are expected to go all out as the movie approaches its release. After three back-to-back solo posters, Ajay Devgn introduced his full squad in a freshly released movie poster.

vgn can be seen sitting terrified on a beige-colored sofa surrounded by the other cast members, who are pointing guns at him, giving angry looks. The poster looks slick and quirky, hinting at another mad ride of laughs, chaos, and action.

While sharing the quirky poster,

Ajay Devgn wrote, "Yeh family photo nahi... Yeh hone wale dhamake ki warning hai! #SonOfSardaar2 in cinemas this 25th of July!"

Son Of Sardaar 2 full star cast revealed, set to clash with The Fantastic Four. Besides Ajay Devgn, the upcoming comedy sequel retains a few old actors from the previous part, but most of them are fresh additions. Mrunal Thakur is playing the romantic hook to Ajay Devgn's character 'Jassi' while Punjabi actress Neeru Bajwa is rumored to essay the role of his wife. The other cast members include Ravi Kishan, Sanjay Mishra, Vindhya Dara Singh, Chunky Panday, Deepak Dobrial, Kubra Sait, Sharat Saxena, Ashwini Kalsekar, Roshni Walia, Sahil Mehta, and late actor Mukul Dev.

Vijay Kumar Arora, known for Harjeeta and Guddiyan Patole, has directed the movie. Son Of Sardaar 2 is expected to leave a mark at the box office and emerge as a successful story. Fans are awaiting the teaser of the movie, which is expected to be released very soon. The movie is scheduled to release on July 25, 2025, clashing with The Fantastic Four: First Steps. Earlier, Sidharth Malhotra and Janhvi Kapoor's Param Sundari was also releasing on the same date, but now it has been postponed.

**Final Destination Bloodlines Lifetime India Collections: Warner Bros' horror-fantasy ends its SPECTACULAR run netting Rs 61 crore**

Final Destination: Bloodlines is now at the fag end of its spectacular India theatrical run. The horror-fantasy is going to finish with Rs 60.50 crore net (Rs 74 crore gross) on the board and that is phenomenal given that it faced stiff competition from Mission: Impossible - The Final Reckoning. The global run of Bloodlines has again been enviable since this USD 50-60 million budgeted film is going to end up doing USD 285 million or so. All that the movie required was USD 150 million for a theatrical break-even, but it had done almost double. The money coming from the non-theatrical revenue sources will further fill the pockets of the producers.

Expected Total Worldwide Gross USD 285 Million Final Destination: Bloodlines Opened Modestly But Ended Up Doing Spectacularly In Its Full Run, Despite Competition, Final Destination: Bloodlines opened to a modest Rs 4.35 crore net on Thursday including late night previews of Wednesday. After showing a growth on its first Friday, it grew further on Saturday and Sunday, despite new found competition in the last installment of the Mission Impossible series. The movie crossed the Rs 50 crore net mark



on its 18th day and managed to add another Rs 10 crore net in the remainder of its run, for a Rs 60.50 crore net cum.

## India Net Opening Day Box Office Predictions

1. Maa, Kajol's Maa, a horror-drama from the world of Shaista, releases on June 27, 2025. Going by its gripping trailer and Kajol's star power, the movie is expected to open at Rs 4.25-4.75 crore net. This is going to be seen as a reasonable start for a women-led film which competes with an accepted Sitaare Zameen Par.

2. Kannappa (Hindi), Vishnu Manchu's Kannappa also releases in Hindi on 27th June, 2025. The movie boasts of an ensemble with the country's biggest of actors, from Akshay Kumar to Mohanlal, Prabhas and Kajal Aggarwal. The devotional-action looks to open in the vicinity of Rs 50 lakh net as things stand.

3. Nikita Roy, Sonakshi Sinha makes her comeback with a gritty

thriller, Nikita Roy. The movie lacks awareness and may open in the Rs 20 lakh range.

4. Metro In Dino, Anurag Basu's Metro... In Dino, a romantic anthology with Ali Fazal, Fatima Sana Shaikh, Sara Ali Khan, Nina Gupta, Anupam Kher, Aditya Roy Kapur and others, hits theaters on July 4, 2025. Its soulful vibe is likely to draw multiplex crowds despite facing stiff competition from Jurassic World: Rebirth. The opening day prediction for the movie is Rs 3.75-4.25 crore net, a low number for a costly ensemble. The movie, needless to say, relies on strong word of mouth.

5. Aankhon Ki Gustaakhiyan, Vikrant Massey and debutant Shanya Kapoor star in Aankhon Ki Gustaakhiyan, a romantic drama releasing on July 11, 2025. The teaser's emotional pull has sparked interest, and it's predicted to open at Rs 1.50-2 crore net, banking on urban audiences. It faces competition from Rajkumar Rao led Maalik and Warner Bros Superman.

6. Maalik, Rajkummar Rao and Manushi Chhillar's Maalik, directed by Pukit, arrives on 11th July, 2025. The teaser caught attention of the audiences but since then, the other units have not been received too well.

The makers had to change the name of the film for Hindi version as 3 Bollywood films already have Coolie as their title- Amitabh Bachchan's Coolie (1983), Varun Dhawan's Coolie No. 1 (2020) and Govinda's Coolie No. 1 (1995).
