Bhutan PM to visit Gaya, Ayodhya during India visit

New Delhi: Bhutanese Prime Minister Tshering Tobgay and his wife Tashi Doma will be on a visit to India from September 3-6, during which they will visit Gaya and Ayodhya, before coming to Delhi. They will arrive in New Delhi on Friday evening, when External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar will call on them. They depart for home on Saturday. In Bihar, the Bhutanese PM will visit Rajgir, Nalanda on September 3-4. The Bhutanese PM and the Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar are to inaugurate the Royal Bhutanese Monastery in Rajgir on September 4, commemorating the Golden Jubilee of bilateral relations.

IGP Kashmir reviews security for Eid Milad-un-Nabi

Srinagar: Inspector General of Police (IGP) Kashmir, V.K. Birdi, today chaired a high-level security review meeting here to finalise foolproof arrangements for the upcoming Eid Milad-un-Nabi celebrations, with a special focus on major shrines, mosques, and other religious places expecting large congregations. A police spokesman said the meeting was attended by all range DIsG and SSSP of Kashmir Zone. The discussions focused on facilitating smooth and secure congregations and processions across the Kashmir Valley to mark the auspicious occasion.

Rs one lakh bounty announced on arrest of SP's district president

Pratapgarh (UP): The police have increased the reward amount for the arrest of Samajwadi Party (SP) district president Gulshan Yadav from Rs 50,000 to Rs one lakh in Pratapgarh district here in Uttar Pradesh, police sources said here today. Police sources said that 53 cases are registered against Gulshan Yadav in various police stations of Pratapgarh district, which include attempt to murder, robbery, extortion and Gangster Act. "He has been absconding for almost a year and police have confiscated his property worth more than Rs 7 crore. His hooliganism has spread terror in the area," they said.

We are not aligned with NNPGs: NSCN-K (Niki)

Dimapur: The NSCN-K (Niki) today clarified that the NSCN/GPRN has not aligned with the Naga National Political Groups (NNPGs) or their 'Agreed Position'. The outfit, in a release, said the clarification was necessitated in the wake of certain elements spreading 'false rumours'. "Without our knowledge, the NNPGs issued a statement about Gen Niki Sumi (ret'd), which should not be misconstrued in any way as being on the same page when it comes to our political stance," the release said.


Earthquake of magnitude 3.5 strikes Assam's Sonitpur

Sonitpur (Assam): An earthquake measuring 3.5 on the Richter scale jolted Sonitpur, Assam, on Tuesday, at 17:33:29 IST, according to the National Center for Seismology (NCS). The quake occurred at a depth of 15 km, with its epicentre located at latitude 26.69 N and longitude 92.92 E. In X post, the NCS stated, "EQ of M: 3.5, On: 02/09/2025 17:33:29 IST, Lat: 26.69 N, Long: 92.92 E, Depth: 15 Km, Location: Sonitpur, Assam." No reports of injury or damage to property have been received so far.

PM slams Cong-RJD alliance

For derogatory remarks against his mother at Bihar rally

New Delhi/Patna (UNI) Prime Minister Narendra Modi today came down heavily on the Congress-RJD alliance in Bihar, condemning the use of derogatory language against his late mother during their political rally recently in the poll-bound State. Addressing a programme of Bihar State Jeevika Nidhi Credit Cooperative Society through video conferencing, Modi got emotional while speaking and said the abusive words used against his mother reflect the mentality of Congress and RJD. He accused them of nurturing the feeling of hatred against women. He minced no words as he said the remarks against his mother were not merely a personal affront but an insult to every mother and sister in the country and that he was deeply hurt by the demeaning remark. Modi further said "the Indian land



never tolerates humiliation of a mother and the Congress RJD should apologize to the women of the country and especially the "Chhathi Maiya" (the famous deity of the internationally known Chhath festival of Bihar) and the "Saptabahini" (so-

cial offerings to exhibit respect to the Seven Sisters- the rivers of the Eastern region)."

"Mother is our entire world, mother is our pride. In this culturally rich land of Bihar, what happened a few days ago, I could never have imagined it. From the stage of RJD and Congress, my mother was abused. These abuses are not just an insult to my mother.

They are an insult to the mothers, sisters, and daughters of this country, said the Prime Minister.

"I know...how bad all of you, every mother, sister of Bihar, felt after seeing and hearing this! I know, as much pain as I have in my heart, the people of Bihar are also in the same pain," Modi added.

He said his mother was no more and had never been involved in politics and added that she had separated herself from him so that he could serve crores of mothers.

Suvendu suspended from assembly for rest of session

Kolkata (UNI) Speaker Biman Banerjee today suspended Leader of the Opposition Suvendu Adhikari from the West Bengal Assembly for the rest of the session for disrupting proceedings of the House.



Speaking to reporters outside the Assembly, Adhikari said, "The Army is our pride, but the education minister Bratya Basu accused them of being politicised and even compared their actions to the coup in Bangladesh. We will not tolerate this. I am ready to face suspension again over this issue."

The uproar began when BJP legislators, led by Adhikari, protested remarks made by state Education Minister Bratya Basu against the Army. Despite repeated warnings from the Speaker to maintain order, the BJP members insisted on withdrawal of the statement. As the ruckus continued, Adhikari was suspended, prompting BJP legislators to walk out of the House in protest.

The controversy erupted at Esplanade yesterday, where a stage erected by the Trinamool Congress (TMC) near the Gandhi statue was dismantled by the Army. The TMC had set up the stage to protest alleged humiliation of the Bengali language and harassment of Bengali-speaking migrant workers.

Agra police busts illegal conversion racket, eight arrested

Agra: Eight persons including the main accused were arrested today by the Shahganj police which busted an illegal conversion racket in Agra district here in Uttar Pradesh, a senior police officer said here.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (City) Sonam Kumar said that the game of converting people from Hinduism to Christianity was going on in Shahganj. "The main accused Rajkumar Lalwani had returned from Mumbai and was engaged in illegal conversion. He used to ask people to convert by citing divine powers. Police have arrested eight people including Rajkumar Lalwani and three women," he said.

He said that Lalwani had gone to Mumbai four years ago and converted to Christianity there. "After returning from Mumbai, he started adopting tricks to convert people in Sindhi Colony from Hinduism to Christianity. He used to lure people to get their spoiled work done by praying," he said.

Rahul Gandhi's hydrogen bomb will explode soon with blessings of Baba Vishwanath: Ajay Rai

Varanasi (UNI) Uttar Pradesh unit president of Congress Ajay Rai today said that the issue of "vote theft" has become a topic of discussion in the whole country and this time Rahul Gandhi's hydrogen bomb will explode with the blessings and will of Baba Vishwanath.

While talking to journalists at the camp office in Lahurabir, Rai gave the example of Varanasi and said that the Election Commission had stopped giving updates here after 1 pm.

Targeting the then Divisional Commissioner Kaushal Raj Sharma, he said that he was called to Delhi and made the CEO of the Water Commission because he had worked for Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

EoW books two for posing as union Ministers' relatives to dupe people

Srinagar: The Economic Offences Wing (EOW) of Crime Branch Kashmir today registered a case against two individuals for allegedly impersonating relatives of senior union ministers and duping people on the pretext of arranging government contracts. Officials identified the accused as Kumail Ansari and Yetsen Kumar, against whom a joint complaint alleging cheating and criminal conspiracy was filed.

According to officials, the duo lured unsuspecting victims by promising lucrative contracts in NHPC and the Defence sector, projecting themselves as close relatives of top union ministers to gain trust and extract money.

In a statement, EoW said as per the complainant, the accused falsely posed as influential individuals capable of securing contracts in NHPC and the Defence sector.



Manoj Jarange declares victory after Govt concedes demands

Mumbai (UNI) The Maratha reservation movement spearheaded by Manoj Jarange-Patil has finally attained victory. The state government has accepted six out of his eight key demands. Sub-committee chairman Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil met Jarange and recited the draft proposal.

Following this, Jarange announced, "We have won", while insisting that the government issue the official order (Government Resolution) within the next hour.

He further declared that the agitation would be called off only after the GR is released. Jarange also appealed to protesters to vacate Mumbai by 9 pm tonight. The state government has announced that the Sataras Sansthan Gazette, which covers the entire western Maharashtra region, will be examined from a legal perspective and executed promptly. Authorities assured that a decision on implementation will be made within the next 15 days.

On the issue of criminal cases registered during the Maratha reservation movement, the government clarified that several cases have already been withdrawn, while the remaining will be retracted through the court process. A government resolution (GR) has been issued to ensure that all such cases are retracted by the end of September.

Regarding the demands for aid to

the families of those who sacrificed their lives during the Maratha quota protests, the government said Rs15 crore in financial assistance has already been disbursed. The remaining families will receive aid within a week. In addition, heirs will be offered government jobs, initially in state transport services.

However, protest leaders have demanded that employment should be based on the educational qualifications of the beneficiaries, preferably in MIDC or other sectors.

The government also highlighted that around 58 lakh old records related to Kunbi-Maratha caste validation have been traced. These records will be linked to respective Gram Panchayats, and pending validity certificates will be cleared.

Minister Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil informed that district-level meetings will now be held every Monday to resolve caste certificate issues.

Earlier, the caste scrutiny committees lacked manpower, but additional staff has now been appointed to expedite the process.

Protest leader Manoj Jarange demanded that the Shinde committee be provided with a permanent office, that the genealogy verification committee be given an extension, and that officials be authorized to retrieve records, including those in Modi script, to ensure justice for the Maratha community.

Kerala CM to inaugurate Onam Week celebrations today

Thiruvananthapuram: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan will inaugurate the state-level Onam Week Celebrations at the Nishagandhi Open Air Auditorium in Kanakakkunnu Palace here on September 3.

Tourism and Public Works Minister P A Mohamed Riyas will preside over the opening ceremony, while General Education and Labour Minister V Sivankutty will deliver the welcome address.

Food and Civil Supplies Minister G R Anil and Leader of Opposition V D Satheshan will attend the function as Chief Guests. Popular film personalities Ravi Mohan (Jayam Ravi) and Basil Joseph will be present as Guests of Honour.

The inaugural ceremony will be followed by a cultural performance by Kerala Kalamandalam and a music and dance presentation, Chingilavu, the organisers said.

Punjab cops smash Jaish-e-Mohammad terror cell

Chandigarh (UNI)

In a significant breakthrough in the fight against terrorism, SAS Nagar Police have dismantled a Jaish-e-Mohammad (JeM) terror module, arresting three Jammu and Kashmir based individuals linked to the abduction and murder of a cab driver Anil Kumar, Punjab Director General of Police (DGP) Gaurav Yadav said today.

The arrested individuals are Sahil Bashir, 19, from Handwara Langate, Kupwara; Munish Singh, alias Ansh, 22, from Kotli, Doda; and Aijaz Ahmed Khan, alias Wasim, 22, from Manjura, Kalamabad. Police recovered a .32 bore country-made pistol and the stolen white Maruti Swift Dzire (PB01-D-6299) used in the crime.

The case began with a complaint

from Anil Kumar's wife, Sudha Devi, who reported that her husband, a taxi driver, left home on August 31, 2025, at 8:30 am for a ride from Kharar to Chandigarh railway station but became unreachable thereafter.

DGP Yadav said that initial investigations revealed three unidentified individuals had hired Anil Kumar's cab, forcibly taken his vehicle, and killed him.

Acting swiftly, police teams apprehended the suspects in Batala and Gurdaspur. Sahil Bashir is a wanted individual in a UAPA and Arms Act case in Qalamabad, Handwara, J&K, while his brother Aijaz Ahmad, previously arrested with JeM-linked weapons, and both are identified as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) of JeM.

"Corruption is going on like business"

Senior Congress leader Digvijaya Singh on Tuesday criticised the Janata Dal United (JDU) and Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in Bihar, alleging that corruption is flourishing like a business wherever there is a double-engine government.

The Congress leader also stated that the BJP and JDU have become "partners in corruption in Bihar."

Speaking to the mediapersons in Patna, Singh said, "Wherever there is a double-engine government, corruption is going on like a business. The leaders of the ruling party are in-

MP Rahul Gandhi's "hydrogen bomb" remark, which he claimed would expose the BJP, the senior Congress leader said, "Wait for the hydrogen bomb."

On Monday, Congress MP and Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, warned the BJP of an impending expose, stating that he will soon unleash a "hydrogen bomb" about his allegations of vote theft, adding that what was shown about Mahadevpura was just an "atom bomb."

SFI to send 1 lakh female students' letters to Sonia Gandhi

Agencies, Thiruvananthapuram Students' Federation of India, the student wing of the Communist Party of India (Marxist), has announced a "mass mail campaign" against Palakkad MLA Rahul Mamkootathil, who has been accused of harassing multiple women, and in one case, forcing a woman to have an abortion against her will.

The campaign aims to send one lakh letters written by female students to Congress leader Sonia Gandhi, demanding the resignation of Rahul Mamkootathil.

He resigned from the post of Youth Congress State President after the allegations came to light, but he and his party resisted the demand

for his resignation from the MLA post. The Congress argued that there are other MLAs from the ruling alliance who face similar allegations

but have not resigned.

Earlier, the Kerala Crime Branch had registered a case against Mamkootathil for allegedly stalking and harassing women against their will through social media, causing mental agony to the women.

The case has been registered under the BNS sections of 78(2) and 351 and the Kerala Police Act 120(0), the officials added. The Crime Branch has registered a case on the instructions of the State Police Chief after examining the complaints received by the State Police Chief in this regard, and it was found that they were cognizable offences.
