The operation was carried out by the anti-encroachment team to clear the way for crucial infrastructure development.

Bhopal: Bhopal is grappling with disturbing allegations of rape and extortion involving three college students. The accused, identified as Farhan Khan, Sahil Khan, and Ali Khan, allegedly preyed on the victims after deceptively befriending them under false pretenses. Farhan Khan has been apprehended, while a search for the other two is underway.

The horrifying details reveal a pattern of coercion, with the accused allegedly luring the girls to various locations where the assaults occurred. Exploiting technology, the perpetrators reportedly filmed obscene videos of the victims, using this footage to issue threats and manipulate them into further sexual encounters. The abuse extended to financial extortion, with the girls allegedly forced to hand over substantial sums of

Commuters will not have to take long detour

Currently, those traveling from BHEL to access the Subhash Nagar flyover face a considerable detour via Prabhat Chauraha. The construction of this third leg will eliminate this inconvenience, allowing vehicles from BHEL direct access onto the existing flyover. Conversely, commuters heading towards BHEL from Maida Mill and MP Nagar will no longer need to navigate Prabhat Square. Instead they will utilize the third leg from the Maida Mill side, descending at Moti Nagar.

Minister Sarang emphasized that this strategic addition will provide direct and convenient access, substantially improving the city's overall traffic management and offering a smoother, more effi-cient commute for a large segment of Bhopal's population. The imminent start of construction signals a significant step towards alleviating traffic congestion in key areas.
