

Congress protests fertilizer crisis in Assembly

► Symbolic demonstration with empty sacks & Nano bottles



Bhopal: On the fifth day of the Madhya Pradesh Assembly's monsoon session, Congress legislators staged a forceful protest in the Assembly premises over the worsening fertilizer crisis. Led by Leader of the Opposition Umang Singhar, the MLAs carried empty fertilizer

sacks and symbolic bottles of nano-fertilizer, accusing the government of turning its back on struggling farmers.

Farmers in crisis, government unmoved

Singhar lashed out at the ad-

ministration, saying, "While lakhs of farmers are waiting in long queues for fertilizer during the crucial monsoon season, the Chief Minister is preoccupied with foreign trips." He claimed the government is ignoring farmers' pain and experimenting with unproven solutions like nano-fertilizer, which only adds to their burden amid widespread shortage and counter-fert supply issues.

Demands from the Opposition

Congress demanded immediate availability of fertilizers in sufficient quantity, transparency in distribution, a detailed government response in the Assembly, and an investigation into the potential harmful effects of nano-fertilizers.

Warning of Escalation

Singhar declared that this symbolic protest was meant to bring farmers' anguish into the legislative spotlight. "If the government doesn't act swiftly to resolve this crisis, we will intensify the movement," he warned.

Another FIR of rape registered against Yasin Ahmed

► Girl accuses of drug smuggler sexual and physical abuse

Bhopal: Another FIR of rape has been registered against drug smuggler Yasin Ahmed alias Machhli. A young woman has accused him of raping her for a year on the pretext of marriage. The first rape incident was carried out in a five star hotel in MP Nagar.

It is alleged that Yasin used to beat the girl brutally. He had also made videos of the assault. On the basis of these videos, the police identified the girl and after counseling her, an FIR was registered in MP Nagar police station on Friday.

Earlier, FIRs of sexual harassment and fraud have also been registered against Yasin in Mahila Thana and Arera Hills police station.

The woman met Yasin in a pub

According to Sub Inspector Archana Tiwari, the 29-year-old woman does a private job. About a year ago, she met drug smuggler Yasin in a pub. After



talking to each other, they became friends. Both shared their mobile numbers with each other.

Later, the accused Yasin called the girl to meet him in a five star hotel, where he raped her on the pretext of marrying her. Since then, he was continuously exploiting the girl.

Just a while ago, Yasin had refused to marry the victim. Since then, he was trying to convince the victim to keep a distance from him. When the girl put pressure on him for marriage, the accused beat her up. He also made videos of her.


No heavy rain alert for Bhopal

Flood conditions persist in some parts

The Meteorological Department has issued a statement indicating that there will be no heavy rain alert in Bhopal for the next two days. This monsoon season, Madhya Pradesh has received 28 inches of rainfall, which accounts for 74 percent of the expected quota. The eastern regions, including Jabalpur, Rewa, Shahdol, and Sagar divisions, experienced particularly heavy rainfall, leading to flood conditions, but this intense rainfall has now subsided.

On Friday, light rain was reported in over 15 districts, including Bhopal, Betul, Datia, Guna, Gwalior, Narmadapuram, and others. However, there was no significant downpour in any area. The Meteorological Department forecasts a continuation of light rain across the state, including Bhopal, Indore, Ujjain, and Gwalior-Jabalpur, without any alerts for heavy rain.

Bhopal: Eight railway employees from the West Central Railway's Bhopal Division were awarded the prestigious 'Suraksha Puraskar' (Safety Award) for their exceptional vigilance and quick actions that prevented potential train accidents.

At a ceremony held at the Divisional Railway Manager's office, these employees were recognized for their alertness and dedication. Their timely intervention in critical situations ensured the safety of both passengers and railway property. Each awardee received a certificate of appreciation and a cash prize for their commendable service.

Divisional Railway Manager Deoashish Tripathi congratulated the awardees, emphasizing that the employees' vigilance and sense of duty are the backbone of the railway's safety system. Senior Divisional Safety Officer Vijay Shankar Gautam echoed this sentiment, stating that such dedica-



tion inspires the establishment of even better safety standards for the future.

MP on high alert as dams reach full capacity

► Continuously monitor all the dams and reservoirs of the state: Minister Silawat



Bhopal: With Madhya Pradesh receiving 59% more rainfall than its annual average, Water Resources Minister Tulsiram Silawat has ordered continuous monitoring of all dams and reservoirs across the state. Following a review meeting at the state-level flood control room, the minister directed officials to coordinate closely with district administrations and ensure all safety measures are in place to prevent any unforeseen disasters.

Flooding concerns amid heavy rains

The state has recorded 711.30 mm of rainfall so far this monsoon, a significant increase from the 480.40 mm recorded at the same

time last year. The heavy downpour has pushed the state's major dams to a staggering 72.75% of their capacity, a substantial jump from last year's 50.07%. With 18 dams already having opened their gates, Silawat has emphasized the critical need for effective communication, instructing officials to use traditional methods like public announcements to ensure residents in downstream areas are informed well in advance of water releases.

Major dam levels and gate operations

Among the dams with open gates are Bargi in Jabalpur, Indirasagar in Khandwa, Omkaresh-

war, and Rajghat in Ashoknagar. An alarming 104 out of 286 major dams are currently over 90% full, with another 31 between 75% and 90% capacity.

The minister underscored the importance of working with full alertness to prevent any loss of life or property. He highlighted that while the rain is a positive sign for the state, the high water levels require constant vigilance to manage flood situations, particularly in river basins like the Narmada and Ganga, which have seen a surge in water levels. The department is operating dam gates based on weather forecasts to ensure that flood situations remain under control.
