

# Hundreds of workers from Gwalior join Congress

Bhopal: A major political shift was witnessed in Madhya Pradesh on Saturday when hundreds of workers from the Gwalior region abandoned the BJP and BSP to join the Congress. The historic development took place at the Pradesh Congress office in Bhopal in the presence of State Congress President Jitu Patwari, where all new entrants formally took membership.

The group, led by senior Gwalior leader Saheb Singh Gurjar, accused the BJP and BSP of betraying the people. They alleged that farmers, youth and the poor had been consistently neglected, while promises were repeatedly broken. # "Har Ghar Jal" plays a major role in improving child health: Prof. Kreamer

## ► CS discusses strategies to make department initiatives more effective



Bhopal: Chief Secretary Anurag Jain on Friday held extensive discussions with Nobel Laureate Prof. Michael Robert Kreamer and senior officials from various departments at the Mantralaya. The meeting focused on enhancing the effectiveness of development initiatives through evidence-based strategies in key sectors such as health, agriculture, education, and water management.

Prof. Kreamer, an American development economist and recipient of the 2019 Nobel Prize in Economics (along with Abhijit Banerjee and Es-

ther Duflo), shared key insights from his research on poverty alleviation. He highlighted that access to safe drinking water can reduce infant mortality by nearly 20 percent.

Citing survey data, he noted that one in four child deaths could be prevented by ensuring clean water supply. In this context, he praised the role of initiatives like the Har Ghar Jal program and emphasized the critical importance of the Jal Jeevan Mission in improving child health and rural livelihoods.

Need for collaboration among re-

searchers, govt institutions: Introducing new experimental methodologies, Prof. Kreamer underscored the need for collaboration among researchers, government institutions, private firms, and non-profit organizations to design and test scalable solutions. He stressed that rigorous evaluation is essential before expanding programs to a wider population. Responding to questions from officials, he also shared insights on challenges related to health, agriculture, education, and climate change, offering valuable suggestions for state-level policy planning.

Ankur Garg, Country Director of Evidence Action, presented the organization's work in India, explaining how proven research is converted into impactful, large-scale programs. He detailed the organization's ongoing support to the state government, particularly in water and health initiatives.

## Moving truck loaded with chemicals catches fire

### Major accident averted

Bhopal: A major accident was narrowly avoided in Bhopal during Ganesh Chaturdashi when a moving truck suddenly caught fire on Bairasnia Road. The truck, loaded with chemicals and paint, produced flames that reached heights of 10 to 15 feet. The driver managed to escape to safety.

The incident occurred on Saturday at 3:30 PM. Upon receiving the alert, the fire brigade quickly arrived at the scene to control the blaze. Nearby, another truck loaded with gas cylinders was having a tire puncture fixed. Firefighters promptly moved this truck to prevent any potential explosions from the gas cylinders. Once that was done, they began extinguishing the fire.

### Fire controlled within about an hour

Firefighter Pankaj Yadav reported that the fire was fully under control within about an hour. He noted that the truck carrying the cylinders was on a jack for tire repairs, but due to the fire risk, it was removed from the jack to ensure safety. The truck was being driven by Raju Kushwah and Mithun Saini, who jumped from the vehicle as soon as they realized it was on fire. Rural SP Pramod Kumar Sinha and TI Ashish Sapre also arrived at the scene to oversee the situation.
