

Commissioner orders strict action against illegal fertilizer sales

► Emphasizes natural farming push



Bhopal: Bhopal Division Commissioner Sanjeev Singh has directed the Agriculture Welfare and Development Department to ensure uninterrupted availability of fertilizers to farmers and to take strict action against black marketing and illegal sales. He also emphasized the urgent resolution of pending complaints on the

Chief Minister's Helpline. The directives came during a time-bound review meeting held at the Commissioner's office on Friday. Joint Commissioner Vinod Yadav and officials from various departments were present. Commissioner Singh instructed that complaints pending for over 100 days on the CM Helpline be addressed on priority and that districts improve their performance rankings. He stressed efficient handling of grievances on the "Samadhan Online" platform as well. In a key initiative to promote sustainable agriculture, the division is boosting natural farming. Deputy Director of Agriculture, Suman Prasad, informed the meeting that under the natural farming scheme, 12,500 farmers across 100 clusters in Bhopal division are being supported to practice chemical-free farming on 5,000 hectares of land. Of these, 9,771 farmers have already registered on the m-Kisan portal. Over 200 Kisan Sakhis (women farmer facilitators) are actively raising awareness about modern techniques and the benefits of natural farming. The initiative aims to reduce input costs, preserve soil fertility, and promote sustainable, profitable agriculture. Officials reaffirmed their commitment to ensuring timely services and transparent agricultural practices, supporting both environmental goals and farmer welfare.

Bhopal gears up for PM's Rozgar Mela

254 new recruits to receive **Bhopal:** Excitement builds in Bhopal as the city prepares to host a significant 'Prime Minister's Rozgar Mela' event tomorrow, Saturday, July 12, 2025. Organized by the West Central Railway, Bhopal Division, the grand ceremony will take place at the Railway Auditorium, Narmada Railway Club, Habibganj (opposite Sanchi Milk Dairy), commencing at 10 AM. The event is part of the central government's nationwide initiative to boost employment. Prime Minister Narendra Modi will address approximately 51,000 newly appointed candidates across the country via video conferencing, virtually handing over appointment letters. In Bhopal, the local ceremony will be graced by the Union Minister for Agriculture & Farmers Welfare and Panchayat & Rural Development, Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan, as the Chief Guest. He will personally distribute appointment letters to 254 successful candidates. These include 196 recruits for the railway department and 58 for other central government departments such as banking, CISE, Narcotics Control Bureau, and the Postal Department.

Cop's daughter files complaint against husband

► Dowry harassment case registered

Bhopal: A 31-year-old woman, daughter of a serving police inspector, has lodged a dowry harassment case at Kamla Nagar police station after initial denial of assistance. The FIR was registered only after senior police officials intervened following a complaint against Station House Officer (SHO) Nirupa Pandey. According to sources, the woman was married to Saransh Upadhyay on December 24, 2022. She alleged that her husband and mother-in-law, Kalpana Upadhyay—residents near DIG Bungalow under Gautam Nagar police station limits—harassed her for a dowry of Rs 35 lakh. **Counselling session held at Mahila Thana:** Initially, the woman and her father attempted to resolve the matter amicably by approaching internal police channels. A counselling session was held at the Bhopal Mahila Thana (women's police station), but it failed to bring any resolution. When the woman later approached Kamla Nagar police station to file a formal complaint, she was reportedly denied support. Her father then submitted a complaint against TI Nirupa Pandey to senior police officers. Following this, the SHO was reprimanded and an FIR was registered. Kamla Nagar police have booked the accused under sections related to dowry harassment, assault, criminal intimidation, and provisions of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Police bust large-scale counterfeit urea racket

Bhopal: Sukhi Sewaniya police have busted a large-scale operation involving counterfeit urea, used in diesel vehicle pollution control systems. A raid on July 9, following a tip-off from a lubricant company's regional manager, led to the seizure of fake products worth approximately Rs 13 lakh from a warehouse masquerading as legitimate lubricant and automotive brands. Station House Officer Rambabu Choudhary confirmed that hundreds of buckets falsely labeled with brands like Gulf AL, Tata Motors, Eicher, Mahindra, and Bharat Benz were recovered, alongside branded IBC tanks. During the raid, Himmat Singh Jatav, an employee, was detained. He confessed that the illicit business was run by Jagdish Kumar Vasantani, who remains at large. Jatav revealed that Vasantani sourced fake urea, printed counterfeit brand stickers, and repackaged the product for sale as genuine. A case has been registered under fraud and Copyright Act charges.

BMHRC joins National Radiation Emergency Network

► Gains scientific recognition



Bhopal: In a major scientific milestone, Bhopal Memorial Hospital and Research Centre (BMHRC) has been inducted into the prestigious Indian Biodosimetry Network (IN-BioDoS). With this, BMHRC becomes the first and only institution in Central India to join the elite group of six labs across the country equipped to assess radia-

tion exposure during emergencies. BMHRC's cytogenetic laboratory will now play a vital role in identifying the extent of radiation exposure in affected individuals, enabling accurate and timely medical treatment. This is especially crucial in emergencies such as nuclear accidents, radiation leaks in hospitals, or industrial mishaps. Dr.

Ravindra M. Samarth, Assistant Professor at BMHRC, explained that the lab analyzes blood samples to detect radiation-induced damage to chromosomes using techniques like the Di-centric Chromosome Assay (DCA) and Micronucleus Assay. These tests help determine the radiation dose received, which is key to beginning appropriate treatment. Radiation is increasingly used in sectors like nuclear energy and medicine—particularly in cancer treatment. In the event of accidental overexposure, biodosimetry provides critical data to guide life-saving interventions. Launched by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), the IN-BioDoS network includes labs in Chennai, Delhi, Lucknow, Mangaluru, Kalpakkam, and now Bhopal. Together, these labs will strengthen India's preparedness for radiation-related emergencies. Dr. Manisha Srivastava, In-charge Director of BMHRC, called the inclusion "a matter of pride," highlighting the lab's scientific excellence and its potential to support the region during radiation crises.

Man dies in mishap in Eintkhedi

► Family alleges foul play

Bhopal: A 38-year-old man, Mahendra Singh Dangi, was found dead under suspicious circumstances near Chaurasia Dhaba in the Eintkhedi area of rural Bhopal late Thursday night. His body, discovered in a pool of blood, has raised serious doubts among family members despite initial police claims of a road accident. Dangi, a resident of Sharda Nagar in Lambakheda and employed at a local wine shop, was reportedly last seen riding his bike. His nephew, Ravi Dangi, told police that the first news of Mahendra's death came from an unidentified woman who was present at the scene. She claimed that Mahendra offered her a lift and the bike later skidded into a ditch.



However, Ravi questioned her story, asking how she remained unharmed if she too was on the bike. He demanded her role be thoroughly investigated. **Eyewitnesses supported the road accident theory: ASP** Additional Superintendent of Police (Rural Bhopal) Neeraj Chourasiya said that eyewitnesses supported the road accident theory and that injuries suggested a collision with a heavy vehicle. "The woman's identity and her account are under scrutiny. We're investigating all angles," he said. The body was handed over to the family after post-mortem. Police have registered a case and are probing the incident from both accident and possible foul play perspectives.

Woman dies by suicide in Kolar area

Bhopal: A 24-year-old married woman named Muskan allegedly died by suicide in the Kolar area of Bhopal in the early hours of Friday, police said. The incident reportedly occurred around 3:30 am at her residence in Sarvadharm, A Sector, where she lived with her husband, Anil. According to Kolar police station in-charge, Sanjay Singh Soni, Muskan was found hanging. Her husband claimed the two had an argument before the incident after he caught her talking to another man over the phone. He alleged that Muskan had been in frequent contact with the man and had once even attempted to elope, though she returned home after persuasion. Anil told police they had been married for seven years and had no children. On the night of the incident, a confrontation occurred when he again found her speaking to the same man. After the argument, he said he went to sleep but later woke up to find Muskan hanging.
