# Two students drown during picnic outing ► Pleasure turned tragedy at Kolar Dam

**Bhopal:** A joyous picnic at Kolar Dam turned to tragedy as two Bhopal students, Prince Singh and Ujjwal Tripathi, drowned after venturing into deep waters. Their friends' desperate cries for help shattered the festive atmosphere. After an arduous 18-hour search operation, police and SDRF teams recovered their bodies, casting a pall of grief over the community.

### Fatal fun: Friends swept away

The devastating incident unfolded near Sehore at Kolar Dam. Four friends from Bhopal had gathered for a leisurely day, but the fun took a fatal turn when Prince Singh and Ujjwal Tripathi entered the water. Evewitnesses recounted that the quartet was enjoying themselves before the two victims drifted into deeper sections of the dam and disappeared beneath the surface. Their friends' valiant attempts to

Police confirmed that the victims drowned due to entering deep water. Their companions immediately alerted authorities, prompting Bilkisganj Station In-charge Sandeep Meena and his team to rush to the scene, quickly joined by the SDRF. A search operation was launched without delay, leading to the recovery of the students' bodies by afternoon. A case has been registered, and investigations are under-

# Monsoon fury grips Madhya Pradesh Heavy rains expected, alerts issued across districts

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is bracing for another wave of intense monsoon activity, with the Meteorological Department forecasting widespread rain and thunderstorms across most parts of the state on Tuesday. Several districts are under alert as continuous downpours are expected to persist

Districts including Betul, Harda, Khandwa, Khargone, Jhabua, Ratlam, Neemuch, Guna, Ashoknagar, Shivpuri, Damoh, Chhatarpur, Tikamgarh, and Niwari are all on alert for impending rainfall. Along with the precipitation, winds gusting between 30 to 40 kmph are also anticipated.

Furthermore, regions Raisen, Vidisha, Satna, Narmadapuram, Singrauli, Sidhi, Umaria, Katni, and Narsinghpur are also expected to receive continuous rainfall, potentially accompanied by thunder and lightning. The Meteorological Department had previously indicated a high likelihood of heavy rainfall across the state until July 17.



According to the weather bureau, the monsoon trough currentnortheastern Rajasthan and a wellmarked low-pressure area over adnorthwest Pradesh, all the way to a wellmarked low-pressure area over Ranchi, southeastern Gangetic West Bengal, and adjoining Bangladesh. A western distur-

bance is also active as a trough in the mid-tropospheric levels. The over northeast Rajasthan and adnorthwest Pradesh, along with its associated cyclonic circulation, is expected to move gradually west-northwest wards across Rajasthan over the next two days, signaling continued unsettled weather.
