

Flames of anarchy now reached your own people!

- Patwari slams government on law and order in MP
- Political firestorm erupts as BJP leader's murder fuels crime concerns

Bhopal: The brutal murder of BJP Mandal Vice-President Shyam Lal Dhakad in Hingoriya Bada village, Nahargarh area of Mandsaur, has ignited a political firestorm across Madhya Pradesh. The shocking incident has drawn sharp criticism from PCC Chief Jitu Patwari, who launched a scathing attack on the ruling BJP government via social media platform X.

In a strongly worded tweet, PCC Chief Jitu Patwari stated, "BJP Mandal Vice-President Shyam Lal Dhakad has been brutally murdered with a sharp weapon in Hingoriya Bada, Nahargarh area of Mandsaur! This sensational incident, amidst rampant lawlessness and rising crime, occurred in the



Deputy Chief Minister's home district! Chief Minister vs. Home Minister, the flames of anarchy have now reached your own people! Will the stubbornness to remain in the Home Minister's post persist, or will the silence be broken after this murder?"

The tragic discovery was made on the morning of July 19th when Dhakad's son found his father's body, drenched in blood, on the second floor of their home. Mandsaur Superintendent of Police Ab-

hishek Anand confirmed that preliminary investigations indicate multiple stab wounds to the head inflicted by a sharp weapon. It is suspected that the assailant gained access to the room via a shed located near the house.

The murder of Shyam Lal Dhakad, an active BJP worker, is particularly significant as it occurred in the home district and Malhargarh assembly constituency of Deputy Chief Minister Jagdish Devda. Following the incident, Devda took to social media to promise an impartial investigation and directed the police to apprehend the culprits as soon as possible.

The incident has intensified the ongoing debate about the state of law and order in Madhya Pradesh, with the opposition seizing the opportunity to challenge the government's efficacy in ensuring public safety. The political ramifications are expected to reverberate as authorities race to bring the perpetrators to justice.

Sharma allegedly smashed the window of Ankit Jadon's car after it was not immediately moved. When Jadon arrived and protested the



took swift action, sending Sharma to the police lines. IG Arvind Saxena acknowledged prima facie fault on the ASI's part, stating such public behavior is "improper."
