CM inaugurates Mobility Station

● Citing new tech as key to Ujjain's growth

Bhopal: Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav virtually inaugurated the Shri Gayatri Petroleum - Mobility Station located in Nalwa village, Ujjain, emphasizing that fuel, mobility, and new technologies are essential drivers for the region's rapid development.

Speaking from the Chief Minister's residence, Dr. Yadav extended congratulations to the station owner, Govind Singh Anjana. He highlighted that Western Madhya Pradesh is undergoing a significant transformation, shaped by the upcoming Simhastha 2028 and the planned development of the Ujjain-Indore-Dewas Metropolitan Area.

Indore shatters 10-year cold record

● Dips below Pachmarhi

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is currently reeling under a fierce cold wave, with nighttime temperatures plummeting across the state for the third consecutive night. Surprisingly, Indore, often milder than the hill station Pachmarhi, recorded a bone-chilling 4.5°C, marking its lowest temperature in the last decade. This figure was colder than Pachmarhi's recorded minimum of 4.8°C. Meanwhile, the state capital Bhopal has endured a continuous cold wave effect for six days straight.

Cold wave alert issued across five districts

The Meteorological Department has issued a cold wave warning for Friday across several regions, including Bhopal, Indore, Sehore, Shajapur, and Rajgarh districts, urging residents to take extreme precautions. The sudden and intense drop in temperatures



is attributed to several active weather systems, including a trough-shaped Western Disturbance at the middle tropospheric level and the indirect influence of a high-speed sub-tropical jet stream flowing over Northeast India.

Public safety and crop advisory

Temperatures have consistently dipped significantly below normal,

with the Bhopal division reporting minimum temperatures up to 3.7°C below average. Residents are advised to take extra care, especially for the elderly and children, and to avoid unnecessary exposure during early morning and late evening hours. Farmers in rural areas have also been put on alert regarding the possibility of frost damage to crops due to the intense cold.
