One district-one product: Madhya Pradesh bags silver medal

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is mak-ing significant strides in global markets through the "One Dis-trict-One Product" (ODOP) scheme. This initiative has garnered national recognition, culminating in the state receiving the Silver Award in the State and Union Territory category at the One District One Product Award 2024. The award was presented by Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal during a ceremony held at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi. It acknowledges Madhya Pradesh's effective im-plementation of the ODOP scheme, which focuses on brand building for local products, generating employment, and fostering both rural and urban entrepreneurship.

The event was attended by Delhi CM Rekha Gupta, senior ministers from the Government of India, and representatives from various states. The award was accepted by Mrs. Ruhi Khan, Deputy Secretary of the Department of Industry, Commerce and Investment Promotion Poli-cy on behalf of Madhya Pradesh.



ODOP scheme designed to elevate local products to global stage

The ODOP scheme is de-signed to elevate local products to a global stage. By forming a robust network of local exporters, Madhya Pradesh is transitioning from a local economy to a global marketplace. Several

products have received Geographical Indication (GI) tags, boosting their international ap-peal. The recognition of handi-crafts, agricultural, and food products is enhancing the livelihoods of artisans and manufac-turers across the state.

The scheme features special products that reflect the unique geographical and cultural char-

acteristics of each district, including green vegetables, coarse grains, crafts, handloom, and handicrafts. To date, 19 specific products have been awarded GI tags, such as Chanderi Sarees, Bagh Print textiles, Nagpuri Or-anges, and Kadaknath Chicken, with seven of these included in the ODOP initiative.

MLA stages paddy plantation protest against waterlogging

Dabra (Gwalior): Residents of Dabra in Gwalior district are reeling from severe wacolonies into virtual lakes. In a striking act of protest, local MLA Suresh Raje, accompanied by party workers, took to the waterlogged streets near the bus stand to plant paddy, symbolizing the extent of the flooding crisis. The demonstration escalated when ad-ministrative officials failed to arrive promptly to address their concerns, prompting MLA Raje and his supporters to stage a sit-in amidst the standing water.

Protest ends after official assurance

After a nearly three-hour standoff, SDM Divyanshu Choudhary and CMO Sakshi Vajpayee arrived at the scene. They assured

Balaghat tops in state in plantation by school children



Bhopal: To make the students aware about environmental protection, the School Education Department has given instructions to plant saplings under the Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam campaign through the students enrolled in the schools.

Balaghat district ranks first in Madhya Pradesh in terms of plantation by school children. This campaign is being effectively implemented in Balaghat district under the guidance of Collector Mr. Mrinal Meena. Along with the protection of the

plants planted in this campaign, instructions have been given to upload their photos on the My Life app. After uploading the photo on this app, certificates are also being provided to the students planting the saplings by the Principal of the school.

District Education Officer Ashwini Upadhyay said that as per the instructions of the department, plantation is being done under the Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam Abhiyan with the participation of students. Students are planting saplings in the name of mother in the school premises, their homes and fields. In Balaghat district, till July 15, 26 thousand 913 saplings have been planted by the students of 1255 schools under this campaign.

Under this campaign, among the schools of Balaghat district, St. Mary School Balaghat is in first place, Sandipani Vidyalaya Bolegaon is in second place and Sandipani Vidyalaya Katangi is in third place. Special attention is being paid to the protection of the saplings being planted by the children of the schools under the Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam Abhiyan.

Negligence blamed for city's plight

The severe waterlogging is widely attrib-uted to the municipality's negligence, as drains and storm sewers were reportedly not cleaned before the monsoon season. This oversight has led to widespread urban flooding.

Last year, areas like Chinour Road and Nandu Ke Dera in Dabra experienced flood-like conditions, yet the administration seemingly failed to learn from the past.

Campaign will start for PM Kisan **Yojana** saturation

Bhopal: The Commissioner of Land Records has informed that a campaign will be run in the state for PM Kisan Yojana saturation, in which by contacting as many farmers as possible, the process will be completed with the farmers left out of saturation and benefit distribution will be ensured. Preparations have been started for better conduct of the campaign.

About 5 lakh farmers in the state have taken action to enable e-KYC and Aadhaar bank account for DBT. It is proposed to take action to create farmer registry by more than 20 lakh farmers in the scheme.

It is noteworthy that under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana, a total amount of Rs 6 thousand is being provided to eligible farmer families in a year. Beneficiaries receive the amount only after completing the mandatory action of the scheme like e-KYC, Aadhaar, bank account, enablement for DBT and farmer registry. It is proposed to distribute the 20th installment of the scheme in the month of July 2025.
