On the downside, the Egyptian toe belongs to peeps who are pretty private and have hidden depths. You have a habit to procrastinate, which could stop them from having the big things in life.


4. Roman Toe

6. Stretched Toe




This type of foot has the big toe (thumb) straying far away from other fingers. In a nutshell, there is a significant gap between the thumb and the fingers. Talking about personali-


