

Four dead in horrific road accident in Shivpuri

► Victims identified as musicians from Gujarat



Shivpuri: Four people were killed and several others injured in a horrific road accident in Shivpuri this morning. A travel car and a truck collided on the Kota-Jhansi Na-

tional Highway in the Surwaya police station area. The fatal crash occurred when a traveler mini-bus crossed the road divider on NH-46 and collided head-on with an oncoming truck. So far, four people have died in the tragic accident, while seven are seriously injured. The incident took place on Saturday morning. The victims were among a group of around 20 musicians from the Mehsana and Surendranagar districts of Gujarat. They were on their way back after performing at a Shivkatha event at the Kashi Vishwanath Temple. As the bus was passing through the Surwaya police station area, it reportedly lost control, veered over the median, and crashed into the truck. Four people died in the collision, and seven were injured.

CMYadav announces grand Krishna temple in Raisen

Raisen: Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav announced today that a magnificent temple dedicated to Lord Krishna will be constructed in Mahalpur Patha, a village in Raisen district. The announcement came during a ceremony where he laid the foundation stones for and inaugurated 90 development projects worth over Rs 136 crore.

Speaking at the event, Dr. Yadav highlighted Raisen's growing importance, stating it is set to become a key part of the Bhopal Metropolitan City. He promised that these projects would create jobs for youth and women, uplift the lives of the poor, and bring



honor to farmers. A unique ancient idol at the center of the project: The proposed temple will be built around a unique and ancient idol of Radha, Krishna, and Rukmini, which

is carved from a single piece of white stone. This stunning example of medieval sculpture is also accompanied by other idols of Shiva, Nandi, Ganesh, and Nataraja in the temple complex. The site's serene beauty is further enhanced by a surrounding dense forest and dozens of old step-wells. According to local elder Prem Narayan Rai, the idol has a storied history. He recounted a tale from the British era when an Englishman, fascinated by the statue, attempted to steal it but failed. The story of the idol's divine protection has been passed down through generations in the village.

Three children drown in tragic accident in Tikamgarh

Tikamgarh: A pall of grief has fallen over Jawaharlalpur village in Madhya Pradesh's Tikamgarh district after three children tragically drowned in a local pond. The devastating incident has left the community in shock, with the families of the victims inconsolable.

A fatal attempt to save a friend

According to authorities, the three minor boys had gone to the pond for a swim. One of them ventured into a deeper section of the water and began to drown. In a desperate attempt to rescue their friend, the other two children also went into the deep water and were



unable to save themselves. All three children drowned in the ensuing chaos. Alerted by cries for help, local residents rushed to the scene but were too late to save the boys. Upon receiving news of the tragedy, Khajri police and administrative officials arrived at the site. The bodies were recovered from the pond and sent for an autopsy. Police have registered a case and initiated an investigation. The entire village is in mourning, with the heartbreaking incident leaving a profound sense of loss.

Gautam Gambhir, Sonal Chauhan attend Mahakal Bhasm Aarti



Ujjain: Former Indian cricketer and head coach Gautam Gambhir, along with his family and actress-singer Sonal Chauhan, attended the sacred Bhasm Aarti at the Mahakal Temple in Ujjain today. Gambhir, accompanied by his wife Natasha and two daughters, participated in

the two-hour ceremony from the Nandi Hall. He later offered prayers and water to the idol of Nandi. Following the ritual, the temple committee honored the former Member of Parliament. Gambhir shared that this was his third visit to the temple, stating, "I pray that the blessings of Baba Mahakal remain with the country and all families." Sonal Chauhan, who was visiting the temple for the first time, expressed her profound spiritual experience. She said the divine atmosphere was unlike anything she had ever felt before. "The temple's management and the darshan system are excellent," she said. "I feel like I want to keep coming back here." Known for her work in Hindi and Telugu films, Chauhan gained prominence after winning the Miss World Tourism title in 2005.

Mother suspected of strangling daughters in Ujjain

Ujjain: A mentally unstable woman in Ujjain district is suspected of strangling her two young daughters to death. The tragic incident, which has sent shockwaves through the community, was discovered when the children's father returned home. According to Mahidpur police sources, the accused, identified as Pooja, the wife of Ashok Banjara, allegedly strangled her daughters, four-year-old Uma and eight-month-old Anishka, to death on Friday evening. The crime came to light when the father returned to find his children dead. Police were alerted by the village watchman and rushed to the scene to retrieve the bodies. Authorities believe Pooja, who was alone at home with the children at the time, suffers from a mental illness. The bodies have been sent for a post-mortem examination, and a full investigation is underway.

Major Air India accident narrowly averted

Gwalior: An Air India flight from Bengaluru was forced to make an emergency landing at Gwalior's Maharajpura Airport on Saturday after a sudden technical glitch

caused a terrifying ordeal for passengers. The aircraft experienced multiple jolts during its landing approach, prompting widespread panic on board.

Passengers allege poor service

According to passengers, the flight attempted to land but a sudden jolt forced the pilot to abort the maneuver. The pilot circled the airport and made a second successful attempt, but the incident left travelers shaken. Upon exiting the plane, angry passengers created an uproar, accusing the airline of providing sub-standard service and endangering their lives. They filed a formal complaint with the Airport Director, detailing the terrifying incident.

Investigation underway

This incident is the latest in a series of reported technical problems on Air India flights across the country. The airline has taken note of the complaint and has launched an investigation into the matter.

Police, with the help of local residents, recovered the bodies and transported them to a hospital. While formal identification is pending, the families of the deceased have been notified. The management of Reliance Insurance has expressed profound grief over the incident and has assured the victims' families of all possible support. A police investigation is underway, and a search is on for the truck driver, who fled the scene. The tragic loss has cast a shadow of sorrow over Indore and the hometowns of the victims.

Man protests poor roads at Gwalior Independence Day Event

Gwalior: Gwalior's main Independence Day celebration was briefly interrupted on Tuesday when a man staged a protest to highlight the city's dilapidated roads. The incident occurred moments after Minister Narayan Singh Kushwaha concluded his address at the SAF Ground. The protester, identified as Vijay Mahor, approached the stage with posters attached to his body, decrying the city's pothole-ridden streets. He voiced his frustration, claiming that despite months of neglect, the administration has failed to address the issue. Mahor stated that this was not his first protest; he had previously demonstrated at the Vidhan Sabha gates during a legislative session to draw attention to the same problem. Police personnel swiftly intervened, apprehending Mahor and escorting him away from the event to allow the program to continue without further disruption. Patriotic fervor and celebrations: Despite the brief

commotion, the day's main ceremony proceeded smoothly. Minister Kushwaha hoisted the national flag to commemorate the 79th anniversary of India's independence. He then read a message from Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav, highlighting the government's achievements and various welfare schemes in the district. The ceremony also featured a captivating parade by platoons from the Army, BSF, SAF, police, NCC, and Scout cadets. The incident took place at the Primary School in Kachhpura vil-

lage in the Ambah block. While schools across the district were celebrating with traditional special meals, this school allegedly served stale and foul-smelling sweets to its students.
