Sensex falls 122.52 points

Mumbai, (UNI): Extending losses for the sixth consecutive session on Wednesday, the BSE Sensex lost by 122.52 points to settle at 76,171.08 on weak global cues. The National Stock Exchange (NSE) fell 26.55 points at 23,045.25. The Sensex fell 105 points to open at 76,188.24. During the day, it was tanked 905 points at 75,388.39, days low, before closing at 76,171.08, sliding 122.52 points from its previous close. The Nifty registered days high and low at 23,144.70 and 22,798.35 points respectively. The stocks that tumbled down were Realty by 2.58 pc, Auto by 0.84 pc and Energy by 0.70 pc. The Mid cap declined 0.45 pc and Small cap by 0.49 pc. In 30 scrips, 16 advances while 14 declined.

Third-Party Construction Leads to THINK Gas Pipeline Damage in Bhopal

On 3rd February, an incident occurred near Nandi Tiraha, Bhopal bypass road, resulting in damage to a gas pipeline operated by THINK Gas. Upon investigation, it was found that the damage was caused during third-party piling work conducted in the area. The individual responsible for the excavation work fled the site after realizing the damage caused. The THINK Gas team, along with an Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV), promptly arrived at the location and took immediate action to rectify the damage, restoring gas supply to the affected areas. The disruption caused by this incident led to gas interruptions in several localities.



Importantly, this damage could have been avoided if prior information regarding the excavation work had been communicated to THINK Gas. Such incidents disrupt the gas supply as well as pose significant risks to life and property.

Excavation near gas pipelines is highly dangerous and must be strictly avoided. Any third-party construction or excavation activity near gas infrastructure should be reported to THINK Gas in advance to ensure safety and prevent similar accidents. The act of damaging the gas pipeline clearly falls under the category of crime under Section 15 (1) and (2) of the Petroleum and Mineral Pipelines (Acquisition of User's Right in Land) Act, (PMP Act) 1962 as well as relevant sections of the IPC. These violations are cognizable offences and attract a fine of up to Rs 25 crore and imprisonment of up to three years.
