

# Dhadak 2: Siddhant shot 'half' film without even knowing title & it has Ishaan Khatter connection



Dhadak 2 is one of the most anticipated movies to be released this year. The upcoming intense romantic drama stars Siddhant Chaturvedi and Triptii Dimri as the main leads. But do you know that the team had begun shooting without having a title for the movie? In fact, Siddhant shot half of the film with no title and later learned it from Ishaan Khatter.

Siddhant Chaturvedi recalls shooting for Dhadak 2 as an untitled film. During the promotions of Dhadak 2, Siddhant Chaturvedi recently revealed that Dhadak 2 was an untitled project when he signed for the film. Siddhant shared that the movie went on the floors without having a title, and he and his co-star, Triptii Dimri, had no idea that it would be called

Dhadak 2 later on. Siddhant Chaturvedi learned about the title while meeting Ishaan Khatter. Siddhant Chaturvedi then remembered that he had met Ishaan Khatter at a movie screening. The Gully Boy actor recounted that he was surprised when Ishaan informed him about the title of Dhadak 2, as he wasn't aware of

his own film, unlike the Dhadak star. "...He was the one who told me before I knew, and I've gone and shot half of the script there. Without me knowing, and he knows," the Dhadak 2 actor shared.

Siddhant Chaturvedi also praised Ishaan Khatter's performance in Dhadak. He called him "fabulous" in the first installment of the Dhadak franchise. It is worth noting that they have worked together in the 2022 horror comedy, Phone Bhoot, co-starring Katrina Kaif. Currently, Siddhant has Dhadak 2 on the horizon. Ishaan is yet to announce his next Bollywood project. His 2025 film, Homebound, premiered at the 2025 Cannes International Film Festival.

A brief about Dhadak 2, Produced under the banner of Dharm Productions, Dhadak 2 marks the spiritual sequel to the 2018 film, Dhadak, which was headlined by Ishaan Khatter and Janhvi Kapoor. The upcoming movie, starring Siddhant Chaturvedi and Triptii Dimri, is a Hindi remake of the Tamil film Pariyerum Perumal (2018).

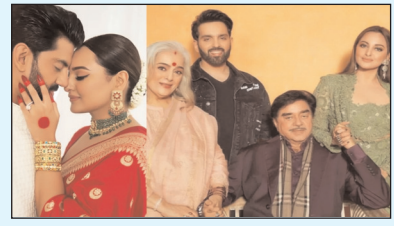
# Sonakshi Sinha's brother Kuss breaks silence on family rift rumors after her marriage: 'If someone wants...'

# Director Mohit Suri reveals filmmakers warned him against making Saiyaara: 'No one's going to make youngster...'



Filmmaker Mohit Suri, who last helmed Ek Villain Returns, is making his directorial comeback with his much-awaited film, Saiyaara. The upcoming musical romantic drama stars newcomers Ahaan Panday and Aneet Padda. Suri has now revealed that industry veterans had warned him against making Saiyaara.

Mohit Suri shares filmmakers didn't want Saiyaara to get materialized. In a new interview with Variety, Mohit Suri spoke about how he was dissuaded by industry veterans for not making Saiyaara. Suri recalled that they didn't believe in the 'youngster love story'.

Quoting filmmakers, the Saiyaara director said, "No one's going to make a youngster, newcomer or love story in this market, in this age where everything has become about the blockbuster, larger than life cinema."

Mohit Suri had written the film by then; however, fate changed when he later collaborated with Yash Raj Films. According to the director, the production house liked the script as the YRF team was actively seeking a story like that.

Saiyaara was initially Aashiqui 3, here's what changed. In an ex-

clusive interview with Pinkvilla last month, Mohit Suri confirmed that he was initially asked to work on Aashiqui 3. Suri was collaborating with Bhushan Kumar and Mukesh Bhatt at the time. The notable filmmaker shared that Saiyaara's idea was originally for Aashiqui 3.

"They (Bhushan and Mukesh) were in the hurry and wanted to announce, which is something I was not comfortable with. I prefer in having a script first and then make an announcement," the Saiyaara director told us.

Saiyaara records historic pre-sales, to release tomorrow, Saiyaara is set to score the second-biggest advance bookings of 2025. As of 3:30 pm, Ahaan Panday and Aneet Padda's film has sold 138,000 tickets in top national chains, with a few hours to go before its release in theaters. It is expected to sell 1,75,000 tickets in final pre-sales.

Saiyaara is headed for a historic start at the box office. It will hit the screens on July 18, 2025.

Before Saiyaara, Mohit Suri directed popular movies such as Aashiqui 2, Zeher, Awarapan, Woh Lamhe, Ek Villain, Humari Adhooori Kahani, Half Girlfriend, and Malang, among others.
