

“BJP proves ‘Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas’ through concrete developmental work

● MP CM Yadav Campaigns for NDA in Bihar
● Highlights Transformative Development

Patna/Bhopal: Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav, addressing rallies in Bihar on Thursday, launched a strong campaign for the NDA candidates, emphasizing that the BJP's slogan of “Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas” (Support of all, Development for all) is demonstrated through action, not just words. Dr. Yadav accompanied NDA candidates Sanjay Gupta (Kumhrar) and Siddharth Saurabh (Vikram) as they filed their nominations, before speaking at public meetings in Kadmkuan and at Parvati Vidyalaya ground.



global climate, CM Yadav stressed that an NDA government is essential to propel India forward with respect on the world stage. He asserted confidence that Bihar is poised to re-elect the NDA under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister Nitish Kumar to continue the state's development story. Dr. Yadav urged voters to commit to securing a record victory for the alliance in the upcoming Assembly elections.

Slamming ‘Jungle Raj’ and Lack of Will

Dr. Yadav harshly criticized the state's past, recalling the “jungle raj” before 2004-2005 when dacoits and misgovernance—for which he held the Congress party accountable—plagued Bihar. He said the “License, Quota, Permit” era ruined the state, which was later handed over to the ‘Lantern’ (BJD symbol), centralizing power in one

family and stalling progress. However, he lauded the current leadership, noting that PM Modi has allocated over ₹13 lakh crore for Bihar's development. Dr. Yadav stated that while Biharis possess immense talent (producing the most IAS/IPS officers), the previous lack was in “right leadership and intent,” a gap that the NDA government has now bridged.

The ‘Sudarshan Chakra’ of the Vote

The Chief Minister concluded with a powerful call to action, urging voters to remain vigilant against political opponents who may resort to “cunning tricks.” He compared ignoring opponents' negative remarks to Lord Krishna ignoring Shishupala's insults. Dr. Yadav stated that on polling day, the opponents’ “one hundred insults” will be complete, and voters will hold the ‘Sudarshan Chakra’ of their vote. He told the crowds that pressing the button for the NDA candidate would activate that powerful ‘Chakra’ and ensure the coalition's victory march continues.

EOW Raids Victoria Hospital over Multi-Crore Financial Scam

Jabalpur: The Economic Offenses Wing (EOW) of Jabalpur conducted a high-stakes raid on Victoria District Hospital on Thursday afternoon, seizing a massive cache of documents related to a suspected multi-crore financial scam. The search, which began at 1:30 PM, lasted for three hours in the Civil Surgeon's office.

● Decade of Fraudulent Documents Seized from Civil Surgeon's Office

Sources indicate the EOW had received at least two confidential complaints dating back to 2019 and 2022, pointing fingers at account branch staff.

The EOW acted after hospital management repeatedly failed to produce the requested documents despite multiple official letters. The team meticulously searched the record room, seizing crucial files, bills, and vouchers to finally advance the investigation. The detailed examination of the seized material is now underway to determine the extent of the corruption.

Focus on Decade-Long Irregularities

The raid targets complaints of massive fraud spanning from 2009 to 2020. The allegations include widespread manipulation of bills, overpayments, and the use of bogus tender processes for medicine procurement, equipment maintenance, and construction work.

MP Tops National Mining Readiness Index for Reforms

CM Yadav's Policies Drive State to First Place

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh has reasserted its leadership in the mining sector, securing the first position nationally in the State Mining Readiness Index (SMRI) and State Ranking released by the Union Ministry of Mines on Thursday. This achievement is credited to Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav's visionary leadership and the state's focus on modernization, sustained development and responsible mining practices. Madhya Pradesh's dominance is evident in mineral auctions. The state was previously honored by the central government for holding the highest number of mineral block auctions in the country. More recently, MP became the first state to implement the Central Government's policy for auctioning Critical Minerals.

Congress Demands Withdrawal of FIR against PCC Chief Patwari

Party Leaders Allege Malice after Wheat Sack Protest at Union Minister's Home

Bhopal: Congress leaders registered a strong protest with the Police Commissioner on Thursday, demanding the immediate cancellation of the FIR filed against State Congress President Jitu Patwari. Party leaders condemned the action, alleging the registration of the case was politically motivated.

Protest Led to Police Scuffle

The controversy stems from an incident on Wednesday, when Patwari, accompanied by several farmers carrying sacks of wheat, arrived at the 74 Bungalows residence of a Union Agriculture Minister (and former Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan) to raise farm issues. Security personnel

Ex-Excise Officer's Rs 1.26 Cr found in Bank, 4 Lockers Sealed

● Lokayukta Probe Reveals Rs 20-Crore Disproportionate Assets



Indore: The layers of wealth accumulated by retired Excise Officer Dharmendra Bhadauriya continue to peel back following the Lokayukta raid on Wednesday. The ongoing investigation has revealed that Bhadauriya and his family hold over Rs 1.26 crore in bank deposits, along with four sealed lockers and 21 insurance policies. All bank accounts and lockers have been frozen by the investigating team.

1,26,31,013. Additionally, 21 insurance and investment policies, with premiums paid totaling ₹13.90 lakh, were discovered. The freeze includes four bank lockers found under the family's name, which will be opened only in the accused's presence.



The probe also found that Bhadauriya's son, Suryansh, invested Rs 25 lakh for a 40% partnership stake in a restaurant franchise, ‘Shiva Chinese Wok.’ The Lokayukta's preliminary calculation now estimates the total value of all movable and immovable assets linked to the family to be over Rs 20.24 crore, significantly disproportionate to his known income. A detailed forensic investigation of all seized documents is underway.

Inquiry Team Rushed to Gwalior After Worms Found in Children's Syrup

● Antibiotic Distribution Halted Amid Quality Scare

Gwalior: A major scare has hit the health department after black, worm-like elements were allegedly discovered in an antibiotic syrup meant for children. Following the complaint, the government immediately dispatched a high-level investigation team from Bhopal to Gwalior, confirmed CMHO Sachin Shrivastava. The team has already arrived to begin its probe.



the prescribed Azithromycin Oral Suspension syrup to give it to her child and was horrified to find foreign particles inside. She immediately alerted Civil Surgeon Dr. R.K. Sharma. This incident follows a

previous quality scare involving cold drinks, causing widespread panic.

Distribution Stopped, Samples Sent

Responding swiftly, the Drug Department, led by Drug Inspector Anubhuti Sharma, halted the distribution of the Azithromycin syrup and recalled the batch from all centres. Samples have been collected and sent for testing. Preliminary information suggests the syrup was supplied from a government store in Bhopal. Authorities are now tracing the specific batch number to alert other Madhya Pradesh districts and prevent further distribution. If the samples fail quality tests, strict legal action will be initiated.

Big Setback for MP Govt: High Court Bars New Promotion Process

Jabalpur: The Madhya Pradesh government faced a significant refusal from the High Court today regarding its new rules on reservation in promotions. A division bench of Chief Justice Sanjeev Sachdeva and Justice Vinay Saraf declined the government's plea to immediately proceed with Departmental Promotion Committees (DPCs) and grant promotions.

notification stating that promotions until 2016 would follow the 2002 rules, while subsequent promotions would use the new Madhya Pradesh Public Services (Promotion) Rules, 2025.

The High Court firmly rejected the request to start the process but permitted the government to collect the necessary quantifiable data under the 2025 rules and submit it to the court in a sealed cover. The court noted that the new 2025 rules are currently being challenged, as petitioners argue they are virtually identical to the 2002 rules already quashed by the High Court.

ED and IT Intensify Clampdown on Dilip Buildcon

Conduct raids in Gwalior following action in Bhopal

Gwalior: The net tightened around prominent construction firm Dilip Buildcon (DBL) as the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and Income Tax (IT) Department expanded their sensational crackdown. Following Monday's initial raids in Bhopal, the joint operation extended its reach to a residential property linked to the company in Gwalior's Deendayal Nagar.

The intensified action is reportedly linked to serious allegations of tax evasion, the possession of dis-



proportionate assets, and various financial irregularities.

Former BJP Leader, Ex-Waqf Chief on the Run

● Police announced Rs 10,000 reward

Ujjain: The hunt has intensified for absconding BJP leader and former Madhya Pradesh Waqf Board Chairman, Shaukat Mohammad Khan, who is now facing a warrant and Rs 10,000 reward for his capture.

Ujjain police are hot on the heels of Khan, who is wanted in several serious cases, including allegedly running a parallel Waqf Board and filing forged documents in court, leading to charges under IPC Section 420, among others.

In a dramatic twist, sources suggest the former politician has fled the country and is reportedly hiding in Muscat, the capital of Oman.

Ujjain Superintendent of Police Pradeep Sharma has announced Rs 10,000 cash reward for any information leading to Khan's arrest, assuring that the informant's identity will remain strictly confidential.



This high-profile case has put the spotlight back on alleged irregularities, blackmailing, and the use of fraudulent documents within Waqf committees. Special police teams are actively conducting raids to ensure the swift arrest of the prominent fugitive.

Deputy CM Shukla Demands 24/7 Doctor Presence at Sagar Hospital

Directs Strict Compliance on Emergency Duties and Cleanliness

Bhopal: Deputy Chief Minister and Sagar District In-charge Minister, Rajendra Shukla, conducted a thorough review of health services at the Sagar District Hospital today. Expressing concern over adherence to schedules, he issued a clear directive: all doctors must strictly follow their assigned timings and maintain diligence in patient care, warning against any negligence in treatment.



Mandatory Emergency Room Coverage

Shukla specifically instructed the hospital administration to ensure the

continuous presence of doctors and paramedical staff in the Emergency Room according to their duty rosters. He also focused on improving maternal health, demanding timely checkups for high-risk pregnant mothers. Expert female specialists must conduct comprehensive examinations during the dedicated health camps held every 9th and 25th of the month.

Focus on Cleanliness and Drug Stock

The Deputy CM emphasized the critical need for cleanliness, sanitation, and sufficient stock of essential medicines across the hospital. He reassured staff that the government will expedite the recruitment process to fill vacancies for doctors and para-

medical personnel. Furthermore, he commended the Telemedicine system for extending specialized advice to remote and rural areas, enhancing both the speed and transparency of treatment.

Prioritizing Mother and Child Welfare

Shukla concluded by stressing the government's commitment to reducing maternal and infant mortality rates. He mandated targeted action at Nutritional Rehabilitation Centers (NRCs) to combat malnutrition among children. The inspection was attended by local MIA Shailendra Jain, Zila Panchayat President Hira Singh Rajput, and BMC Dean Dr. P.S. Thakur, among other officials and public representatives.

Police Officer Accused of Suppressing Kidnapping Case in Raisen

Family Alleges Rs 3 Lakh Taken to Free Suspect in Minor's Disappearance

Raisen: A serious case of alleged corruption and police negligence has emerged in Raisen, where the family of a kidnapped minor girl accuses Jaithari Police Post In-charge Arvind Pandey of accepting a Rs 3 lakh bribe to bury the case.

The minor, who went missing a year ago, was recently recovered from Indore. Her father has now filed applications with the Chief Minister, DGP, Collector, and SP Raisen, demanding action against the officer.
