Bhopal: In a significant relief for her family and the state, Manisha Bhatnagar, a resident of Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, who was stranded in Doha, Qatar, amidst the escalating Iran-Israel conflict, has successfully returned home. Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav personally connected with Manisha via phone to inquire about her well-being, expressing immense gratitude to the Government of India for their pivotal role in her safe repatriation, likely under "Operation Sindhu."

Manisha Bhatnagar, a Senior Cabin Crew member with Qatar Airways, found herself caught in the geopolitical crossfire. Upon learning of her plight, Chief Min-



Digvijaya Singh noticed in defamation case by MP-MLA Court



Jabalpur: The MP-MLA Court has issued notice to former Chief Minister and current Rajya Sabha MP, Digvijaya Singh, in a defamation case filed by a BJP MLA. Special Judge D.P. Sutrakar, after hearing the complaint, has directed Singh to present his side. The next hearing for the case is scheduled for July 21, 2025.

The defamation suit was filed by Sushil Tiwari Indu, a BJP MLA from Jabalpur's Panagar constituency. Tiwari alleges that on May 15, 2023, Digvijaya Singh held a press conference in Jabalpur, publicly accusing him of black-marketing 50 to 60 percent of grains from the Public Distribution System (PDS). The complaint states that Singh's remarks, also shared on social media, damaged Tiwari's reputation among party leaders and voters, potentially impacting his electoral performance.

The Special Judge, noting the applicant's statement has been recorded, deemed it essential to hear the respondent's perspective. Consequently, the court ordered the issuance of a notice to Digvijaya Singh.

Advanced agriculture key to doubling farmer income - Agricultural Production Commissioner

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is ushering in a new era of agricultural transformation, focused on doubling farmer incomes through innovation, crop diversification, and allied ventures. Agricultural Production Commissioner Ashok Barnwal, outlining the state's forward-looking strategy under Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav's vision, emphasized integrating modern practices with on-ground support.

MPPSC recruits 3,756 in 18 months

► Another 5,562 positions on the horizon

Bhopal: Under Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav's tenure, which began approximately eighteen months ago, the Madhya Pradesh Public Service Commission (MPPSC) has successfully recruited 3,756 individuals across various government departments. Dr. Yadav assumed office on December 12, 2023.

Accelerating recruitment and strengthening state services

Dr. Rajesh Lal Mehra, Chairman of the MPPSC, reported that since December 2023, the commission has issued 75 advertisements for 4,492 positions, leading to recommendation letters for the appointment of 3,756 candidates to their respective departments.

The MPPSC has issued a total of 81 recruitment advertisements, through which an additional 5,562 positions are expected to be filled in the coming months. Currently, 61 recruitment processes are underway for 5,317 posts. The commission is diligently working to complete these recruitment drives in a timely manner, adhering to its

annual examination calendar. These results comply with directives from the Madhya Pradesh government and the High Court to declare results for 87% of the total advertised positions.

Chief Minister Dr. Yadav commended the MPPSC, stating that as an institution, it has consistently demonstrated its dedication to state service by identifying and selecting the most suitable and talented young individuals for prestigious government roles. He added that the commission has made a significant contribution to the process of nation-building, thereby solidifying its role as the cornerstone of a capable and efficient state administration.

Prabal Sipaha, Secretary of the MPPSC, elaborated that during this period, the commission declared final selection results for 1,109 positions through three State Service Examinations (2019, 2021, 2022), and 200 positions for the Madhya Pradesh Finance Service were recommended to their respective departments.

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During this period, the State Service Examination led to recommendations for 72 Deputy Collectors for the General Administration Department and 51 Deputy Superintendents of Police for the Home Department. Additionally, 132 Assistant Directors for the School Education Department and 22 positions for the Madhya Pradesh Finance Service were recommended to their respective departments.

Under the State Forest Service Examination, 19 Assistant Forest Conservators and 181 Forest Rangers and Project Area Officers were recommended to the Forest Department. The Public Health and Medical Education Department received recommendations for 7 Radiologist Specialists. For the AYUSH Department, recommendations were made for 543 Ayurvedic Medical Officers across 17 subjects and 71 AYUSH Lecturers. Lastly, the Higher Education Department received recommendations for 727 Assistant Professor positions across 25 subjects through the Assistant Professor Examination 2022.
