

MP Government Tightens Fiscal Screws

- Bans New Spending and Vehicle Purchases
Strict Financial Discipline Prevails as Zero-Base Budgeting Restricts Spending

Bhopal: The Madhya Pradesh government is moving swiftly to enforce strict financial discipline, signaling an end to the tradition of unrestrained, late-year luxury spending.

Under a stern directive from the Finance Department, all government departments are now prohibited from submitting proposals for new expenditure heads ("Naye Mad") or requests for the purchase of new official vehicles.



No Relief in Second Supplementary Budget

The Finance Department has begun preparations for the second supplementary budget, set to be presented during the Assembly's winter session.

The department highlighted that the annual budget for 2025-26 was formulated using a Zero-Base Budgeting system. A subsequent review concluded that most pre-existing liabilities have already been reduced and provisioned for.

Limited Scope for New Proposals

Only proposals meeting specific, critical conditions will be considered. These include:

- Proposals related to advances sanctioned from the Contingency Fund.
Expenditures previously approved by the Finance Department or those receiving Central Government/Agency financial assistance that cannot be met from existing budget lines.
Requests to create new budget lines under the Special Capital Assistance Scheme for proposals already submitted to or approved by the Government of India.

Man Dies by Suicide in Bhopal Home

Bhopal: A 50-year-old man, identified as Bhagwat Kushwaha, tragically died by suicide by hanging himself at his home in Khajuri Kala on Tuesday evening. Police have registered a case and initiated an investigation.

Former CM Announces Major Return and Cow Conservation Campaign

Bhopal: Former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Uma Bharti has made a definitive political declaration, announcing her intention to contest the 2029 Lok Sabha elections from the Jhansi constituency. "I will only contest from Jhansi," she stated at a press conference, adding that her primary interest lies in national-level politics.



She announced the launch of a massive Cow Conservation Campaign (Gau Samvardhan Abhiyan) on Gopashtami, October 29, which will run for a year and a half. The campaign aims to create new grazing lands (gochar), involve Gram Panchayats, and link farmers to the movement.
