In an interview with Friday Talkies, when asked about the singer-actor, Dhanoa redirected the discussion, saying, "Let's talk about positive people, real people, nice people, good people." 

Eshaa Pathak tells what brings authenticity to her character

Bringing a character to life is more than just learning lines—it's about understanding the world they belong to. For actors, keen observation is the key to authenticity, especially when portraying a culture-rich character.

This helps us bring authenticity to our characters and makes it easier to portray the culture that the show is based on." The Rishto Se Bandhi Gauri actress further added, "For me, this process has been even smoother because I belong to Madhya Pradesh. I am already familiar with the local language, traditions, and way of life. Since childhood, I have seen and experi-



enced MP's culture firsthand, so when I play a character that belongs to this region—like in my current show on Sun Neo Rishto Se Bandhi Gauri it feels very natural to me. I instinctively know how to carry myself, speak, and behave in a way that fits the character and setting."
Eshaa Pathak says she has

lived in Indore for two years, which has further helped her grasp the local dialect and slang. Being surrounded by the lan-guage and culture on a daily basis made it easy for me to absorb the natural flow of conversations, making my portrayal even more realistic and effortless, she adds.
