Bhopal: The Government of India today energized the nation's workforce with the grand launch of the 17th Rozgar Mela, a massive initiative that saw over 51,000 aspiring candidates receive appointment letters across 40 cities. The event, held in Bhopal and simultaneously across the country, marked a significant milestone, bringing the total employment provided through these fairs to over 11 lakh youth.

'Citizen is God': A Call to Service

In Bhopal, 248 selected candidates were inducted into vital central departments, including the Postal Department, Railways, AIIMS, and Ministries of Home and Health. Prime Minister Narendra



Modi, addressing the recruits via message, emphasized that the appointment was not just a job, but an "opportunity to serve the nation." He urged the young professionals to work with integrity and adopt the principle of 'Naagrik Devo Bhava: (The Citizen is God) to realize the dream of a developed India.

Bhopal MP Alok Sharma hailed the Mela as a testament to the Prime Minister's vision. Postmaster General Brajesh Kumar advised the new recruits, whose roles are directly connected to public welfare, to serve the citizens wholeheartedly. The successful event highlights the government's commitment to leveraging India's vast youth power.

Blackout Alert Major Power Outages Slated for Bhopal This Saturday

Bhopal: Residents across several major areas of the capital should brace for prolonged power cuts this Saturday as the electricity board conducts essential maintenance work. The planned outages will affect commercial hubs and residential zones, with duration varying significantly across the city.

The longest scheduled blackouts will run from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, hitting areas like Old Qazi Camp, Kokta, Transport Nagar, and Anandpura.

Meanwhile, key localities including Ravi Shankar Nagar, Arera Colony (E-1/E-2), and the 7 Number Bus Stop will face interruptions from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Additionally, areas such as Chandbad, Hinotiya, Halpura Bus Stand, and Om Nagar will experience phased cuts throughout the day. Residents are strongly advised to complete essential tasks and charge devices in advance to minimize inconvenience during the maintenance period.

WCR Rides Revenue Rocket: Rs 2,789 Crore Earned in Freight Surge

Bhopal/Jabalpur: Western Central Railway (WCR) has engineered a spectacular surge in freight traffic, hauling in a massive revenue of over Rs 2,789 Crore during the first half of the current fiscal year (April to September 2025). Driven by the continuous monitoring of the General Manager and strategic planning across its Jabalpur, Bhopal, and Kota divisions, WCR achieved a total freight loading of 27.12 million tonnes.

This performance represents a powerful acceleration for the zone, marking an impressive 10% growth in rail revenue and an 8% increase in overall freight loading compared to the same period last year.

Coal and Clinker Lead the Charge

The growth was fueled by exceptional results across key commodities:

- * Coal Loading spiked by 25.45%, transporting 6.82 million tonnes.
- * Clinker Loading also saw a significant jump of 24.61%, moving 5.25 million tonnes.
- * The essential Foodgrain transport increased by over 13%, while



Container loading rose by more than 10%.


Senior officials attribute this success to relentless efforts by the commercial operations teams focused on optimizing commodity-wise loading, ensuring WCR remains a vital engine for economic activity in the region.

Deputy CM Vows Crackdown after Carbine Gun Blast Injures Youth

Bhopal: Deputy Chief Minister Rajendra Shukla made an urgent visit to Hamidia Hospital to check on the youth and children injured in a horrific accident involving a carbine gun explosion. Vowing "strict legal action" against those responsible, the Deputy CM ordered continuous, high-level monitoring of the remaining patients as authorities launch a fierce crackdown on illegal explosives.

Casualty Update and Vigilance Call

Hospital officials, including Dean Dr. Kavita Singh, confirmed that out of the 37 people injured in the accidental blast, 32 have been treated and released. However, five patients are still receiving care. Deputy CM Shukla personally met with the victims and their families, ensuring them that the government is providing the "best medical facilities" and has directed doctors and



nursing staff to maintain constant, vigilant supervision to prevent any lapse in care.

Shukla stressed that the focus is now on rooting out the cause: "Intense investigation is underway against those illegally manufactur-

ing firecrackers or possessing explosive materials," he stated. His promise of "harsh legal action" underscores the government's zero-tolerance policy following the incident that left several young lives shaken.
