# ED to question Anil Ambani as his company denies loan amount diversion allegations

Anil Ambani has been summoned for questioning by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) to its headquarters in Delhi on Tuesday, August 5, in connection with an alleged loan fraud investigation, involving claims as high as Rs 17,000 crore, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) sources stated

The case pertains to alleged financial wrongdoing, including the misuse of more than Rs 10,000 crore in loans by different companies in the group. A major part of the probe under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), is focussed on a



Rs 3,000-crore loan granted by Yes Bank to the Anil Ambani-led Reliance ADA Group between 2017 and 2019, which the ED be-

lieves may have been mis-

Last week, the Enforcement Directorate (ED) raided 50 business entities linked to the Anil Ambaniled Reliance ADA Group and 25 persons under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA). The ED raided at least 35 locations in Mumbai on July 24 in connection with a money laundering case linked to the alleged bank loan fraud, besides several other allegations of finan-

other allegations of financial irregularities worth crores of rupees by some group companies.

However, the Anil Ambani-led Reliance ADA Group has rejected all allegations of diverting funds gations of diverting funds through inter-corporate deposits (ICDs) involving its group company Reliance Infrastructure (R-Infra) and a previously

undisclosed entity called CLE Pvt Ltd.

Yet, according to Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) allegations being probed by the ED, R-Infra allegedly moved approximately Rs 10,000 crore to group companies through CLE Pvt Ltd, without declaring it as a related company, through the guise of ICDs, equity investments and corporate guarantees.

These transactions were allegedly carried out between FY2013 and FY2023, with total exposure to CLE Pvt Ltd, reported to be Rs 8,302 crore by the SEBI, besides write-offs amounting Rs 10,110 crore during FY 2017–21.
