works

The new prepaid electricity meters operate just like prepaid mobile plans:

Offices must recharge their meters in advance to continue receiving power.

If the balance runs out, the electricity supply will be discon-

nected automatically. To restore power, offices must immediately recharge their accounts.

This system will eliminate the long-standing issue of unpaid electricity bills in government offices, enforcing greater financial discipline and accountability.

AIIMS hosts IABSCON 2025, advancing precision

Finance Department's Plan for Implementation

The Finance Department has outlined a structured approach to implementing this new system: Clearing Outstanding Dues: Offices must settle any pending electricity bills before installing pre-

paid meters. The security deposit from postpaid meters will be adjusted against outstanding dues, and any remaining amount will be used for future recharges.

Monthly Recharge System: Offices will receive monthly electricity bills based on actual consumption.

A rolling advance system will be implemented to ensure a month's balance is always available.

Any unused balance will earn incentives, rebates, or interest, as per guidelines set by the Madhya Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission.

Six-Month Transition Period **Before Strict Enforcement**

To facilitate a smooth transition, the government has announced a six-month grace period. During this time, even if an office's prepaid balance runs out, electricity will not be disconnected immediately. However, after six months, there will be no exemptions-if an office fails to recharge, the lights will go out.



Bhopal: A new record of unloading coal from coal racks was created at Shri Singaji Thermal Power Station Dongalia (Khand-wa) of Madhya Pradesh Power Generating Company Limited. Emptying the racks on time also plays an important role in the continuous availability of coal. A total of 531 coal racks were unloaded by Coal Transfer Department (CHP)-1 and 2 at Shri Singaji Thermal Power Station in the period from 9 December 2024 to 11 February 2025 within the stipulated period of the Railways.

This is the record of

emptying the maximum coal racks in a period of three months so far without paying demurrage charge. Earlier, in the year 2023, a total of 505 coal racks were unloaded at Shri Singaji Thermal Power Station from 22 January 2023 to 4 April 2023 without paying demurrage.

It is necessary to unload five hours per rack

The time of five hours per rack has been fixed by the Railways for Shri Singaji Thermal Power Project. If the time taken is more than the stipulat-

ed time, the Railways imposes a delay fee (demurrage charge) at the rate of Rs 9 thousand per hour. When the coal racks aremptying them rive, within the time limit is a complex task. To do this work successfully, continuous availability of the entire system and equipment has to be ensured. By emptying the racks in less than the stipulated time, the availability of

racks for coal transportation increases for the Railways. This achievement has been achieved due to the continuous efforts of the engineers and personnel of the project.

How were the coal racks unloaded

Working in a planned manner, the Coal Trans-fer Department (CHP) of Shri Singaji Thermal Power Station unloaded a total of 185 racks in December 2024, 252 racks in January 2025 and a total of 94 racks till 11th February 2025.
