Tirupati-bound Spicejet flight returns to Hyderabad after technical snag with baggage door

Hyderabad: A Spicejet flight SG 2696 headed to Tirupati had to turn back to Hyderabad's Rajiv Gandhi International Airport on Thursday after the pilots saw an issue with the baggage door. The airline stated that the flight "experienced an intermittent illumination of the AFT baggage door light after take-off."

According to a Spicejet spokesperson, the pilots noticed the baggage door light was on after take-off and as a precautionary measure, returned to Hyderabad.

"On June 19, 2025, a SpiceJet Q400 aircraft operating the Hyderabad-Tirupati flight experienced an intermittent illumination of the AFT baggage door light after take-off. Cabin pressurisation remained normal throughout. As a precautionary measure, the pilots decided to return to Hyderabad," the airline spokesperson said.

New Delhi (UNI) India has decided to evacuate from Israel those Indian nationals who wish to leave, in view of the increasing bombardments between Iran and Israel.

In a statement today, the Ministry of External Affairs has said that it will facilitate the travel of Indians wishing to be evacuated from Israel, through the land borders and thereafter by air to India. In view of the above, the Embassy of India in Tel Aviv would be making arrangements for the evacuation of Indians.

All Indian nationals are requested to register themselves with the Embassy of India in Tel Aviv (https://www.indembassyisrael.gov.in/independent_national_reg), if not already registered. In case of any

Israeli PM says killing Ayatollah not ruled out amid Iranian missile strikes

Jerusalem (UNI) Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, following Iranian missile strikes at the country's Soroka Hospital and various residential areas has not ruled out killing Iranian Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khomeini, stating that "no one is immune," reports Times of Israel.

Touring Beersheba's Soroka Medical Center in Beersheba after the attack, he said "No one is immune", adding "All the options are open."

Condemning the attack, he said "We will exact the full price from the tyrants in Tehran."

However, he did not elaborate much, stating "It's best



not to speak about this in the press." Regarding any possible American involvement in the war, Netanyahu said that "is a decision for President Trump." "He will do what is good for America, and I will do what's good for Israel," adding that the US president

"knows the game." The Israeli PM said that Tel Aviv had the capability to carry out the operation entirely on its own, if additional military support was not given.

Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz, who has been much more open in his statements about Iran, called Khomeini a "modern day Hitler", and wrote on social media "the prime minister and I instructed the IDF to increase the intensity of the attacks against strategic targets in Iran and against government targets in Tehran in order to remove the threats against the State of Israel and undermine the regime of the ayatollahs.

Black box to be sent to US for data extraction

A week after the deadly AI171 plane crash in Ahmedabad, India will send the black box of the Air India Boeing 787 aircraft to the United States for data recovery, as per sources.

They added that the crucial evidence in the investigation of the crash has suffered damage due to high temperatures following the plane crash, which is making data extraction unfeasible.

Notably, the National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB), the US fed-

eral air crash investigation team, which is already assisting their Indian counterparts in the investigation, will also help in extracting the data at its Washington, DC, office.

Indian delegation will also accompany the black box to oversee the entire investigation process and ensure all protocols are followed.

A black box is basically a 'recorder' planted inside the flight for the purpose of facilitating the investigation of aviation accidents and incidents.

"Congress party, its values, and its workers are dear to me. I have been working with them for the past 16 years, and I have seen their commitment, dedication and idealism," he added.

Asked whether his dif-

ference of opinion is with the Congress' high command or with the state leadership of the party, he evaded the question, saying that he did not want to talk about it now as the voting in the Assembly by-election is ongoing.
