Former MLA Amin Bhat rejoins Congress in Kashmir

Srinagar: Days after resigning from the Democratic Progressive Azad Party (DPAP), former Member Legislative Assembly (MLA) Mohammad Amin Bhat rejoined the Congress party on Wednesday. Bhat returned to party during a function held in south Kashmir's Anantnag district during which senior Congress leaders including its J&K president Tariq Karra were present. "This is my home coming," Bhat said.

### TN approaches SC, accuses Centre of withholding funds

New Delhi: The Tamil Nadu government on Wednesday filed a petition in the Supreme Court seeking a direction to the Centre to pay Rs 2,291.30 crore, accusing it of withholding funds for various education schemes. The Dravidian Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) government in the state has accused the Centre of withholding funds under the Samagra Shiksha Yojana for non-implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 and PM Shri. In the original petition filed under Article 131 of the Constitution, the state sought a direction to the Central government to pay Rs 2,291.30 crore, including six per cent per annum interest on the principal amount of Rs 2,151.59 crore from May 1 this year.

### Youth killed, girl injured after jumping in front of train

Bhadoli (UP): A youth was killed and a girl was injured after being hit by a train near Kandhiya railway crossing in Chauri area of Bhadoli district here in Uttar Pradesh. Government Railway Police (GRP) sources said here on Wednesday. GRP sources said that a couple jumped in front of a train near Kandhiya railway crossing on Varanasi-Jangali railway section in Chauri police station area of the district on Tuesday night. "While the youth died on the spot, the girl sustained serious injuries and has been admitted to the hospital, where her condition remains critical," they said.

### 3 killed as car rams stationary vehicle

Hyderabad: Three people were killed and two others sustained serious injuries when the car they were travelling in collided with a stationary DCM vehicle at Kuntluru in Hayathnagar Mandal of Rangareddy district in the early hours of Wednesday. The deceased, all residents of Kumtluru, were identified as Chandrasena Reddy, Thinath Reddy, and Varsit Reddy. The bodies, which were trapped inside the mangled car, were retrieved with the help of crowbars.

# Cong to hold Jai Hind meetings nationwide from May 24-31

New Delhi (UNI)

The Congress on Wednesday announced that the party will organise Jai Hind meetings across the country from May 24 to 31, to salute the valour of the Armed Forces during Operation Sindoora.

Addressing a press conference here, Congress leaders Col Rohit Chaudhary along with Wing Commander Anuma Acharya (Retd) asked the government to tell the people of the country as to how the Pulwama terror attack happened and how India launched Operation Sindoora.

Giving information about the Jai Hind meeting, Col Rohit said, "In the first phase, 16 cities have been selected where 'Jai Hind' meetings will be held. In these meetings, we will salute the bravery of our soldiers".

"The country has been going through a very difficult phase for almost a month. From April 22 itself, the Congress party has given full



support to the government and we have told the government that we will stand firmly with you in every strong action taken against Pakistan," he said.

He emphasised that the grand old party fully supported Operation Sindoora launched by the government.

He praised the armed forces for destroying several terror hubs in

Pakistan and Pakistan-Occupied Jammu and Kashmir.

Raising question on the announcement of ceasefire, the Army veteran said, "we were winning, our army was foiling Pakistan's drones, missiles and all other types of attacks...It was the fourth day of the battle, but suddenly in the evening a ceasefire was announced".

### SC grants bail to former PFI secy in RSS leader murder case

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Wednesday granted bail to S. Srinivasan, the former secretary of the now-banned Popular Front of India (PFI) in Kerala, in the murder case of RSS leader Sreenivasan.

A bench comprising justices Abhay S. Oka and Justice Ujjal Bhuyan delivered the order while hearing Srinivasan's bail plea.

The court observed that there was no direct role attributed to the accused in relation to the murder conspiracy.

The court remarked, "As far as the association with victim Sreenivasan is concerned, there is no direct role attributed to the appellant. The allegations of antecedents are in almost all cases regarding the protests which took place in September 2022. Bail granted."

### Ensure fear of Corona does not spread: Akhilesh

Lucknow: Samajwadi Party (SP) president Akhilesh Yadav has said that the healthcare "mistakes" of the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party's (BJP) proved fatal in the past for the people and the government should ensure that the negligence in controlling Corona is not repeated.

Taking to X, Akhilesh wrote, "Before the alarm bells ring, the government must act in time to control and prevent Corona, ensuring that the negligence and mismanagement of the past are not repeated. The BJP's mistakes often prove fatal for the people."

"Even the corona vaccine, whose certificates were distributed with much fanfare, has now proven ineffective. Therefore, this time, there is an even greater need for vigilance. We all must explain to the public that, although the corona situation is not extremely serious yet, it should not be ignored, as such diseases can change form and return," said the SP leader.


He said the government should make proper use of its healthcare and information system and ensure that fear of Corona does not spread among the people.

The Supreme Court on Wednesday dismissed a writ petition filed by advocate Mathews Nedumpara and others seeking registration of an FIR against Justice Yashwant Varma in connection with the alleged recovery of illicit cash from his official residence.

A bench comprising Justice Abhay S. Oka and Justice Ujjal Bhuyan observed that the Chief Justice of India (CJI) had already forwarded the report of the in-house inquiry committee, along with Justice Varma's response, to the President and the Prime Minister of India.

"Since no representation has been made to the President or the Prime Minister seeking action, the writ petition seeking a writ of man-

damus is not maintainable," the bench noted. The court clarified that it was not rejecting the petitioners' right to approach the judiciary at a later stage. "We are not saying you cannot file. But first, you must follow



the basic rule.

A writ of mandamus cannot be issued unless a representation has been made to the authorities concerned," Justice Oka remarked during the hearing.

The court also declined to entertain other prayers in the petition, such as reconsideration of the K. Veerawami judgment, which governs the procedure for initiating criminal proceedings against sitting judges. Justice Oka said such issues "need not be considered at the present stage."

Advocate Nedumpara, appearing in person, contended that the in-house procedure under the Veerawami judgment was inadequate and called for a criminal investigation.



### Notification issued for panchayat by-elections in Odisha on June 23

Bhubaneswar (UNI)

The Odisha State Election Commission has issued a notification to conduct panchayat by-elections on June 23 across the state.

The bypolls aim to elect 43 sarpanches and 272 ward members in various districts.

These by-elections have been necessitated due to vacancies arising from deaths, resignations, disqualifications, or the de-reservation of reserved seats owing to the unavailability of eligible candidates.

Collectors from Balasore, Boudh, Gajapati, Jharsuguda, Kandhamal, Kendrapara, Keonjhar, Koraput, Malkangiri, Mayurbhanj, Nabarangpur, Sambalpur, and Subarnapur have submitted proposals to conduct fresh elections for ward member positions where seats were de-reserved due to the absence of eligible candidates from reserved categories.

The State Election Commission has completed the revision and preparation of the electoral rolls for the gram panchayats concerned, based on the Assembly electoral roll of 2025.

Exercising its powers under Article 243K of the Constitution of India, along with Section 13(2) of the Odisha Gram Panchayat Act, 1964 and Rule 3-B(4) of the Odisha Gram Panchayat Election Rules, 1965, the Commission has announced the schedule for the by-elections to the offices of Sarpanches and Ward Members.

Nomination forms will be issued and nominations will be accepted on May 26, 28, 29, 30, and 31, between 11 am and 3pm.

### Youth Cong files FIR against Amit Malviya, Arnab Goswami

New Delhi: The Indian Youth Congress (IYC) on Wednesday said it has lodged an FIR against BJP leader Amit Malviya and journalist Arnab Goswami under non-bailable sections for allegedly defaming leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi and "conspiring" to link the Congress to Turkey.

Youth Congress national spokesperson Varun Pandey said that the FIR was lodged on the instructions of the organisation's in-charge Krishna Alluvaru, Youth Congress president Uday Bhanu Chib and legal department national chairman Rupesh Bhadoria.

After the registration of the FIR, Chib and Bhadoria alleged malicious attempt to defame the Congress. The FIR charges the two with spreading fake news, inciting hatred and endangering national security.
