Father in critical condition after electrocution in Narikhelra

Bhopal: A tragic incident in Narikehela has reignited public outrage over a 132,000-volt high-tension wire that looms dangerously over hundreds of homes. Guddu, a local laborer, is fighting for his life at Hamidia Hospital after being electrocuted while hammering a nail in his home. His son, who tried to save him, also suffered an electric shock. Guddu has sustained burns over 80% of his body and remains in critical condition. This is not the first time tragedy has struck. The same high-tension line has been linked to multiple deaths and injuries over the past 25 years. Yet despite repeated promises by politicians to relocate or underground the wires—as was successfully done in nearby Devki Nagar—no action has been taken in Narikehela.

▶ Local outrage follows

Bhopal: A tragic incident in Shah-jahanabad's Sanjay Nagar has sparked outrage after a young man, identified as Satish, was electrocuted due to negligence by the electricity department. Satish, a local halwai, was reportedly electrocuted when he brushed against an exposed Distribution Point (DP) on an electric pole near his home on Tuesday afternoon. It is believed that the electric current spread from the open DP, which had been left uncovered, leading to Satish's untimely death. The incident caused panic among locals, and the resulting power surge damaged electrical appliances in 8 to 10

nearby homes. Refrigerators, fans, coolers, and TVs were among the items destroyed, leaving residents with significant losses. Residents of Sanjay Nagar are furious, blaming the electricity department for its negligence that led to the death of an innocent man and the damage to their property. They are demanding accountability and immediate action.

The police arrived at the scene shortly after the incident, sending Satish's body for a post-mortem. A case (inquest) has been registered, and an investigation is ongoing. Authorities are working to determine if the department's negligence contributed to this tragedy and what steps will be taken against those responsible.

Teen's cricket game turns tragic

Bhopal: A simple game of cricket ended in a devastating tragedy on Monday, as 16-year-old Neeraj Gurjar of Ajabpura lost his life after being electrocuted. The incident, which occurred in a village field, has sparked outrage and calls for accountability. Neeraj, like many teenagers, was playing cricket with friends when the ball strayed near the field's boundary. As he went to retrieve it, his foot made contact with a dangerously exposed electrical wire lying on the ground. The resulting shock sent him collapsing, unconscious. Villagers rushed the severely injured teenager to the Berasia Government Hospital, where doctors battled to save his life. Despite their efforts, Neeraj succumbed to his injuries around 9:30 PM. The Berasia police, upon receiving notification of the tragic death, have registered a case and initiated a thorough investigation. The boy's body has been sent for postmortem examination.

MP Transport Department recruitment after 13 Years

Bhopal: After a long gap of 13 years, the Madhya Pradesh Transport Department is set to launch a much-awaited recruitment drive for 100 male transport constables. The proposal has already been sent to the state government and the recruitment will be conducted through the Madhya Pradesh Staff Selection Board (MPESB). Currently, the department employs 222 transport constables, of which nearly 30% are women. Once the recruitment is completed, the total number of constables will increase to 322, strengthening the department's capacity to crack down on illegal and overloaded vehicles more effectively. The sanctioned strength for constables in the department is 332, but several posts remain vacant due to promotions and retirements.
