# Congress accuses ECI of voter suppression ahead of Bihar polls

The Congress today leveled serious allegations against the Election Commission of India (ECI), claiming that deliberate attempts are being made to compromise the integrity of the electoral process, and accused it of acting as a "pawn" in this process.

Addressing a media conference at the AICC headquarters here, Congress spokesperson Pawan Khera along with Bihar Congress chief Rajesh Kumar and Bihar in-charge Krishna Allavaru alleged that the top poll body is being misused to undermine the fundamental right to vote and that efforts are underway to redraw the entire voter list in Bihar.

"It's shocking that when the Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi or the Congress president and Leader of the Opposition in the Rajya Sabha,



Mallikarjun Kharge, make legitimate demands — such as sharing the voter list or providing footage from the day of voting — the Commission remains silent for months," Khera said.

He said the Commission's swift move to redraw the entire voter list of Bihar within just a month raises serious questions about priorities

and transparency. Highlighting the party's attempts to engage with the Commission, Khera alleged that when Congress representatives seek meetings with the Chief Election Commissioner (CEC), they are met with a "hostile tone".

"We are told — 'This is the new Election Commission, the new normeet," he claimed.

Khera further alleged that the Chief Election Commissioner has initiated a concerning trend of "planting stories" by messaging select journalists, assuming such tactics will go unnoticed.

### Opposition misleading people on Special Intensive **Revision of Electoral rolls in Bihar: Mangal**

Patna: Senior BJP leader and Bihar Health Minister Mangal Pandey alleged today that opposition parties were misleading people on Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral rolls in Bihar, saying only false impression on the issue was being created by them. Pandey said here that SIR of electoral rolls,was not the first exercise of any sort, being carried out in Bihar as similar revision of voters list was also conducted in the year 2003. Opposition leaders were misleading the people that such a massive exercise could not be completed within 31 days but they should know the fact that earlier such exercise was also carried out in 31 days as well, he pointed out.

# **Dubey claims Shivakumar to** replace Siddaramaiah in Nov

BJP MP Dr Nishikant Dubey today claimed that a leadership change has already been finalised within the Karnataka Congress, alleging that DK Shivakumar will replace Siddaramaiah as Chief Minister by November this year.

In a statement posted on social media, Dr Dubey said, "The deal for Karnataka Congress has been finalised — in the month of November, DK Shivakumar will become the new Chief Minister. Siddaramaiah will be made to resign citing old age.

Taking a swipe at Congress chief Mallikarjun Kharge, he further added, "Is it Mr Kharge's turn next? Are preparations underway to repeat the 'dhoti-pulling episode' of Sitaram Kesari at various places?"

The "dhoti-kand" remark was a reference to the unceremonious removal of former Congress chief Sitaram Kesari in 1998, an episode

The Manipur government has decided to take up fresh security measures following repeated attacks on farmers and forcible seizure of grains by suspected Kuki militants.

The state police today said in a

statement that in response to heightened concerns over security during the ongoing farming season, the authorities have significantly stepped up safety measures across the state to ensure protection of farmers and prevent untoward incidents.

A high-level Combined Headquarters (CHO) meeting was convened on June 28, chaired by the Security Advisor and attended by the chief secretary, Director General of Police (DGP), and senior officials of security forces. The meeting focused on reviewing and strengthening security protocols, particularly in the wake of recent incidents in Phubala, Bishnupur district.

As part of the security enhancement, Manipur Police personnel have been deployed at vulnerable farming areas across both hill and

Nine members of gang held in Hazaribagh with arms

Hazaribagh: The Hazaribagh police today arrested nine members of the notorious Uttam Yadav gang who were allegedly planning a serious criminal act in the St. Columba's College Road area of the city. The arrests were made following a swift response to a tip-off received by the district police on July 2.

Acting on the intelligence, police launched a special operation under the leadership of SDPO Sadar Amit Anand. During intensified anticrime checking near the bus stand, a black motorcycle followed by an SUV was spotted. When signaled to stop, the suspects tried to flee through a muddy path. Police teams quickly surrounded the area and nabbed seven suspects.

During interrogation, the accused confessed to being active members of the Uttam Yadav gang.

HC seeks detailed report in law student gang-rape case, next hearing on July 10

The Calcutta High Court on Thursday directed the West Bengal government to submit a detailed progress report and produce the case diary within seven days in connection with the alleged gang-rape of a first-year law student from South Calcutta Law College.

The directive was issued by a division bench comprising Justice Soumen Sen and Justice Smita Das during the initial hearing of three public interest litigations (PILs) de-manding a CBI probe into the June

The next hearing is scheduled for July 10. The bench has also asked the state and the college authorities to file their respective affidavits before

The case, which was first registered at Kasba police station, saw rapid developments. Within 24 hours

of the FIR being filed, three suspects were arrested. They are Monojit Mishra, an ex-student; and Jaib Ahmed and Pramit Mukhopadhyay both senior students of the same in

Initial investigation was carried out by the local police before it was transferred to a Special Investigation Team led by an officer of ACP rank On Wednesday, the Detective De partment of Kolkata Police formally took over the probe and invoked additional charges, including kidnap-ping and assault with dangerous

According to investigators, the assault reportedly took place inside the guard's room in the college premises. Mishra is accused of committing the rape, while Ahmed and Mukhopad hyay allegedly abetted the crime.

In a speech laced with satirical quips the MP made remarks that reflected his "ignorance about the historic roles of Rajasthan's real heroes, including the Jat King of Bharatpur Maharaja Suraj Mal, Maharana Pratap and Panna Dhai.

## AIIMS panel dismisses link between Covid-19 jabs and sudden heart attack deaths

New Delhi (UNI)

A panel of doctors from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi, today sought to clear the air on the efficacy of Covid-19 vaccines, affirming that there was no credible link between the vaccines and sudden deaths, including those attributed to heart attacks.

According to the doctors, such incidents were more likely to be tied to lifestyle factors and comorbities, including smoking and excessive alconsumption,

rather than the Covid jabs. Their assertion came a

day after the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare issued a statement following Karnataka chief minister Siddaramaiah ordered a study on the reasons behind sudden deaths among young people in the state, and to see if the Covid-19 vaccines could have any adverse effects.

The Health Ministry had dismissed any link between the vaccines and the increasing cases of sudden fatalities due to heart attacks.
