PM Modi calls for new growth model, citing environmental and social costs

New Delhi (UNI)
Prime Minister Narendra Modi has called for a fundamental re-evaluation of the global economic growth model, saying existing parameters have failed vast populations and damaged the planet.

Addressing the 1st session of the G20 Leaders' Summit in Johannesburg titled 'Inclusive and Sustainable Economic Growth - Leaving No One Behind', PM Modi highlighted the disproportionate impact of current development models on the developing world, particularly Africa.

plottation. Africa has suffered the most," PM Modi stated. He proposed adopting India's civilizational value of Integral Humanism, which views humans, society, and nature as an integrated whole.

The Prime Minister suggested establishing a Global Traditional Knowledge Repository to preserve traditional and eco-balanced lifestyles. He also proposed the G20-Africa Skills Multiplier initiative to

train one million certified trainers in Africa over the next decade.

He stressed the need for collective responsibility in tackling global security and health crises, proposing a G20 Global Healthcare Response team.

He also highlighted the threat of global drug trafficking, proposing a G20 Initiative on Countering the Drug-Terror Nexus to disrupt illicit funds and dismantle criminal orga-

nizations. PM Modi reaffirmed India's solidarity with Africa, emphasizing the importance of amplifying the Global South's voice in multilateral institutions.

"We must work together to make the voices of the Global South louder in all global institutions," he said.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi met Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni on the sidelines of the G20 Summit, engaging in discussions as both leaders participated in the ongoing multilateral deliberations in Johannesburg.

The interaction took place shortly after Prime Minister Modi arrived at the G20 venue, where South African President Cyril Ramaphosa received him. His formal welcome set the stage for a series of engagements during the summit.

Trump signals support for NYC Mayor-elect Mamdani

In a striking departure from months of political hostility, President Donald Trump on Friday offered praise for New York City Mayor-elect Zohran Mamdani after what both described as a "productive" meeting at the White House.

The meeting lasted roughly 30 minutes and marked the beginning of what both leaders signaled could be a cooperative relationship, an-

expected turn for two politicians who, until days ago, rarely passed up an opportunity to attack each other.

Trump, who had repeatedly derided Mamdani as a "communist" during the mayoral campaign, called the Democratic socialist "rational" and said he would be "cheering for him" once he takes office.

"I think you're going to have, hopefully, a really great mayor. The better he does, the happier I am," Trump said in the Oval Office with Mamdani at his side. "There's no difference in party. We're going to be helping him make everybody's dream come true, having a strong and very safe New York."

The two discussed housing affordability, food and energy costs, and public safety. Mamdani said they also talked about immigration enforcement in the city, an issue on which he has clashed with federal officials and raised concerns over the presence of ICE officers in New York.

Red Fort blast: NIA court permits meeting between lawyer and accused Jasir Bilal during custody

Special NIA court at Patiala House on Saturday allowed the plea of Red Fort blast accused Jasir Bilal Wani for meeting with his lawyer on alternate days during remand at NIA headquarters. Wani is currently in the NIA's custodial remand.

Jasir Bilal Wani's alias, Danish, was arrested in Srinagar on November 17 by the NIA. He was remanded in 10 days' custody on November 18.

Special NIA Judge Anju Bajaj Chandana allowed the plea of Jasir Bilal Wani alias Danish to meet his counsel in custody on alternate days from 5-6 PM.

It is alleged that Jasir provided technical support and modified

drones. He was also planning to make a rocket. He was closely associated with the terror Conspiracy with Umar Un Nabi.

The Delhi High Court on Friday refused to issue directions allowing Red Fort terror attack co-accused Jasir Bilal Wani to meet his lawyer at the National Investigation Agency (NIA) headquarters.

Justice Swarana Kanta Sharma stated that the Court could not devise an exceptional procedure in the absence of a formal rejection order from the trial court.

The matter was accordingly remanded to the Sessions Judge, with instructions to adjudicate it on Saturday.

J&K electrician detained

The State Investigation Agency (SIA) and the Special Operations Group of Jammu and Kashmir have detained another suspect in the Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) interstate terror module linked to the Red Fort blast case. Tufail Ahmed, an electrician working in Pulwama, was picked up from an industrial estate for questioning. He is a native of Srinagar. Sources say the investigation has uncovered strong leads suggesting his involvement in the conspiracy, prompting deeper scrutiny of his role in the network.
