Bhopal: After a delay of three months and twenty-one days, BJP State President Hemant Khandelwal has finally announced the new Madhya Pradesh State Executive. The new team comprises four General Secretaries (Mahamantri), nine Vice Presidents (Upadhyaksh), and nine Secretaries (Mantri).

Key Appointments and Promotions

Sumer Singh Solanki, Rahul Kothari, Lata Wankhede, and Gaurav Ranadive have been appointed as the new State General Secretaries. Notably, the positions of General Secretary, Vice President, and Secretary saw major promotions. Lata Wankhede and Rahul Kothari have been elevated from the post of Secretary to General Secretary, signifying an increase in their stature within the party. Similarly, Manishi Singh has been promoted directly from Secretary to Vice President, and for-

In a display of continued trust, Ashish Agarwal has been retained as the State Media In-charge, and Akhilesh Jain remains the Treasurer. Shyam Mahajan, previously the Sangathan Mantri for the Rewa division, has been given the crucial role of State Office Secretary (Pradesh

Focusing on Balance and Inclusion

The new 29-member team features a blend of continuity and change: 13 members from the previous executive have retained their positions, while 16 new workers have been given the opportunity to serve. Prominent inclusions are Prabhul Jatav and former Minister Prabhu-

ram Choudhary (a close associate of Jyotiraditya Scindia), who have been appointed as Vice Presidents. The new team includes seven women and retains the official positions close to the party's disciplinary

structure, limiting the number of posts to prioritize organization over the expanded structure seen in 2020. The possibility of adding more functionaries for regional and caste balance remains open.

Suspected bomb blast on railway tracks near Kokrajhar

Guwahati: About eight trains under went detention today under the Alipurduar division of the Northeast Frontier Railway (NFR) when a suspected blast occurred on the railway track near Kokrajhar in the wee hours today, railway officials said.

A spokesperson for the NFR stated that at approximately 1:00 am, a blast occurred on the tracks when the goods train UP AZARA Sugar was passing between Salakati and Kokrajhar. He said that the Train manager reported a heavy jerk, after which the train was stopped.

"On checking, it was found that there was damage on the track and sleepers, due to a suspected bomb blast," he added.

The track was restored at 5:25 am, and normal train service has resumed. Patrolling has been intensified in the section while the state Police, RPF, and intelligence authorities are investigating the matter.

Tejaswi Yadav named Mahagathbandhan's CM candidate for Bihar Polls



Patna: Putting an end to speculation, the Mahagathbandhan (Grand Alliance) officially declared Tejaswi Yadav as its Chief Ministerial face for the upcoming Bihar Assembly elections. Adding a strategic dimension to the ticket, Mukesh Sahani of the Vikassheel Insaan Party (VIP) was presented as the Deputy Chief Minister candidate. The announcement was

made at a joint press conference on Thursday by former Rajasthan Chief Minister and senior Congress leader Ashok Gehlot. Prominent leaders from ally parties, including Dipankar Bhattacharya (CPI-ML) and Lalan Chaudhary (CPI-M), were present.

Gehlot stated that the decision was collectively taken by top alliance leadership, including Rahul Gandhi and Mallikarjun Kharge. He highlighted that under Tejaswi Yadav's leadership, the coalition had delivered a strong performance in the 2020 elections, missing the chance to form a government by a narrow margin. The unified declaration aims to consolidate the alliance's electoral momentum heading into the polls.

PM Modi to join 22nd ASEAN-India Summit virtually

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is set to virtually participate in the 22nd ASEAN-India Summit on October 26, responding to an invitation from Malaysian Prime Minister Dato Seri Anwar Ibrahim, the Ministry of External Affairs announced today. This summit represents a significant step forward in strengthening India's rela-

tionship with Southeast Asia, in line with the government's Act East Policy and broader Indo-Pacific vision.

The MEA statement highlighted that, "Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi and the ASEAN leaders will jointly review the progress in ASEAN-India relations and discuss initiatives for strengthening the Comprehensive Strategic Partnership." India's engagement with ASEAN continues to be a vital element of its foreign policy, focused on promoting regional peace, economic resilience, and inclusive development.

Earlier today, PM Modi took to his official X handle to share warm sentiments about his conversation with Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim.

US tariff could be reduced to 15 pc

India-US trade deal may be finalized



New Delhi: The long-running negotiations between India and the United States regarding a trade deal may now be finalized. According to a report, the two countries are very close to a trade deal. The 50 percent tariff imposed on India could be reduced to 15 to 16 percent.

The report states that under this agreement based on energy and agriculture, India could gradually reduce its imports of Russian crude oil. US Presi-

dent Donald Trump said that he spoke with Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He stated that the conversation primarily focused on trade. He also discussed energy, and Modi assured him that India would limit its oil purchases from Russia.

It should be noted that due to India's purchase of oil from Russia, an additional 25 percent tariff has been imposed on Indian exports. Currently, Russia supplies about 34 percent of India's crude oil imports, while about 10 percent (by value) of the country's oil and gas requirements come from the United States.

Meanwhile, President Donald Trump has reiterated his claim that India will "sharply reduce" its imports of Russian oil by the end of this year, citing what he described as a personal assurance from Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
