Ella, Chairperson of Bharat Biotech International and Research Council Chairman of CSIR-NIIST, inaugurated the Fortified Rice Kernels (FRK) Pilot Plant at the CSIR-National Institute for Interdisciplinary Science and Tech-nology (CSIR-NIIST) here on Fri-

The state-of-the-art FRK pilot plant has been established to address the nutritional needs of vulnerable population groups, especially children and pregnant women.

Using technology developed in-house at CSIR-NIIST, the plant enables the continuous production of fortified rice kernels enriched with essential micronutrients such

FRK process involves The blending micronutrients with rice flour and extruding the mix into rice-shaped kernels that are virtually indistinguishable from natural rice. The system is equipped with advanced drying and cooling con-

veyors for effective moisture removal, enabling immediate use and distribution.

The plant is capable of producing 30 to 50 kilograms of FRK per hour, which can be seamlessly blended with polished rice for large-scale public distribution. Speaking at the unveiling, Dr. Krishna M. Ella commended the institute's efforts to develop practical, scalable solutions in food and health sciences.

'This pilot plant is an important innovation that merges science with social responsibility. It holds promise for improving public health outcomes across the country, particularly in underserved regions," he said.
