Pakistan protests linking of TRF with LeT after US terror designation

Islamabad (UNI) Pakistan today protested linking of The Resistance Front (TRF), responsible for the horrific April 22 Pahalgam attack in Jammu and Kashmir, India, with Lashkar-e-Taiba, after the US designated the TRF as a Foreign Terrorist Organisation and officially termed it as "a front and proxy of the Lashkar-e-Taiba".



The Pakistan Foreign Office, in a statement, said that "Any linkage with LeT, a defunct organization banned in Pakistan, belies ground realities. Pakistan has effectively and comprehensively dismantled concerned outfits, arrested and prosecuted the leadership, and deradicalized its cadres," Islamabad claimed.

Pakistan also said that Investigations into the Pahalgam incident "are still inconclusive", in reference to its offer of joint investigation into the terror attack. India has rejected Pakistan's offer of a joint investigation, in the aftermath of the 2016 Pathankot attack, in which India had agreed to a joint investigation only to find that Islamabad sent its Inter-Services Intelligence officials into

the Indian Air Force's compound there.

US Secretary of State Marco Rubio in his statement on designating the TRF clearly stated,

"Today, the Department of State

is adding The Resistance Front (TRF) as a designated Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO) and Specially Designated Global Terrorist (SDGT).

"TRF, a Lashkar-e-Tayyiba (LeT) front and proxy, claimed responsibility for the April 22, 2025, Pahalgam attack which killed 26 civilians.

"This was the deadliest attack on civilians in India since the 2008 Mumbai attacks conducted by LeT. TRF has also claimed responsibility for several attacks against Indian security forces, including most recently in 2024.

"These actions taken by the Department of State demonstrates the Trump Administration's commitment to protecting our national security interests, countering terrorism, and enforcing President Trump's call for justice for the Pahalgam attack.

Registration for Atal Pension: Balaghat tops in the country

Administrative Correspondent Bhopal: Atal Pension Yojana is being run to provide a fixed pension amount to the people working in the unorganized sector in the country after the age of 60 years. To add more and more people from the unorganized sector to the scheme, a special campaign was run by the Central Government from May 1 to July 15 this year across the country. In this campaign, 10 districts of MP have made it to the top ten districts of the country in adding new people and getting them registered. In this, Balaghat district has secured the first position in the country. This achievement is a big achievement for the state as well as Balaghat. The final score of this campaign was released on July 18 by the Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority.

In this campaign, Balaghat district has made 418 percent achievement by linking 12 thousand 507 people with Atal Pension Yojana against the target of 2992. Sheopur district ranked second with 304 percent achievement by adding 2538 persons against 836, Alirajpur district ranked third with 194 percent achievement by adding 1705 persons against 880, Ujjain district ranked

fourth with 191 percent achievement by adding 10813 persons against 5676, Anuppur district ranked fifth with 189 percent achievement by adding 2542 persons against 1342, Umaria district ranked sixth with 184 percent achievement by adding 1819 persons against 990.

Besides, Chhindwara ranked seventh with 183 percent achievement by adding 9148 persons against 4994, Dindori district ranked eighth with 182 percent achievement by adding 1720 persons against 946, Shahdol district ranked 3445 persons against 1936 By adding 3314 people against 1870, the district has achieved the ninth position with 178 percent achievement and Damoh district has achieved the tenth position in the country with 177 percent achievement by adding 3314 people against 1870. Under the campaign, these districts which are in the first 10 positions in the country in adding the names of maximum number of people in Atal Pension Yojana will be given the Award of Excellence.

Atal Pension Yojana is a social security scheme of the Government of India, which has been designed mainly for people working in the unorganized sector.

Ten people involved in illegal conversion arrested

Confirming the arrests here this afternoon, Uttar Pradesh director general of police (DGP), Rajeev Kr-

ishna, in a press conference said that in order to face the specific challenges coming in the sequence of these efforts of the government, UP Police had launched a new 'Mission Asmita', in which earlier two named accused of illegal religious conversion syndicate Mohd. Umar Gautam and Mufti Jahangir Alam Qazmi were arrested by UP ATS.

Recently, the syndicate of illegal religious conversion of Chhangur

Baba alias Jalaluddin has been exposed by UP STF and ATS and the named accused have been arrested. This campaign is against criminals involved in serious crimes through love jihad, illegal conversion, dark web and other networks with the aim of obtaining international jihadi funding in the name of jihad, radicalization and breaching national security.

DGP said in this connection, Agra police arrested ten people from six states.

The arrested accused were identified as Ayesha (SB Krishna) from Goa, Ali Hasan (Shekhar Roy), and Osama from Kolkata, Rehman Qureshi from Agra, Abbu Talib from Khalapar, Muzaffarnagar, Abur Rehman from Dehradun, Mohamad Ali (1), Junaid and Mohammed Ali (2) from Jaipur, Rajasthan and Mustafa alias Manoj from Delhi.

4 burnt alive as car bursts into flames on NH-30

Kanker (Chhattisgarh): Four persons were burnt alive and two injured today when their speeding car — heading here from Keshkal along National Highway 30 — burst into flames after colliding against the railing of a bridge in the vicinity of this district's Aatur village, police said.

The deceased were identified as Deepak Maravi, Suraj Phalke, Yuvraj Sadi and Hemant Sodi while Preetam Meshram and Prithviraj Salaam were injured. The dead were aged between 19 and 25 years. The accident occurred at 0100 hrs. Those hurt have been admitted at the District Hospital. Fire brigade personnel brought the blaze under control. Five friends from Dondra Pal village were coming here to drop a friend.

Golden Temple receives 7th threat email, SGPC questions govt's inaction

Chandigarh: The Golden Temple today received its seventh threat email, continuing a string of disturbing messages over the past week.

Speaking to the media, former Akal Takht Jathedar and current Head Granthi Giani Raghbir Singh expressed concern over the silence of the Punjab government. He said despite multiple threats, no official communication has been made with the SGPC.

Calling the emails a sign of a "larger conspiracy", Giani Raghbir Singh stated that two suspects were arrested yesterday, yet the threats persist, creating fear among devotees.

Life sentence to 9 in Rs 100 Crore 'Digital Arrest' Cyber fraud case

In a landmark judgment, a West Bengal court has sentenced nine people to life imprisonment for their role in a massive 'digital arrest' scam, one of the first convictions of its kind in India. This high-profile cybercrime case involved a 70-year-old victim who was digitally arrested and manipulated into transferring Rs 1 crore

over seven days. The scam came to light after the victim filed a complaint on November 6, 2024, at Kalyani Ranaghat Police Station. The fraud began with a WhatsApp call from a scammer posing as a police officer named SI Hemraj Koli from Andheri Police Station, Mumbai. The caller falsely accused the victim of a crime and threatened legal action unless large sums were deposited into various bank accounts.

According to the West Bengal Cyber Crime Police, the gang behind this fraud had defrauded at least 108 people across India, siphoning over Rs 100 crore using similar digital arrest tactics.

Thirteen people were arrested in connection with this case during raids led by the CID Cyber Crime Cell. The convicts came from different states—Gujarat, Maharashtra, and Haryana.

Odisha: Minor girl abducted & set on fire by miscreants

Puri: A tense and eerie silence hangs over Bayabar village under the jurisdiction of Balanga police station in Odisha's Puri district, after a minor girl was abducted in broad daylight, taken to a riverbank, and set on fire by unidentified miscreants.

According to the victim's father, Hamid Ali, the girl had gone to her friend's house, located about 500 yards from their residence in the village. Reports indicate that while returning home around 9 AM, three youths on two motorcycles intercepted her, gagged her with a cloth, and abducted her.

They took her nearly one kilometre away to the bank of the Bhargavi river, where they poured kerosene on her, set her ablaze, and fled the scene.

Despite severe burn injuries, the girl managed to run to the nearby house of Hrusikesh Mullick, seeking help.

Mullick told the media that he gave her water and clothes, as her attire was completely burned.

Land for medical college at one rupee
