Bhopal: High-voltage protests erupted across Madhya Pradesh on Saturday as Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav and the BJP leadership demanded the immediate expulsion of Congress MLA Phool Singh Baraiya over his controversial remarks regarding women. Backlash over offensive comments: The controversy stems from a viral interview where Baraiya allegedly made derogatory statements about Dalit, Tribal, and OBC women, linking heinous crimes like rape to specific communities. CM Dr. Mohan Yadav slammed the remarks, stating they "dissolve poison into society" and expose the anti-Dalit and anti-woman mind-

set of the Congress party. "Rahul Gandhi shared a stage with Baraiya in Indore recently. Does this silence imply his consent?" the CM questioned, demanding that the Congress leadership move beyond rhetoric and expel the MLA. Statewide protests and effigy burning: The BJP Mahila Morcha took to the streets in Bhopal, Indore, and Jabalpur, burning effigies of the MLA. At Bhopal's Board Office Chauraha, protesters demand-

Congress refutes MLA's remarks on Rudrayamal Tantra

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh Congress Committee media department president Mukesh Nayak has issued a factual rebuttal to statements made by MLA Phool Singh Baraiya regarding the ancient text Rudrayamal Tantra. Nayak said that presenting misleading interpretations of sacred scriptures from public platforms was inappropriate and could foster unnecessary mistrust among different sections of society. Clarifying the Congress position, Nayak stated that Rudrayamal Tantra is a sacred compilation of dialogues between Lord Shiva and Shakti, which emphasises unity, equality and the dignity of all hu-

manity. He cited verses from the text to underline that the tantric path is meant for people of all varnas and ashrams, granting spiritual rights to every individual without discrimination. He further pointed out that the text regards the human body as a divine temple and every living being as inherently divine, making allegations of caste or class bias baseless. Nayak added that renowned meditative practices, including those in Vigyan Bhairav Tantra, originate from the same tradition. He asserted that the Congress respects all religious texts and does not endorse uninformed personal views that hurt cultural and spiritual sentiments.

Symposium highlights conservation of lesser-known species

Experts stress research, habitat protection, and community participation



Bhopal: The fourth national symposium on lesser-known species of Central India was held at the Environment Complex in Bhopal, bringing together wildlife experts, researchers, and forest officials from across the country. The event was jointly inaugurated by senior officials of the Madhya Pradesh Forest Department, the Madhya Pradesh Bio-

diversity Board, and the Indian Institute of Forest Management. Focus on wildlife management and gaps: Addressing the inaugural session, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests V.N. Ambade said Madhya Pradesh has set benchmarks in wildlife management but stressed that conservation efforts must equally focus on lesser-

known flora and fauna. Chief Wildlife Warden Shubhbranjana Sen noted that the decline of species like the Lesser Florican and Great Indian Bustard reflects collective failure, though encouraging work is underway on caracal conservation, with a special project proposed in Gandhi Sagar Sanctuary. Gharial conservation and habitat chal-

enges: A key technical session marked 50 years of India's Crocodile Conservation Project. Experts highlighted the Chambal region as a model for species conservation, noting the presence of over 2,400 gharials and several rare turtles. Speakers underlined that habitat protection, not just population numbers, is crucial, especially in human-dominated landscapes. Research on carnivores and community role: Presentations covered studies on small carnivores in Kutch, Great Indian Bustard conservation through community engagement, Hill Myna recovery, and the ecological importance of fireflies as bio-indicators. Researchers emphasized that conservation cannot succeed without local community involvement and strong habitat policies. Organised by the Society of Nature Healers, Conservators and Local Tourism Development, the three-day symposium will also focus on river ecosystem restoration and community-led conservation efforts.

Internal rift widens: Shivpuri Congress Chief issues notices to 8 workers

Shivpuri: The internal crisis within the Shivpuri District Congress has escalated into a public showdown after District President Mohit Agarwal issued "show-cause" notices to eight party workers on charges of indiscipline and anti-party activities. The move, triggered by ongoing friction over organizational expansion in Narwar, has ignited a political firestorm. Adding fuel to the fire, the notices were leaked on social media before

reaching the concerned individuals, a move that local cadres have branded as a deliberate attempt to humiliate them. In a swift and defiant response, senior leaders including former Narwar Block President Kalluram Kushwaha and veteran leader Sushil Tiwari released video statements condemning Agarwal's leadership. Terming the action "dictatorial" and a violation of party protocol, the disgruntled lead-

ers accused the District President of bypassing internal grievance mechanisms. Kushwaha stated that the public nature of the notices has tarnished the party's image, while Tiwari warned that such high-handedness would hurt the organization's roots in the district. As the war of words plays out in the media, the deepening divide poses a significant challenge for the Congress leadership ahead of upcoming regional engagements.
