While the Rajinikanth starrer crime thriller could add Rs 12 crore to the tally, the spy action drama grossed only Rs 9 crore. Coolie and War 2 target wrap their theatrical runs under Rs 300 crore mark, if the trend continues to drop like this, Coolie and War 2 will end their entire theatrical run under Rs 300 crore gross in India. Looking at the current trends, War 2 is likely to bridge the gap and end up doing around Rs 275 crore by the end of the theatrical run.

Coolie, on the other hand, is expected to finish its box office journey in the vicinity of Rs 285 crore to Rs 300 crore, depending on how it performs in the coming days.
