

MP on high alert for internal security

- Every corner under vigilance
- DGP calls meeting of SPs and IGs
- High-level meeting on emergency preparedness

Bhopal: In light of the prevailing national scenario, Director General of Police (DGP) Kailash Makwana convened a discussion on Friday with all district Superintendents of Police (SPs), Range Inspectors General (IGs) and Additional Directors General (ADGs), as well as Collectors and Commissioners. He assessed the internal security situation of each district, emphasizing the need for heightened vigilance.



The DGP directed that police focus on the security of crowded areas and critical infrastructure. He stressed the importance of keeping the police force, including the State

Disaster Response Force (SDRF), prepared to handle any emergency situation.

During the afternoon, the DGP engaged in detailed discussions

with all SPs across the state regarding internal security. He inquired about the security arrangements in place for significant buildings, national monuments, and heavily populated areas, to which all officers presented their preparedness strategies. Furthermore, he sought information on the measures taken to tackle potential emergencies.

In addition to these directives, the DGP instructed officials to maintain strict surveillance on social media to prevent any guideline violations. He also issued orders to intensify security checks at airports and railway stations. Furthermore, continuous vehicle checking in urban areas remains a priority. These concerted efforts underscore Madhya Pradesh's proactive stance in ensuring the safety and security of its citizens amidst the current national context.

Bhopal: Colonel Sophia Qureshi, the Indian Army officer who played a pivotal role in Operation Sindoor against Pakistan, continues to capture national attention. Praising her courage and contribution, Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav lauded her as a true symbol of pride for the state and the country.

Sophia spent her early childhood there, attending GTC School from grades one to three before continuing her journey across India due to her father's postings in the Army.

Mass leave ban for 13 key departments

Bhopal: In a late-night move, the General Administration Department has cancelled all types of leave for employees in 13 critical government departments, including Health, Home, Energy, Urban Development, Panchayat & Rural Development, Public Works, and Food & Civil Supplies. Even previously sanctioned leaves have been revoked, effective immediately.

Government staff must remain present at their headquarters at all times. Exceptions will only be considered in cases like marriage, childbirth, serious illness, or family emergencies, subject to approval by the district collector or departmental secretary.

Security Meetings

Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav chaired two high-level meetings on Friday to review the security situation and preparedness measures in the state. In a video conference with district collectors and police superintendents, he emphasized the importance of visible and proactive administration.

- Citizens march with pride to honor

Bhopal: Following the resounding success of ‘Operation Sindoor’, in which the Indian Army dismantled terrorist hideouts in Pakistan in retaliation for the Pahalgam terror attack, the Madhya Pradesh Congress organized a powerful show of patriotism through a Tiranga Yatra in Bhopal.

Outdated wartime siren system to be replaced in Bhopal



Bhopal: Bhopal is set to receive a modern siren system to replace its aging infrastructure, much of which dates back to the 1971 Indo-Pak war and has fallen into disrepair. The need for an upgrade became starkly evident during a city-wide mock

drill on Wednesday, May 7th, when the existing sirens failed to be audible in several areas. This resulted in widespread confusion among residents regarding the start and end of the simulated blackout.

The new, centrally controlled siren system will be strategically installed across key locations and bustling marketplaces throughout the capital. This integrated system will be linked to the administration's Control and Command Center, ensuring seamless and unified operation.

Collector Kaushalendra Vikram Singh stated that a meeting with the Police Commissioner will be convened soon to finalize the implementation plan. The current siren network, a relic of the 1971 war, is largely defunct. The incoming system promises simultaneous activation across the entire city, providing immediate and uniform alerts to all residents during emergencies.

To ensure public awareness and preparedness, an extensive campaign will be launched to educate citizens about the meaning and appropriate response to the new siren system. Special attention will be given to school and college students, equipping them with essential knowledge on emergency protocols.
