

# MP Launches 'Enforcement Cell' to End Drug Adulteration

## Post-Tragedy Crackdown

**Bhopal:** The devastating loss of 25 children in Chhindwara due to poisonous cough syrup has spurred the Madhya Pradesh government into a massive overhaul of its drug monitoring system.



Deputy Chief Minister Dr. Rajendra Shukla held an emergency meeting, declaring a zero-tolerance policy: "Accountability will now be fixed for every pill and every syrup." No medicine will reach the

market or hospitals without mandatory testing. **Field-Level Quality Control**


The state will establish a specialized Enforcement and Legal Cell to ensure rapid action—from drug seizure to license revocation—against defaulters. A key reform is decentralizing testing; local Drug Monitoring Units will be created in every district to test samples on-site and instantly report to state headquarters.

To speed up quality checks, Drug Inspectors will be equipped with handheld testing devices for immediate verification of syrup and tablet quality, allowing for instant detection of chemical discrepancies or adulteration.

Furthermore, state labs in Bhopal, Indore, Gwalior, and Jabalpur are being upgraded with advanced testing units (HPLC, GCMSM). Dr. Shukla emphasized that the new protocol will ensure every batch and sample has accountability, ensuring that no child's life is lost again due to fatal counterfeit medicine.

# Mahamandaleshwar Atmanand Issues Stark Warning on 'Love Jihad'

**Mandla:** Mahamandaleshwar Atmanand Giri Maharaj has issued a fiery call for social vigilance against what he terms the "scourge of Love Jihad," asserting it is destroying the lives of Indian daughters. During a brief stopover in Niwas, the spiritual leader delivered a scathing statement regarding a particular community, claiming that a society that does not regard its own kinswomen as sisters cannot possibly view an 'outsider's' daughter as one.



"A conspiracy like 'Love Jihad' is actively ruining the lives of our nation's daughters," Maharaj Giri stated, urging society to be "alert

and cautious."

Addressing the press, he stressed the urgent need for par-

ents to be more conscious of their daughters' safety, as an insidious network of "deception and trickery" is working to weaken their faith and cultural values. He likened the perpetrators to deceitful figures, warning that they "say one thing and do another."

Maharaj Giri, currently speaking at the grand Shri Ram Katha festival in Majhgao, emphasized that the strength of society lies in the religious awareness of its women. He concluded with a powerful message for societal change: "As long as mothers and daughters remain vigilant in their faith, no force can mislead them."

# Minister Tomar Directs MP Transco to Ensure Timely, Quality Work

## Powering 'Simhastha 2028'

**Jabalpur:** Madhya Pradesh Energy Minister Pradyuman Singh Tomar has underscored the critical importance of Simhastha 2028, calling it a top priority for the state government. Chairing a review of Madhya Pradesh Power Transmission Company (MP Transco) projects, the Minister directed officials to maintain strict, regular oversight and complete all Simhastha-related works within the stipulated timeframe and with high quality.



Managing Director Sunil Tiwari briefed the Minister on the progress of MP Transco's efforts to ensure uninterrupted power supply in Ujjain for the major event.

The review focused on the first phase of construction, specifically the new 132 kV substations at Chintaman and Triveni Vihar. Further efforts include significant capacity upgrades: the 220 kV substation at Shankarpura is being boosted from 20 MVA to 50 MVA, and a new 50 MVA transformer is being installed at the 400 kV Tajpur substation.

Minister Tomar stressed that these projects must be executed with urgency to guarantee a seamless Simhastha experience.

# Grand Route March Ignites Patriotism for RSS Centenary

**Bhopal:** Marking a momentous century of service, the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) hosted a grand Path Sanchalan (route march) in Shivaji Basti, Mahavir Nagar, on the auspicious day of Vijaydashami. # Include Public Representatives in PKCC Project Work: Minister Silawat

## Reviews Kumbhraj Project



**Bhopal:** Water Resources Minister Tulsiram Silawat has stressed that government officials must work in confidence with public representatives on all development projects, ensuring they are informed and their suggestions are imple-

mented. The Minister made the remarks while reviewing the Kumbhraj Project, a component of the ambitious Parvati-Kalisindh-Chambal (PKCC) River Linking Project, calling it a significant gift from Prime

Minister Narendra Modi. He noted that the project realizes the river-linking vision of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee under the leadership of Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav.

With the Centre contributing 90% of the funds, the modified PKCC Link Project will provide irrigation to 6.11 lakh hectares and drinking water to 40 lakh people in Madhya Pradesh.

The Kumbhraj Project is the largest component, set to benefit farmers in the Chachaura constituency of Guna district the most. Minister Silawat directed officials to select technically sound construction sites and complete land acquisition and rehabilitation for affected families strictly according to rules and timelines. Responding to requests from legislators, he assured that he would discuss a special package for displaced families with the Chief Minister.

# Twelve Suspected Bangladeshi Nationals Vanish Before Police Raid

**Gwalior/Morena:** A dramatic disappearance has put authorities on high alert after 12 suspected Bangladeshi nationals vanished from the Bheelpur village on the Gwalior-Morena border, where they had been living under police surveillance.

These individuals, who earned a living by scavenging and doing odd jobs near the Rairu Distillery, were staying in a makeshift hut in a dilapidated building. Their disappearance, along with their alleged facilitator, Abrar Khan, occurred one to two months ago—just before the police could act on the verification of their suspicious documents.

The group was identified outside the "Operation Sindoor" security sweep, but their questionable documents triggered a separate investigation. An internal police survey suggests the suspects fled when they sensed a pending crackdown. The last known digital footprints of the fugitives trace to locations in Chennai and Kolkata (West Bengal), a strong indication of their intended escape route. This incident follows a recent arrest of eight other Bangladeshi nationals near the Maharajpura Air Force Station, underscoring a persistent security challenge involving illegal settlements in the region. The police are currently scrambling to track the individuals, whose contact numbers are now switched off.
